

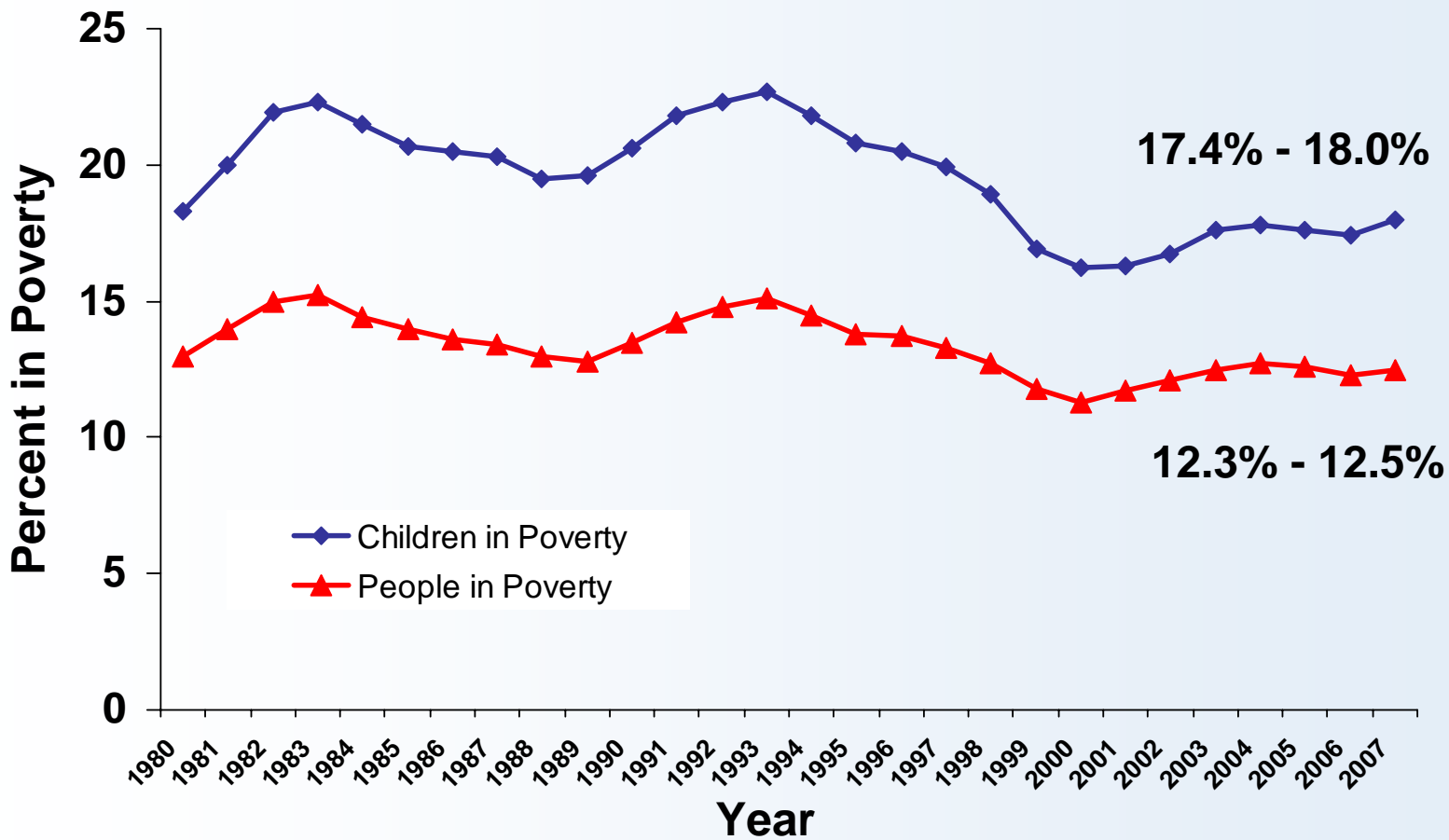

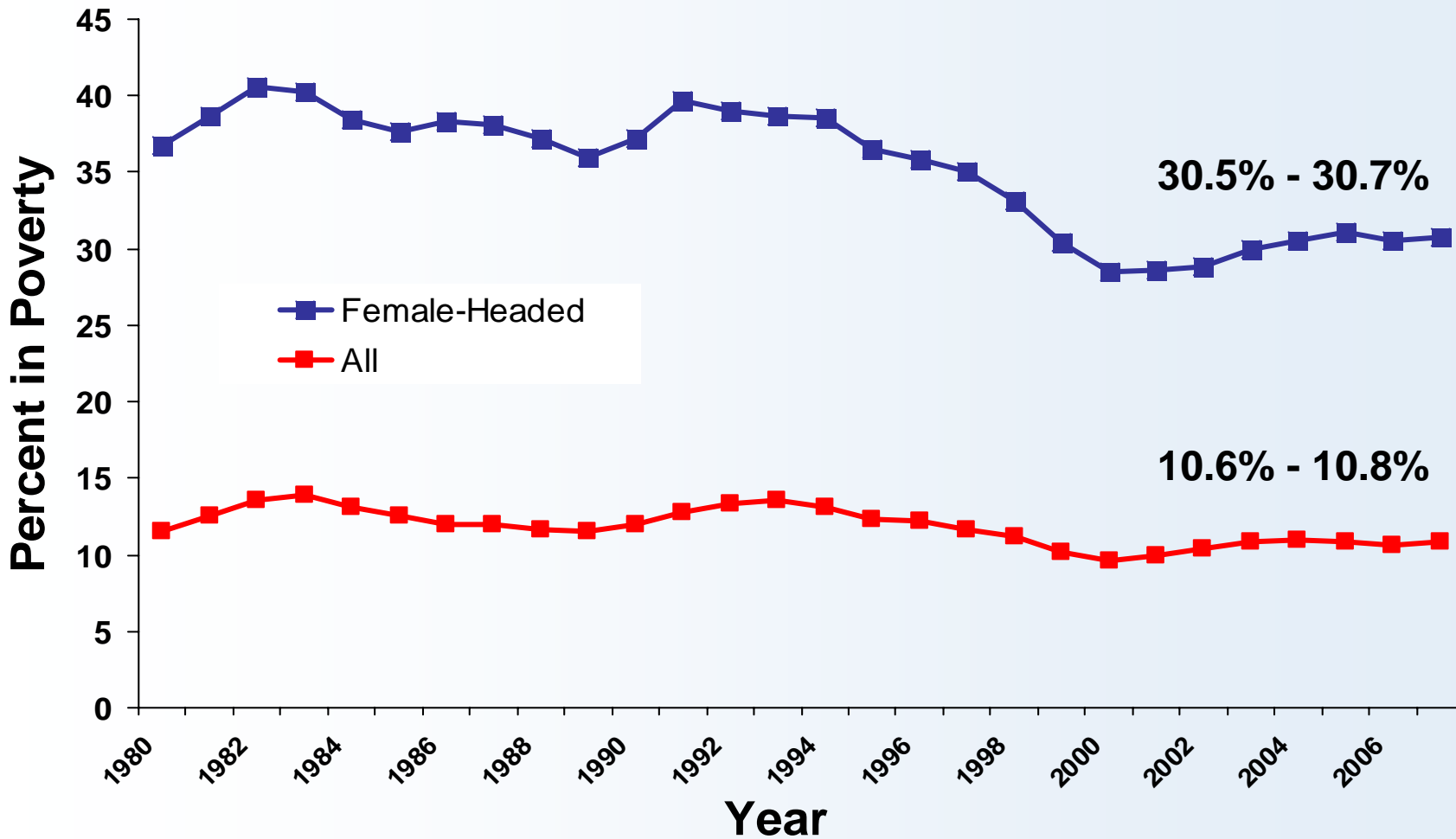

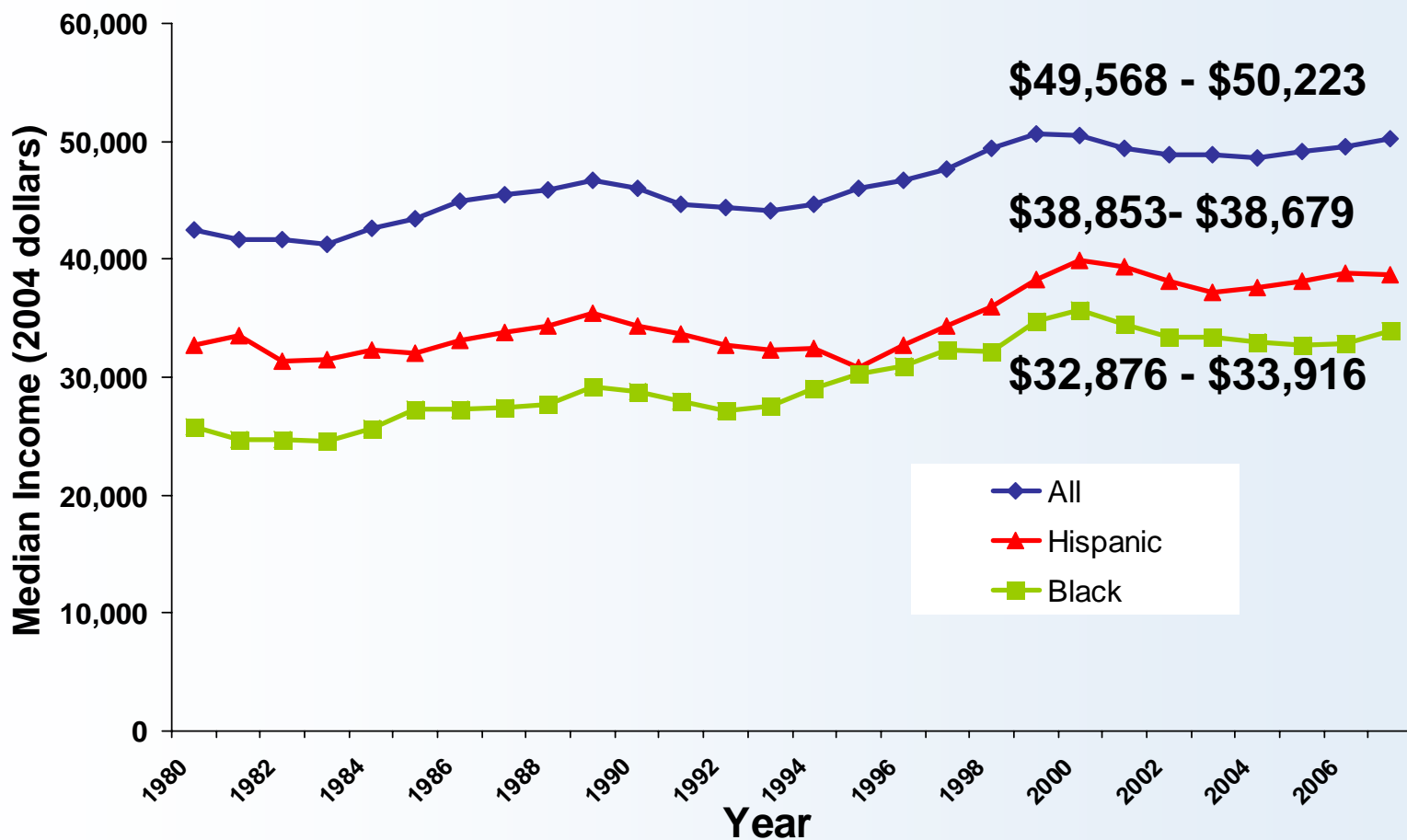
Children in Poverty and People in Poverty, 1980 – 2007

Median Income for All, Hispanic and Black Households, 1980 – 2007

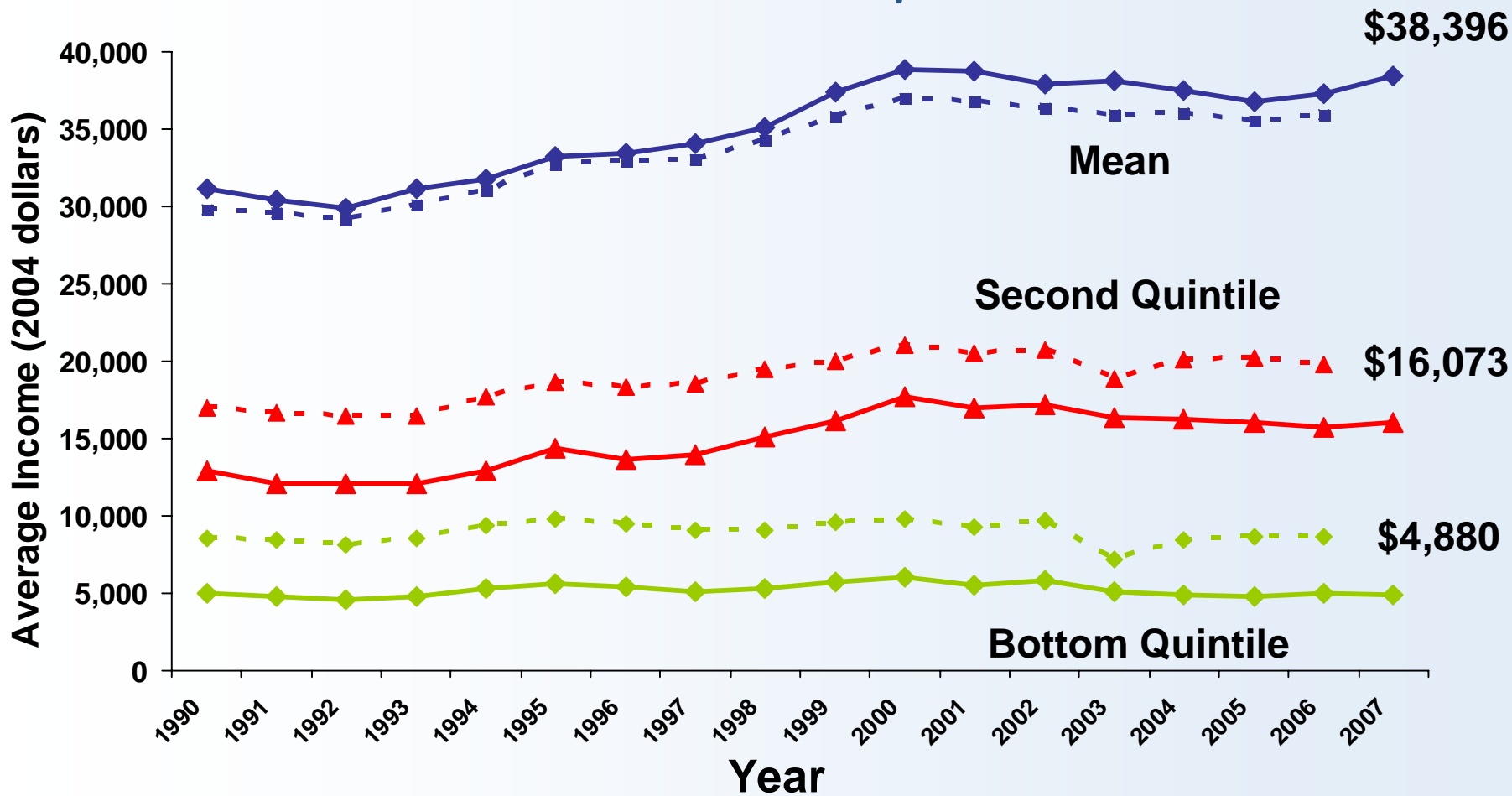

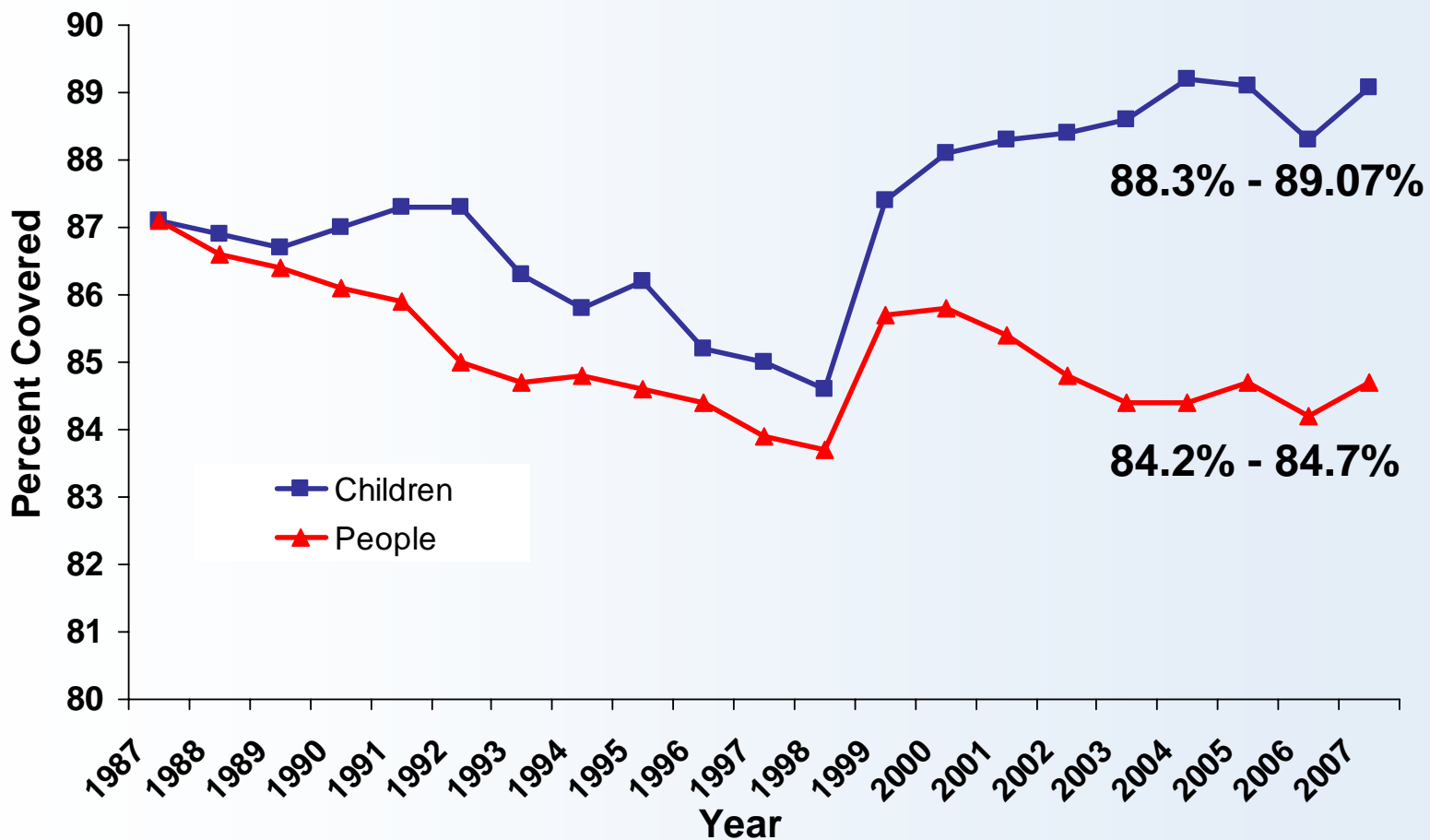
