Description of files

The replication files provided are all Excel 2007 files, some of which use macro functionality and only work when macros are enabled. The files are named by figure number that coincides with that in the paper.

The structure of each of the workbooks is the following:

- The white tab with “readme” contains a description of the content of the file and the data source that we use.
- Green-tabbed worksheets contain raw source data.
- Purple-tabbed worksheets contain calculations based on the source data.
- Orange-tabbed worksheets contain the figures. Those with a name ending in “ppr” contain the black-and-white layout used in the paper. Other figures are in color for presentation purposes.

For most of the workbooks the source data is directly published by the BLS (in many of the workbooks Haver Analytics codes are provided for easy updating).
