David Mandell is an assistant professor in the Departments of Psychiatry and Pediatrics in the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine, trained primarily as an epidemiologist and health services researcher. His research focuses on the epidemiology of autism as well as the organization, financing and delivery of services and supports to children with autism and their families. His funded research activities include being an investigator on a study of the epidemiology and etiology of autism, as well as a number of studies related to assessing the service and system needs of families of children with autism. He is also the co-chair of the Pennsylvania Autism Task Force, and works with the Pennsylvania Departments of Public Welfare and Health to develop appropriate policies and procedures to meet the needs of this population.
