(1981–2003)

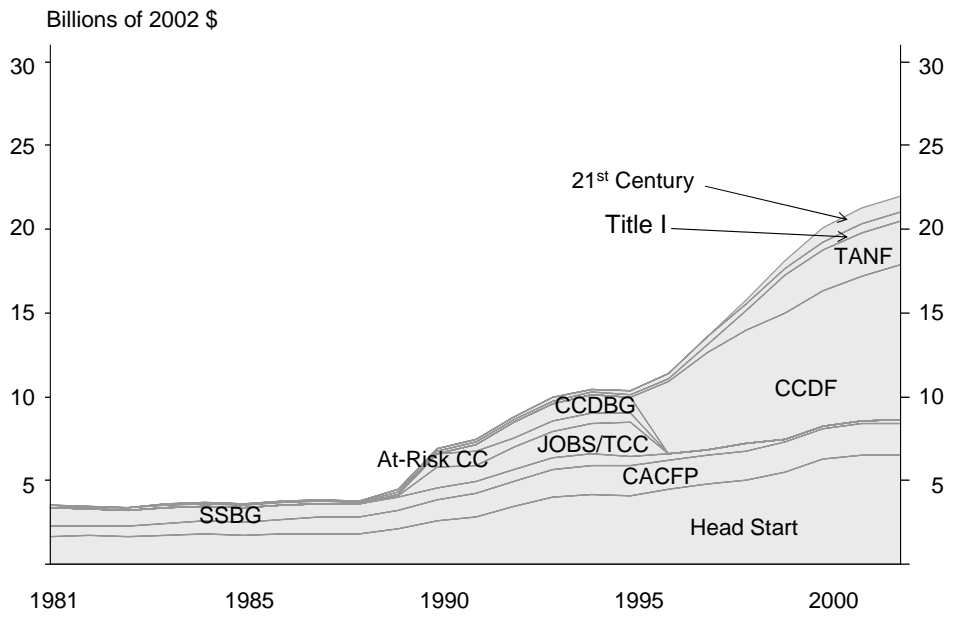

(1981–2003)

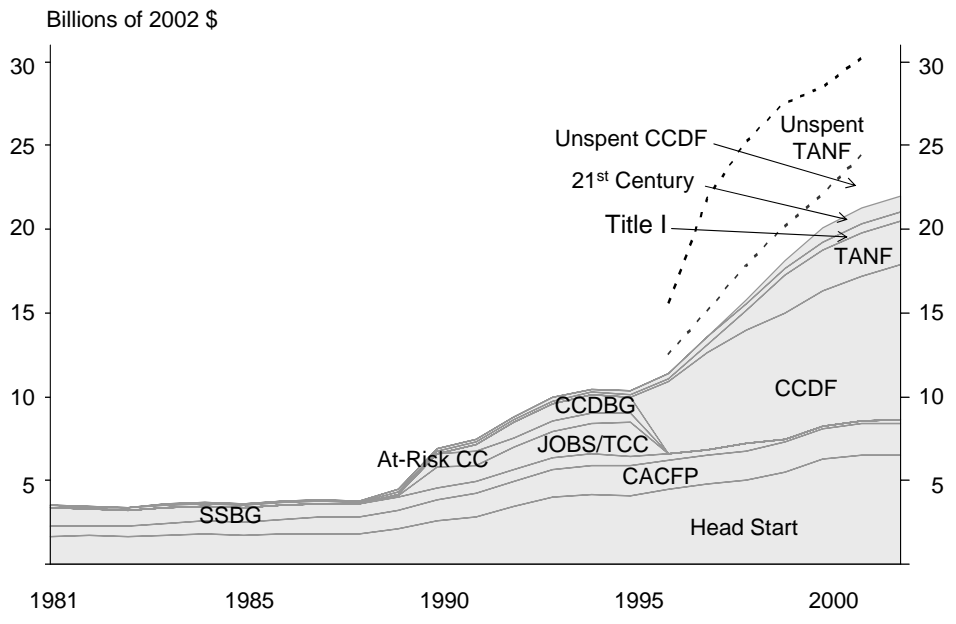
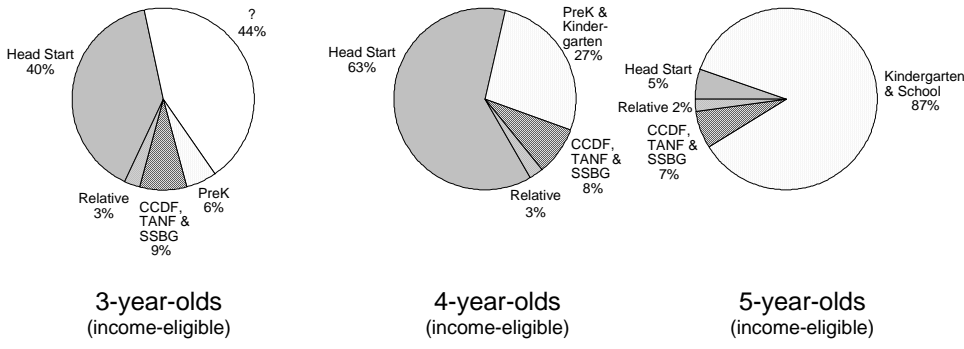
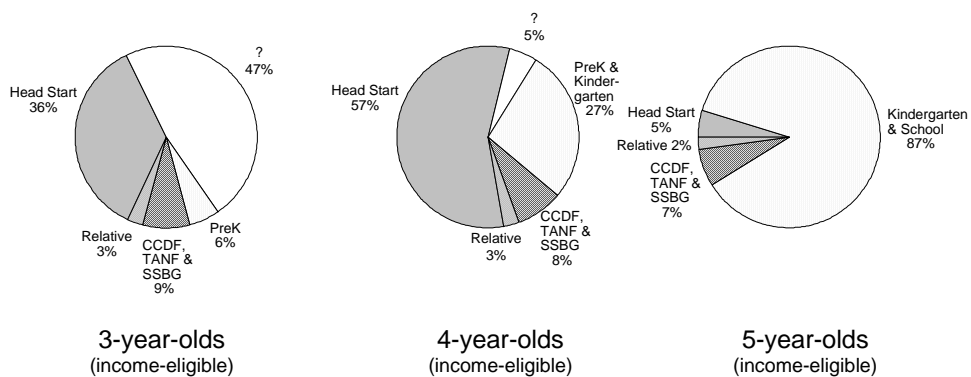
