




# Children in Poverty and People in Poverty, 1980 – 2007




# Poverty in Female-Headed Families and All Families, 1980-2007



# Median Income for All, Hispanic and Black Households, 1980 – 2007




# Income of Female-Headed Families with Children, 1990 - 2007
