

Anthony Corrado

Anthony Corrado is the Charles A. Dana Professor of Government at Colby College in Waterville, Maine, and a Visiting Fellow in Governance Studies at the Brookings Institution. Considered one of the nation's leading experts on campaign finance, Corrado also serves as Chair of the American Bar Association's Advisory Commission on Election Law and Co-chair of the Board of Trustees of the Campaign Finance Institute, a nonpartisan, nonprofit institute located in Washington, D.C.



Corrado is the author or co-author of seven books, including most recently *Inside the Campaign Finance Battle* (Brookings 2003), and has published numerous articles on political finance, presidential campaigns, and election law. He is a recipient of the American Political Science Association's Emerging Scholars Award and New England Political Science Association's Johnson Prize, and is a member of a number of academic advisory boards. Corrado has participated as an expert consultant in several federal court cases, including *Colorado II* and *McConnell v. Federal Election Commission*, and has testified before the U.S. House and Senate on campaign finance issues. He has lectured widely on campaign finance and elections, and is a frequent contributor to newspaper and broadcast media coverage of American politics.

Corrado formerly served as principal investigator for a major grant project sponsored by The Pew Charitable Trusts; consultant for the Committee for Economic Development's Judicial Selection Project; and executive director of The Century Foundation's Task Force on Presidential Debates. He has also been a staff member or consultant to four presidential campaigns.
