Dr. Prasad is a research professor at the Robert H. Smith School of Business, University of Maryland, and guest scholar at the Brookings Institution. Previous positions include professor of economics at Florida State University and research officer at the University of Cambridge.

His principal research contributions are in the areas of computability and complexity of individual choice and economic equilibrium, innovation and diffusion of technology, and social influences on behavior.

Current projects include medical treatment variations and diffusion of technologies in medicine, complexity of choice under uncertainty, experimental tests of contract theory, and behavioral health economics.
