

## Chad P. Bown

Chad P. Bown is a Nonresident Fellow in the Global Economy and Development Program at the Brookings Institution, as well as Associate Professor in the Department of Economics and International Business School (IBS) at Brandeis University in Waltham, Massachusetts. He is a Term Member at the Council on Foreign Relations and currently serves as the Book Review Editor for the *World Trade Review*.



Bown's research focuses on the economics of international trade laws and institutions, trade policy negotiations, trade frictions, the WTO and China's integration into the global economy. His policy pieces and commentary have been featured in *The Washington Post*, *The American*, and the Chicago Fed's *Economic Perspectives*. His recent research has been published in academic and policy journals such as the *Canadian Journal of Economics*, *Economics & Politics*, *European Journal of Political Economy*, *IMF Staff Papers*, *Journal of International Economic Law*, *Journal of International Economics*, *Journal of Legal Studies*, *Journal of World Trade*, *Oxford Review of Economic Policy*, *The Review of Economics and Statistics*, *World Bank Economic Review*, *The World Economy*, and *World Trade Review*.

For 2004-2005, Bown was the *Okun-Model Visiting Fellow* in Economic Studies at Brookings. He has also been a visiting scholar at and consultant to the World Bank, a visiting fellow at the Center for European Integration Studies (ZEI) in Bonn, Germany and the Swedish National Board of Trade (Kommerskollegium) in Stockholm. His research has received financial support through funding provided by the Mellon and Schulhof Family Foundations.

Bown teaches courses on the global economy, international trade policy and institutions, and international trade disputes to undergraduate students at Brandeis, as well as in the M.A., M.B.A., Ph.D., and Executive Education programs at Brandeis' International Business School. He has received numerous teaching awards while at Brandeis, including the University's *Michael L. Walzer '56 Award for Excellence in Teaching*, a *Kermit H. Perlmutter Fellowship for Teaching Excellence*, and he has twice been voted by students as IBS's *Teacher of the Year*. In 2006 Bown co-taught a Brandeis undergraduate course on globalization with *New York Times* columnist and author Thomas L. Friedman.

Bown holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1999), and a B.A. *magna cum laude* in Economics and International Relations from Bucknell University (1994).
