






### How often do you use the internet, if at all?






What's your primary source for news on the Arab-Israeli issue?




When you watch international news, which of the following network's news broadcasts do you watch most often?




Which network's news broadcast is your second choice?






How would you describe your views of President Barack


How would you describe your views of the American Secretary of State Hillary Clinton?




After six months of the Obama Administration, how would you describe your attitudes toward the administration's policy in the Middle East?




As you are looking to assess the Obama Administration policy in the region, what issue is most central to your assessment?




Which TWO of the following factors do you believe are most important in driving American policy in the Middle East?
















When you observe the state of affairs in Gaza, which of the Palestinian parties do you believe is most responsible for it?




















Which world leader (outside your own country) do you admire most?




Which world leader (outside your own country) do you admire second most?




