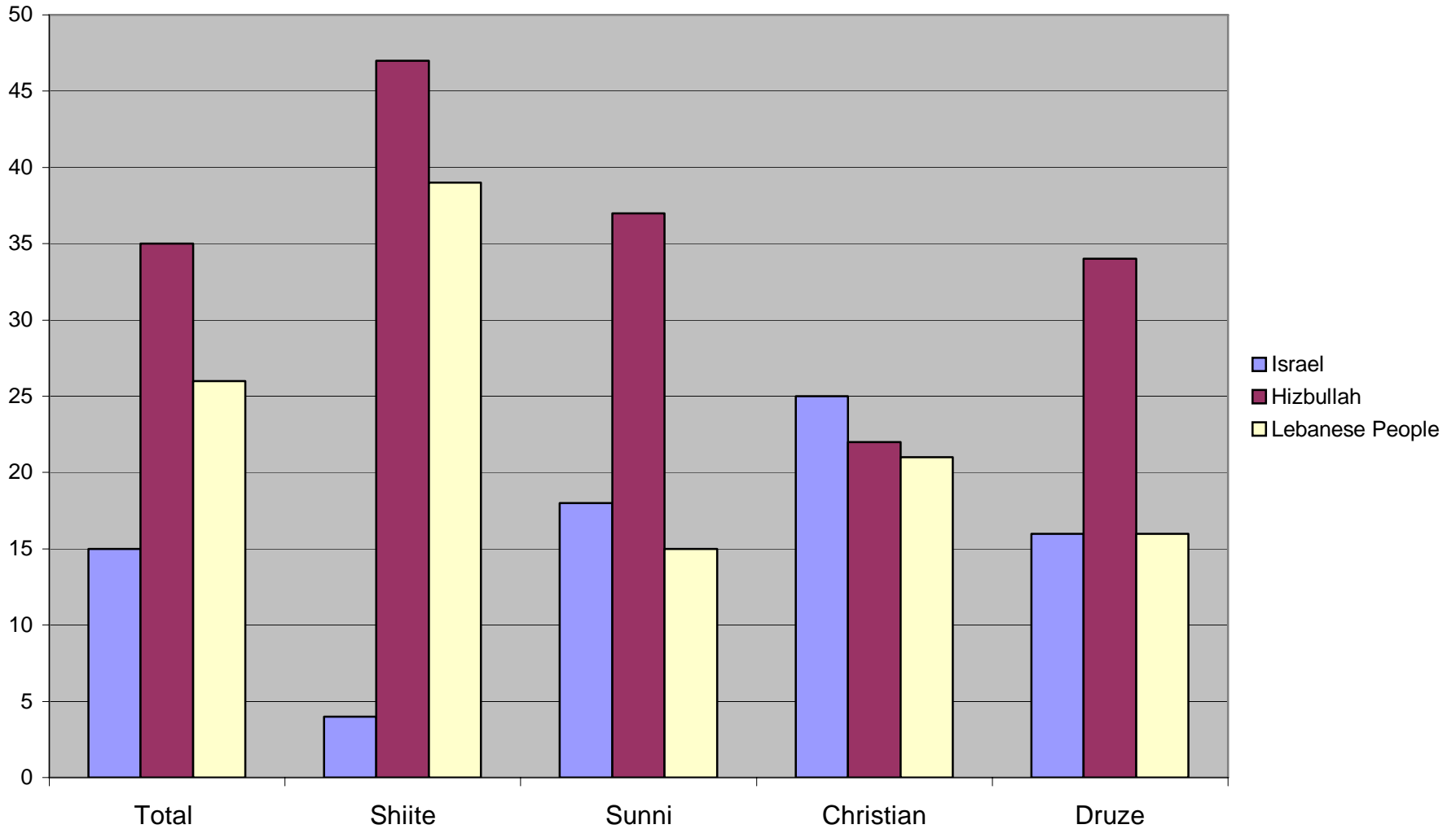

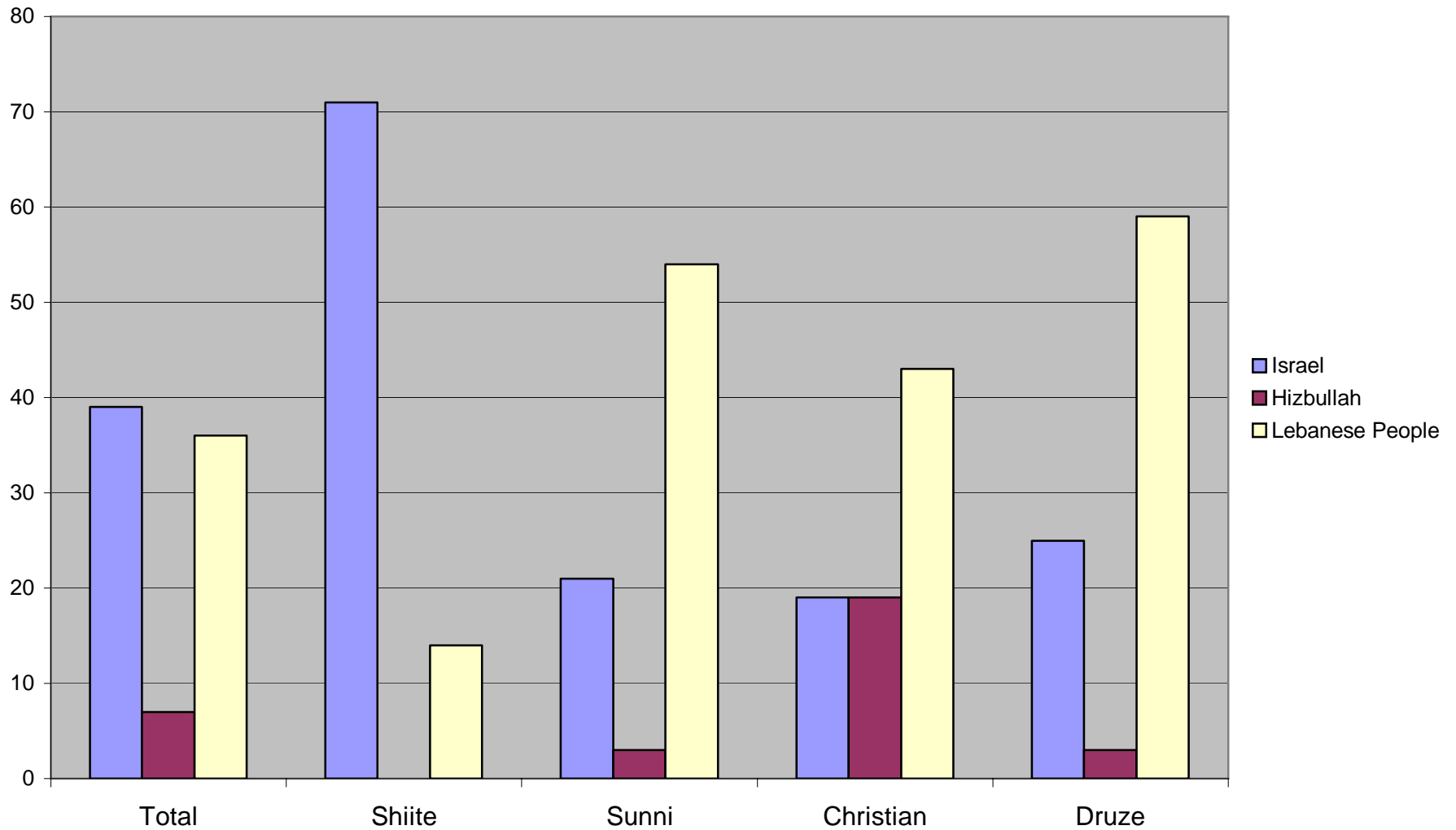

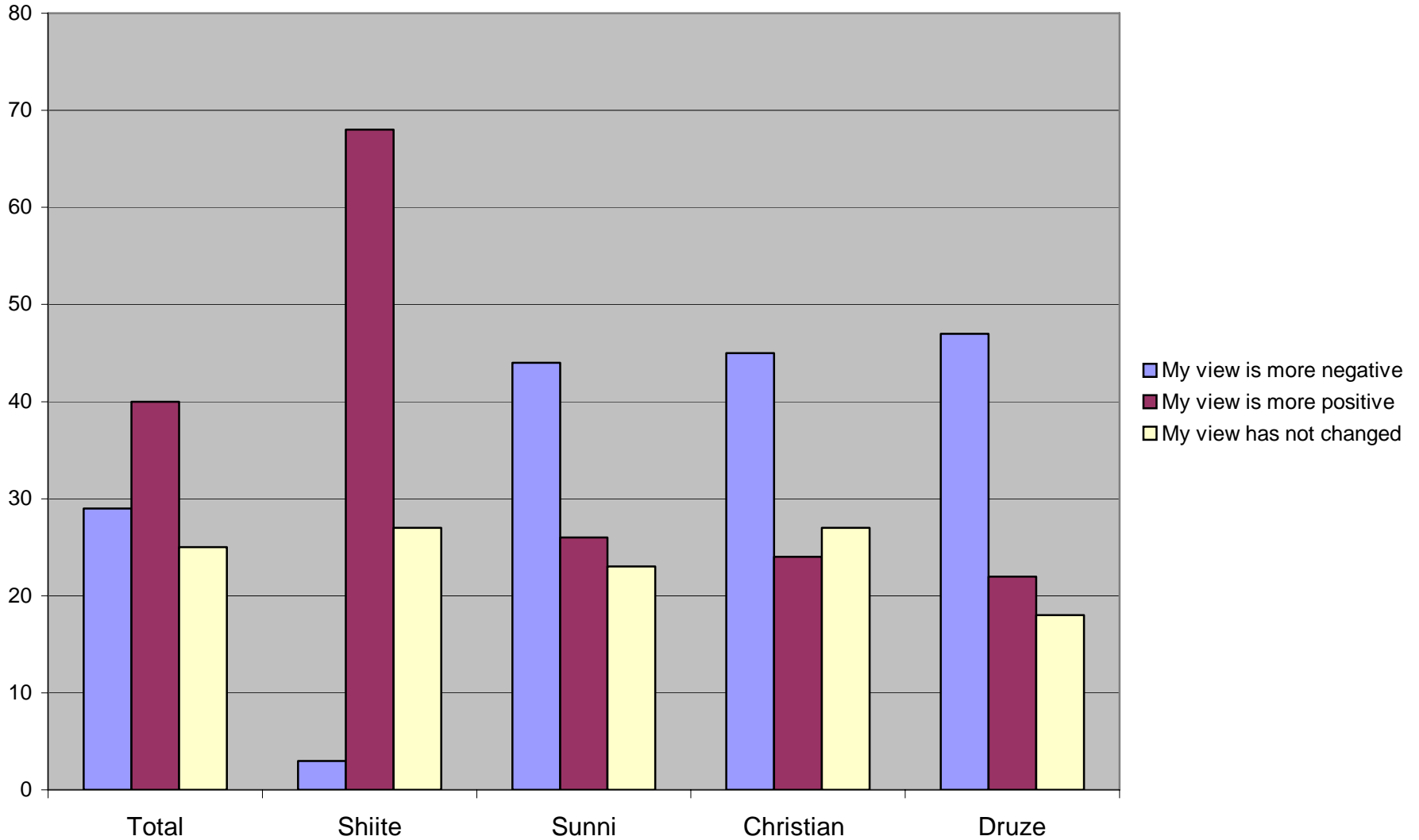
When you consider the outcome of the Lebanon-Israel War who do you think emerged as the biggest winner?



When you consider the outcome of the Lebanon-Israel War who do you think is the biggest loser?

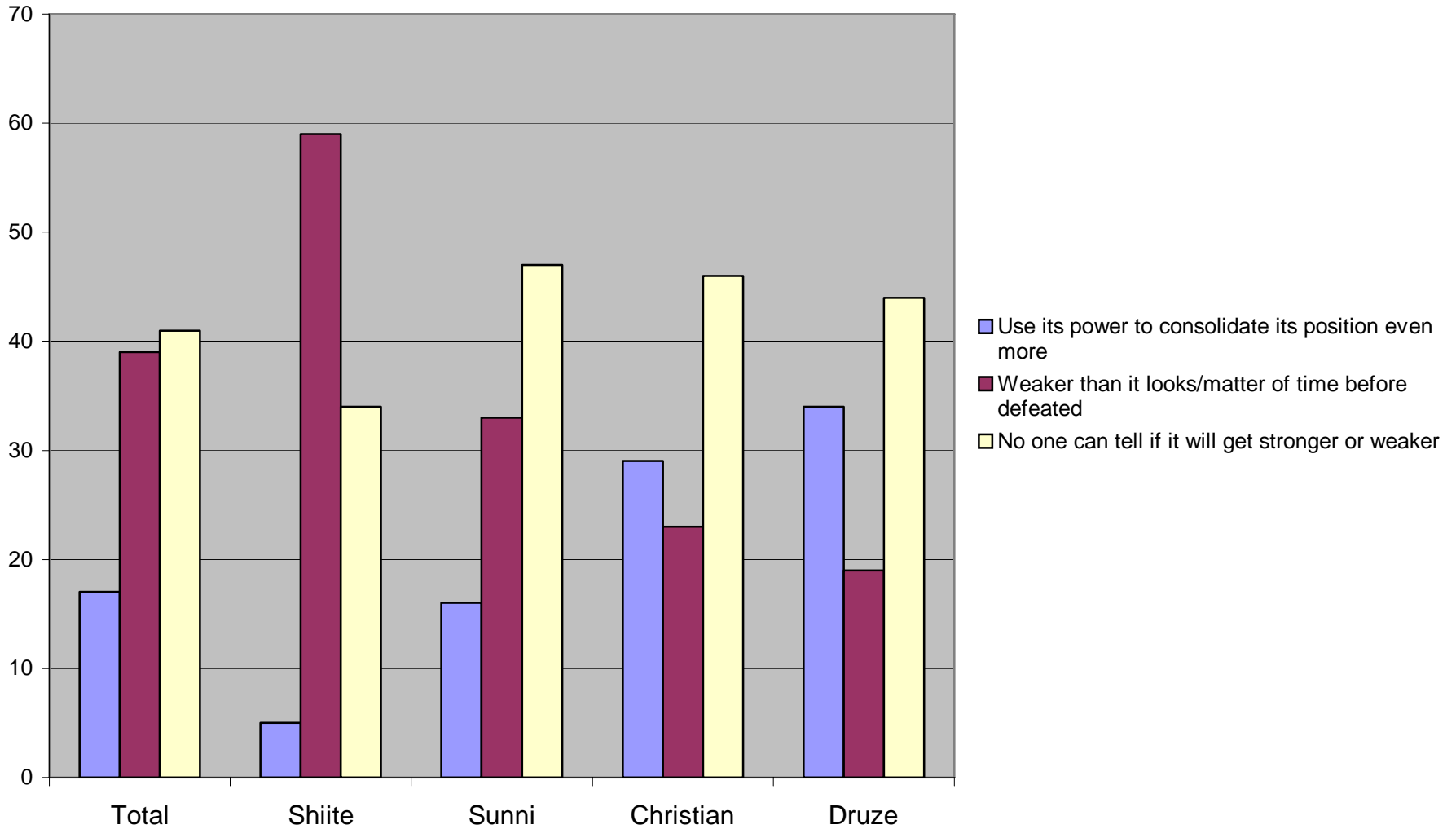


After the Lebanon War describe your attitudes toward Hizbullah

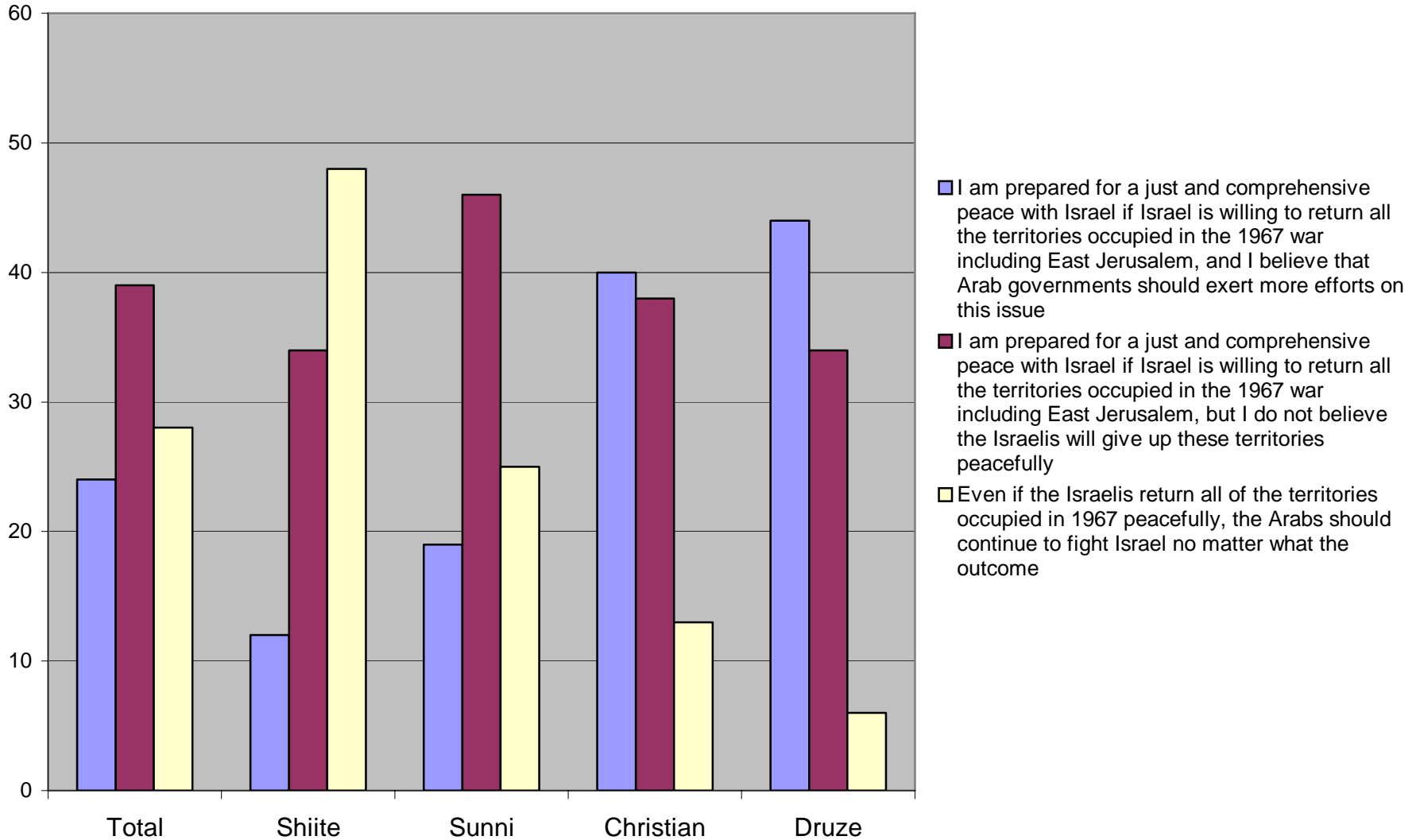

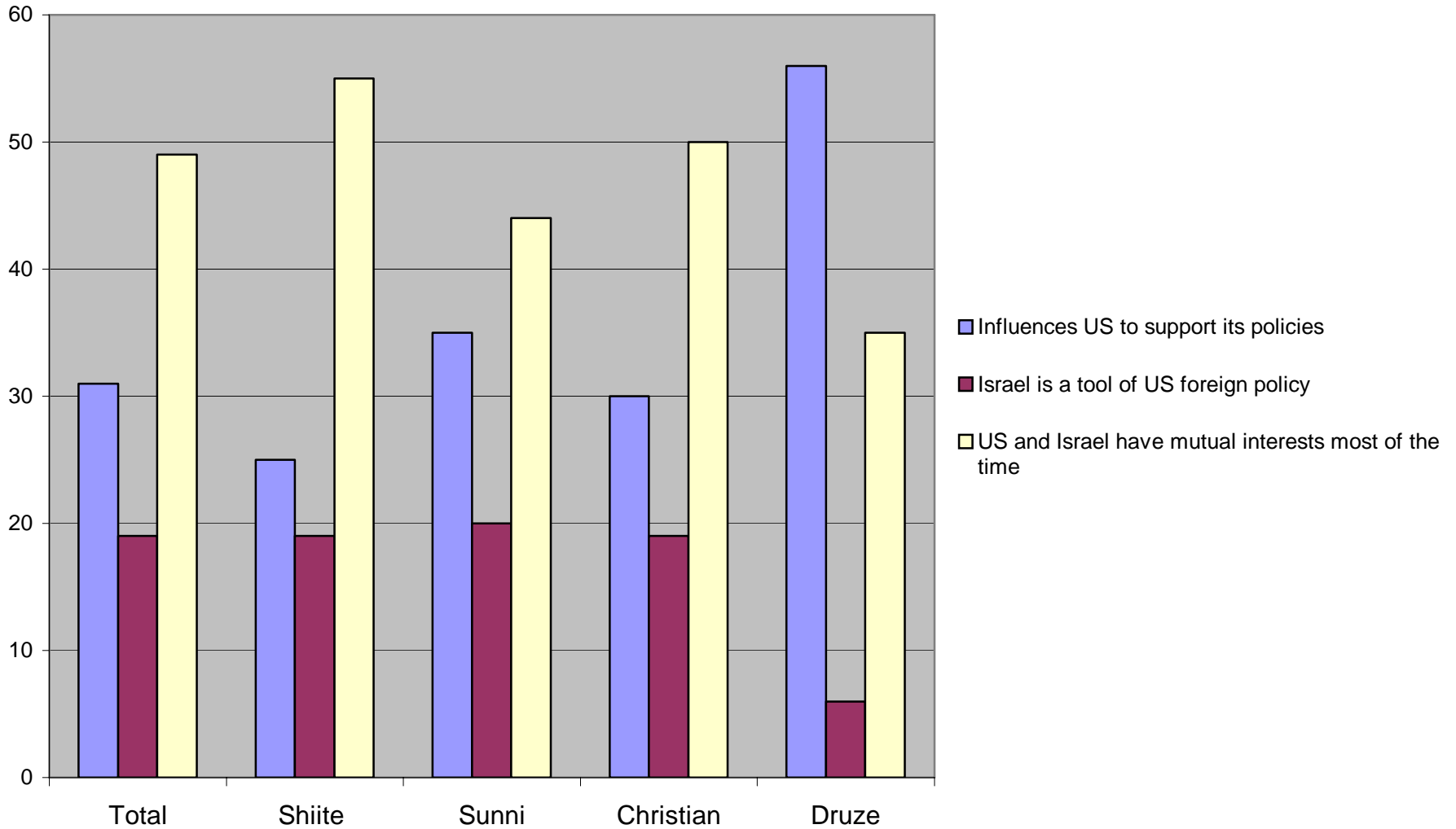
Looking at the recent violence in Lebanon and Gaza describe your attitude toward Israel's power



Which of the following statements is closer to your view:

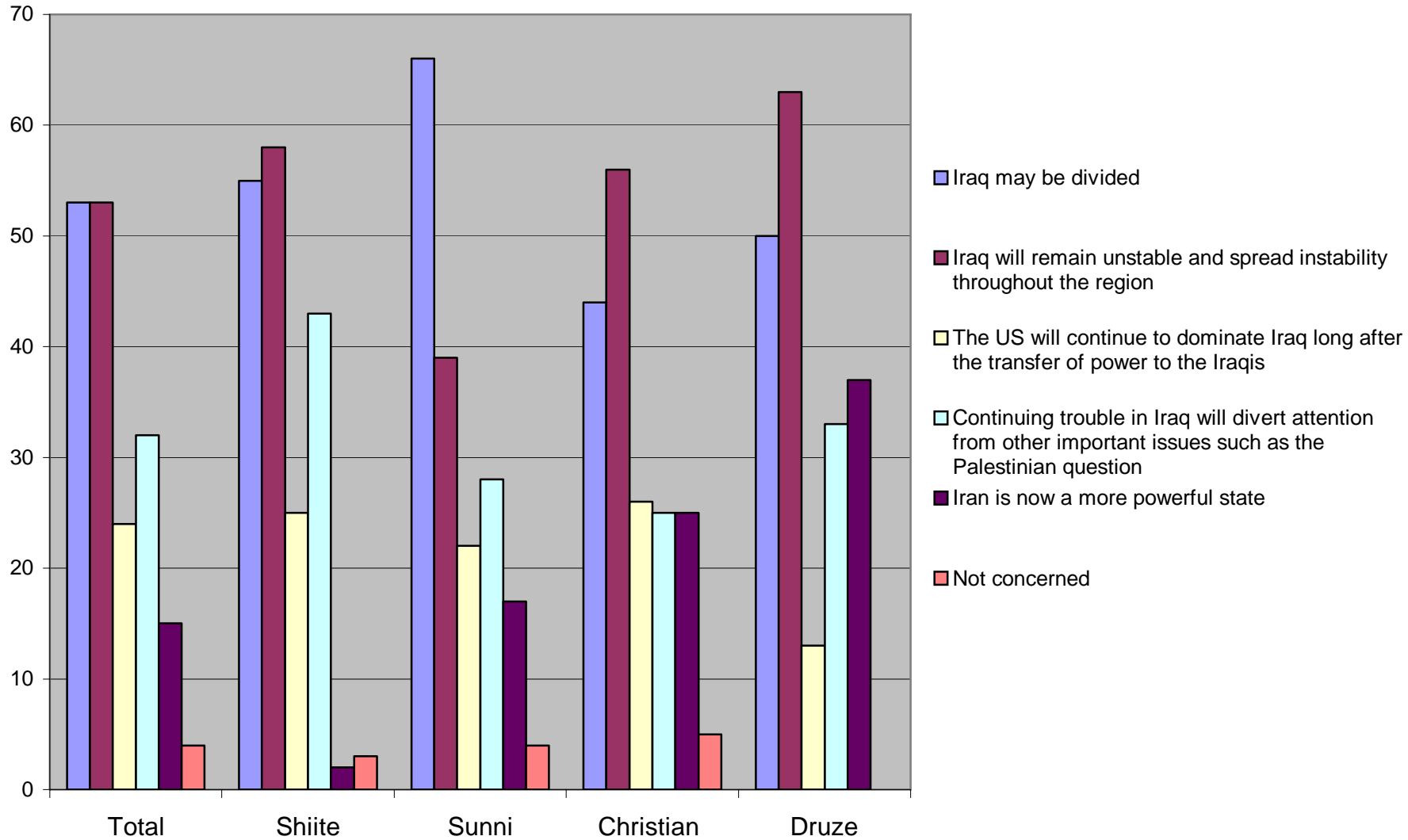


What do you believe motivates Israeli policies in the region and US support for these policies?

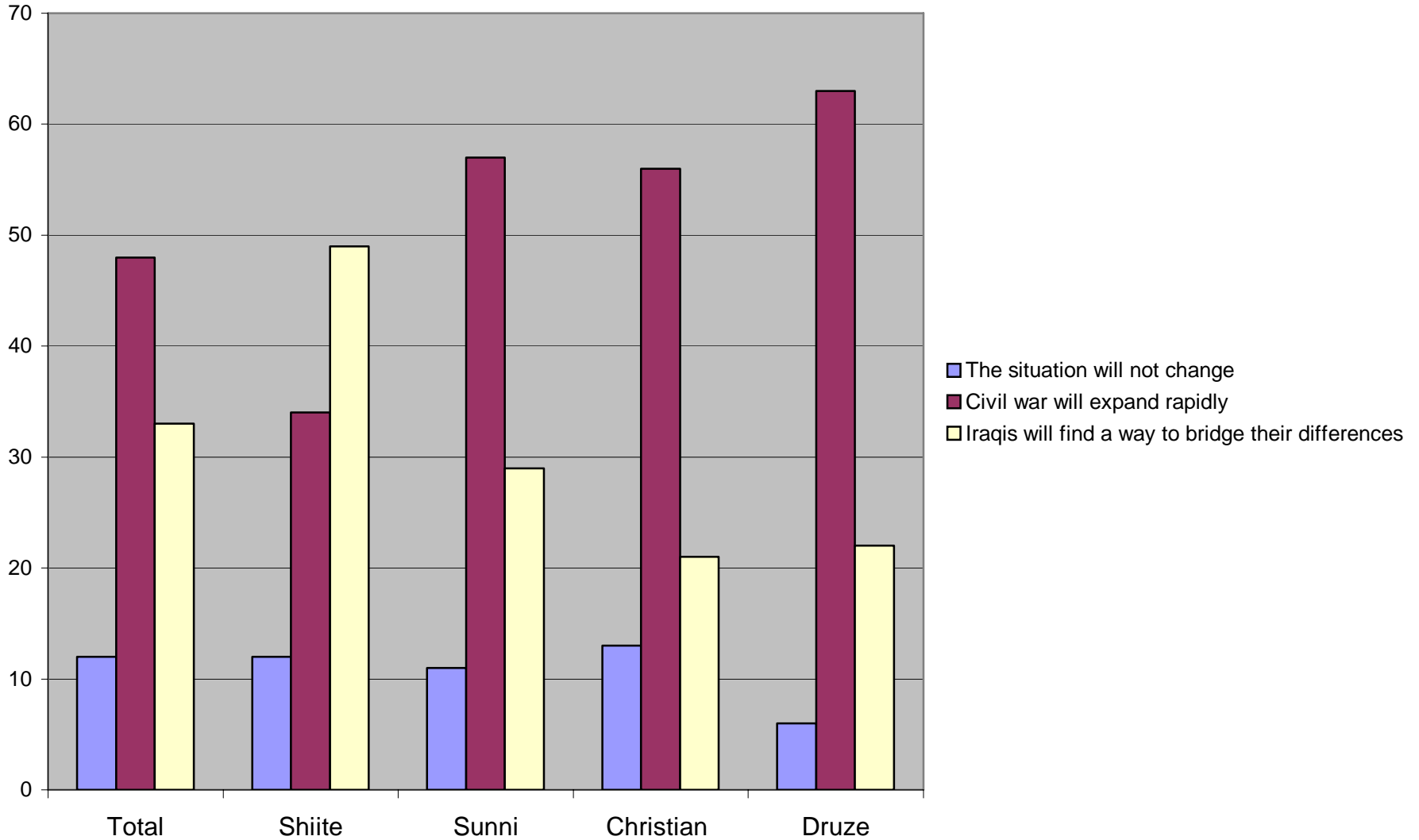

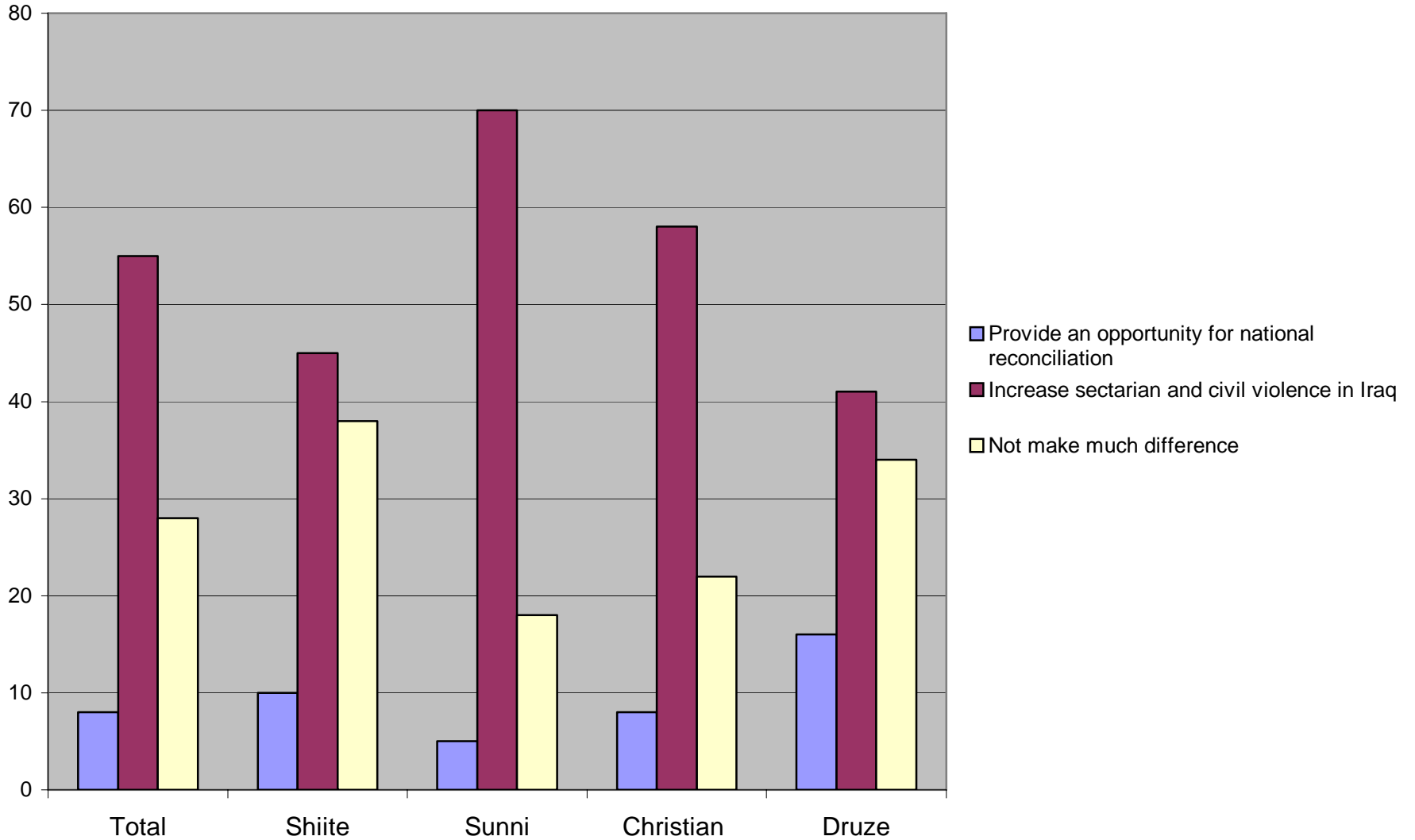
Which of the following is your biggest concern about the consequences of war with Iraq?



What do you believe would happen in Iraq if the US quickly withdrew its forces?

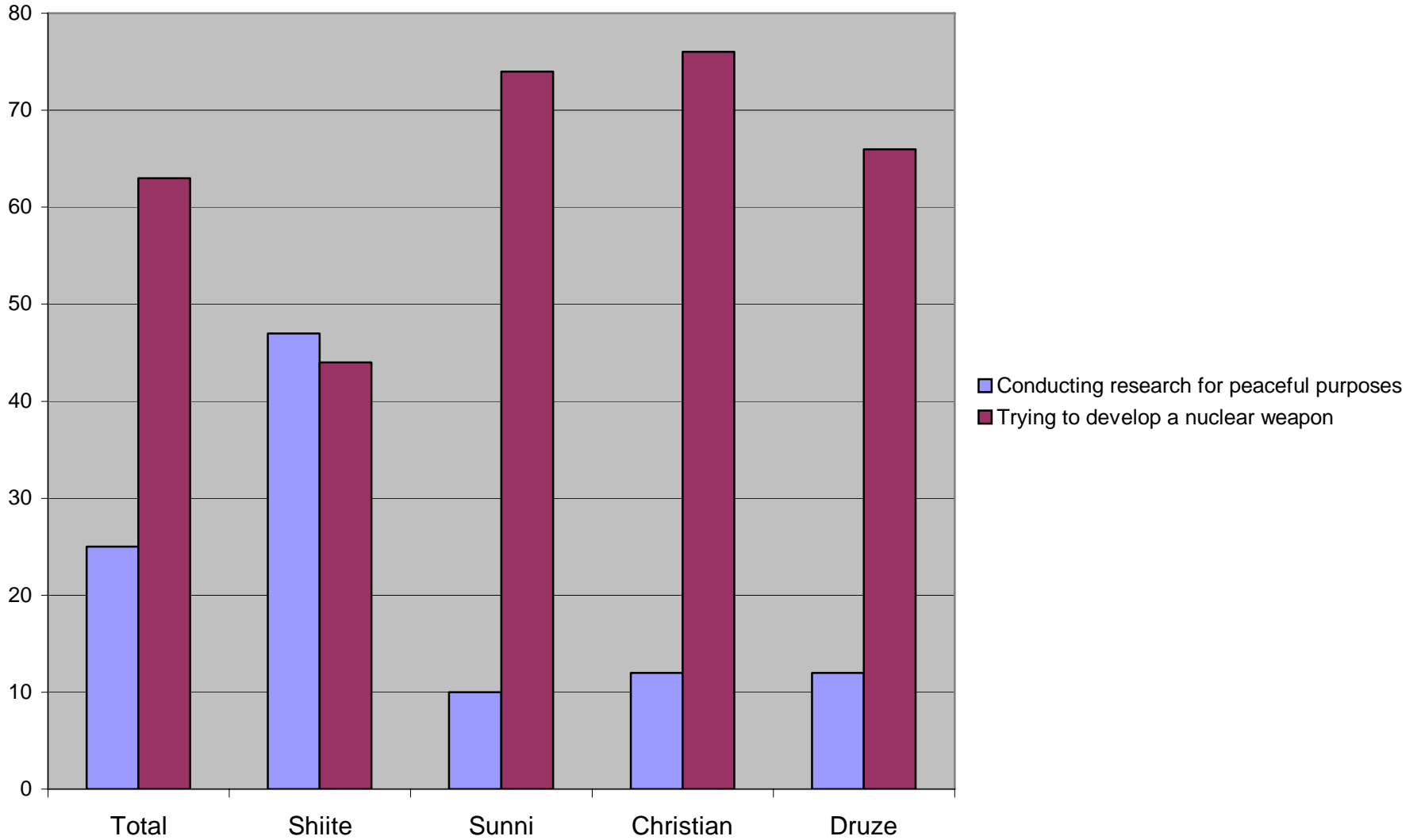


Do you believe that the recent sentencing of former Iraqi President Saddam Hussein will:

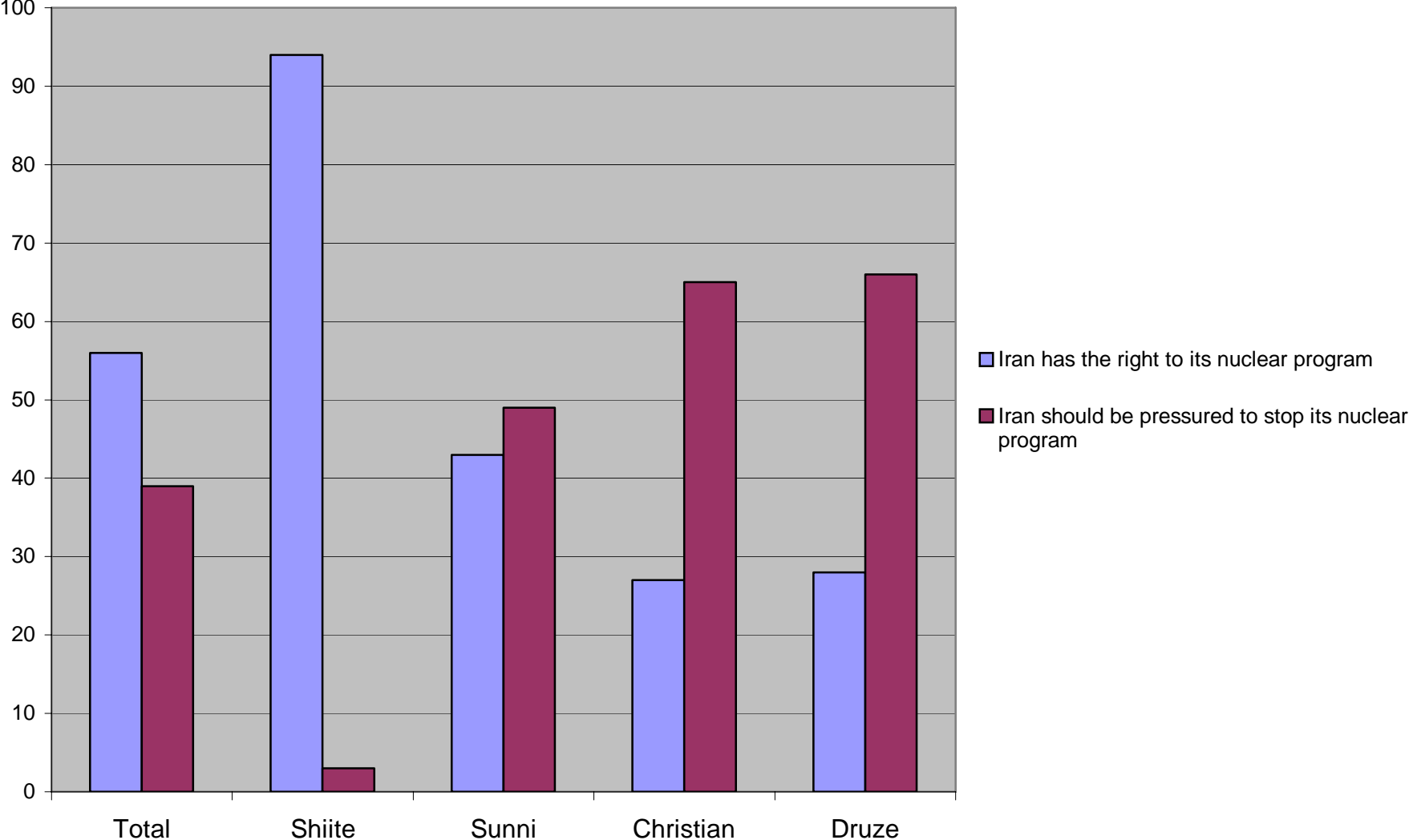

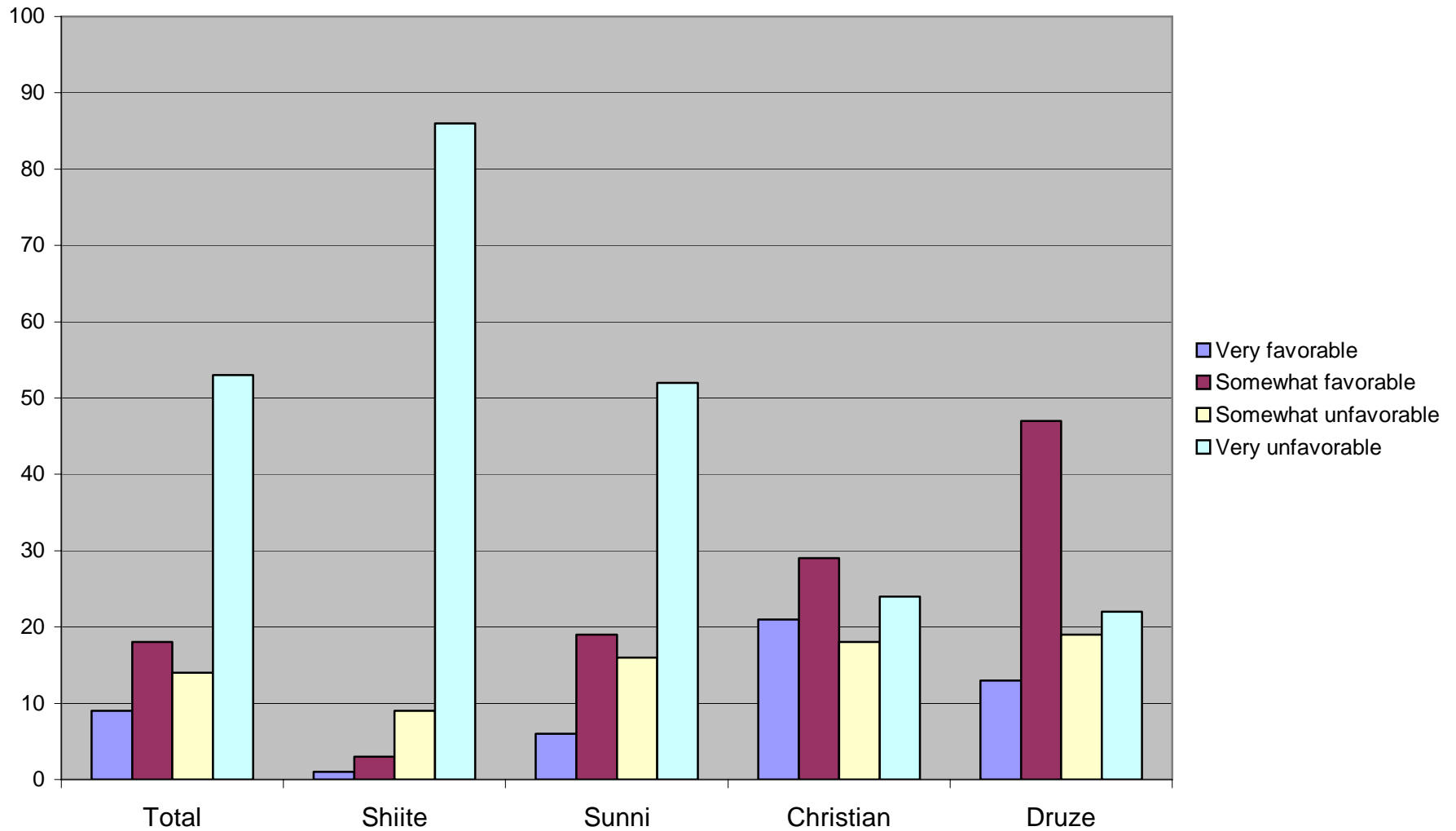


There is international pressure on Iran to curtail its nuclear program. What is your opinion?

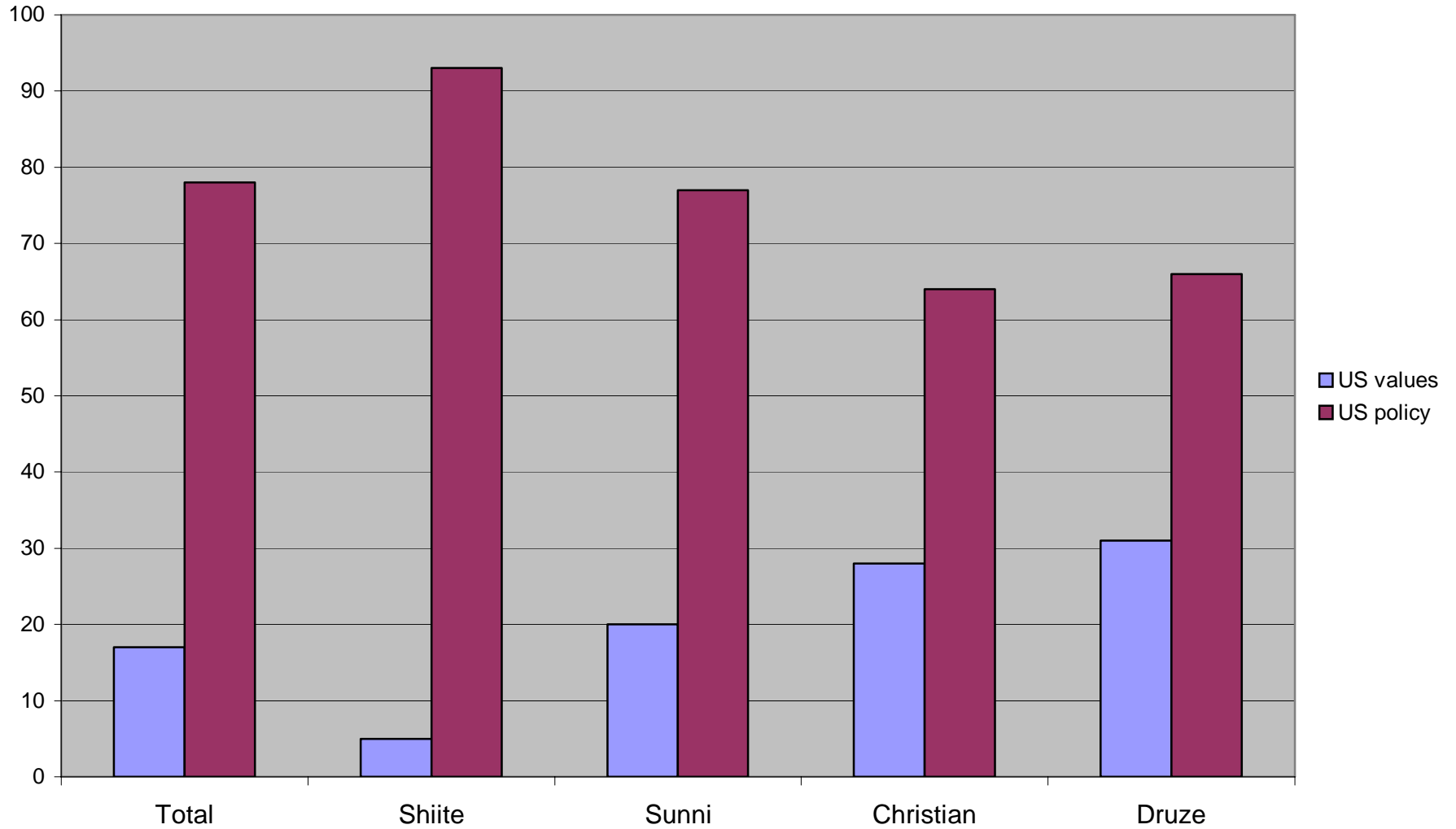

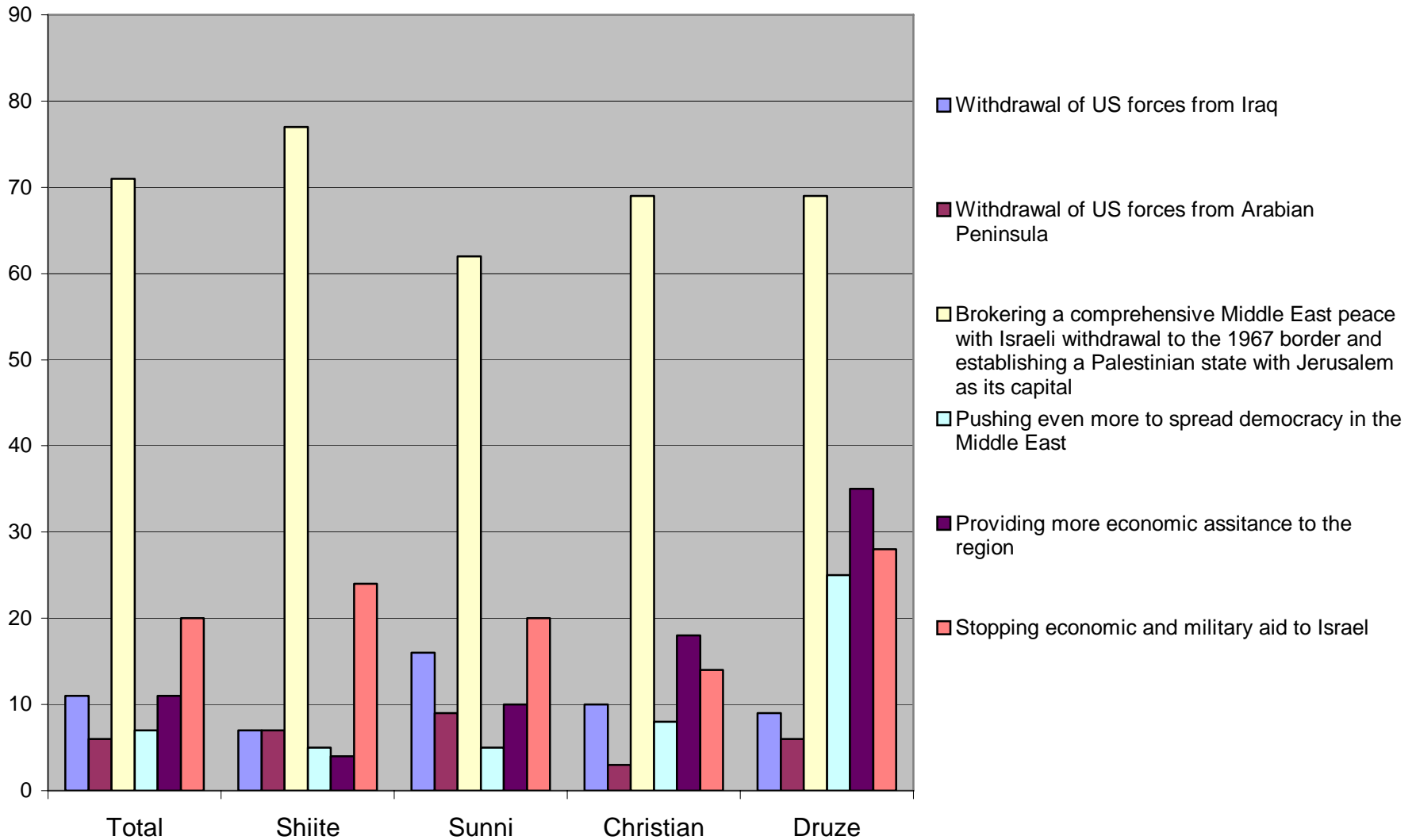
Generally speaking is your attitude towards the US very favorable, somewhat favorable, somewhat unfavorable, or very unfavorable?



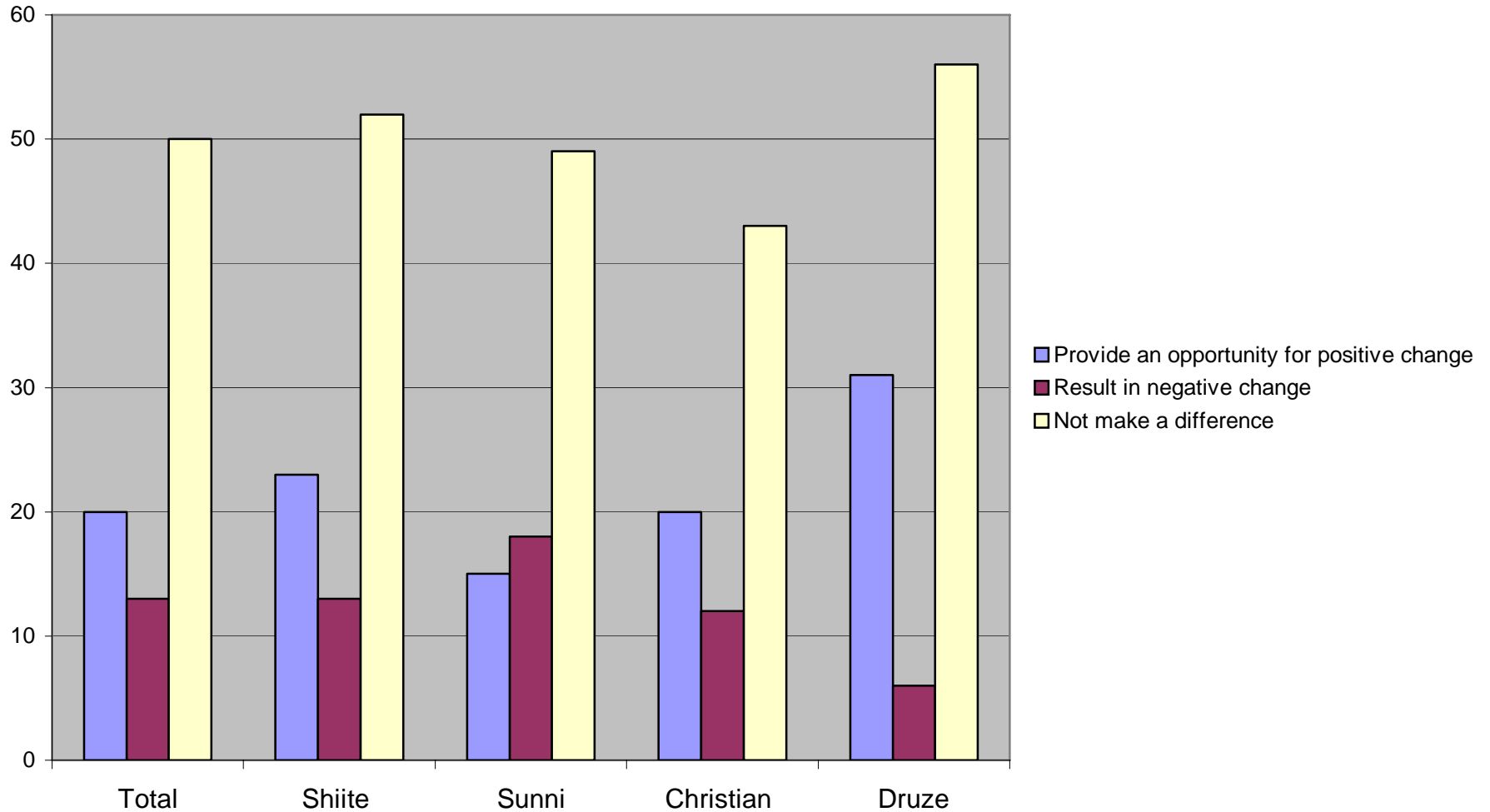
Would you say your attitudes toward the US are based more on US values or US policy in the Middle East?



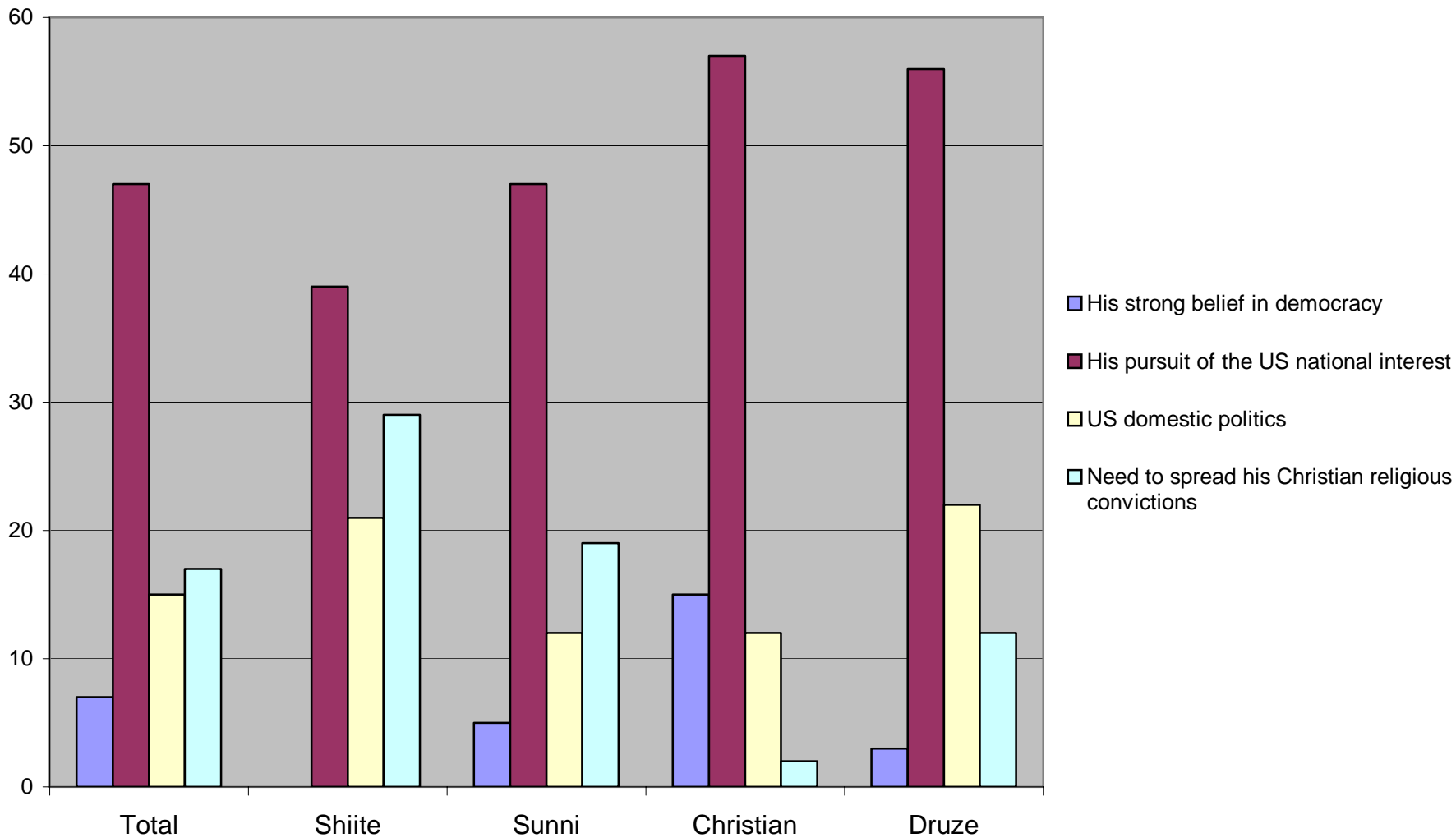
What step by the US would improve your views of the US most?



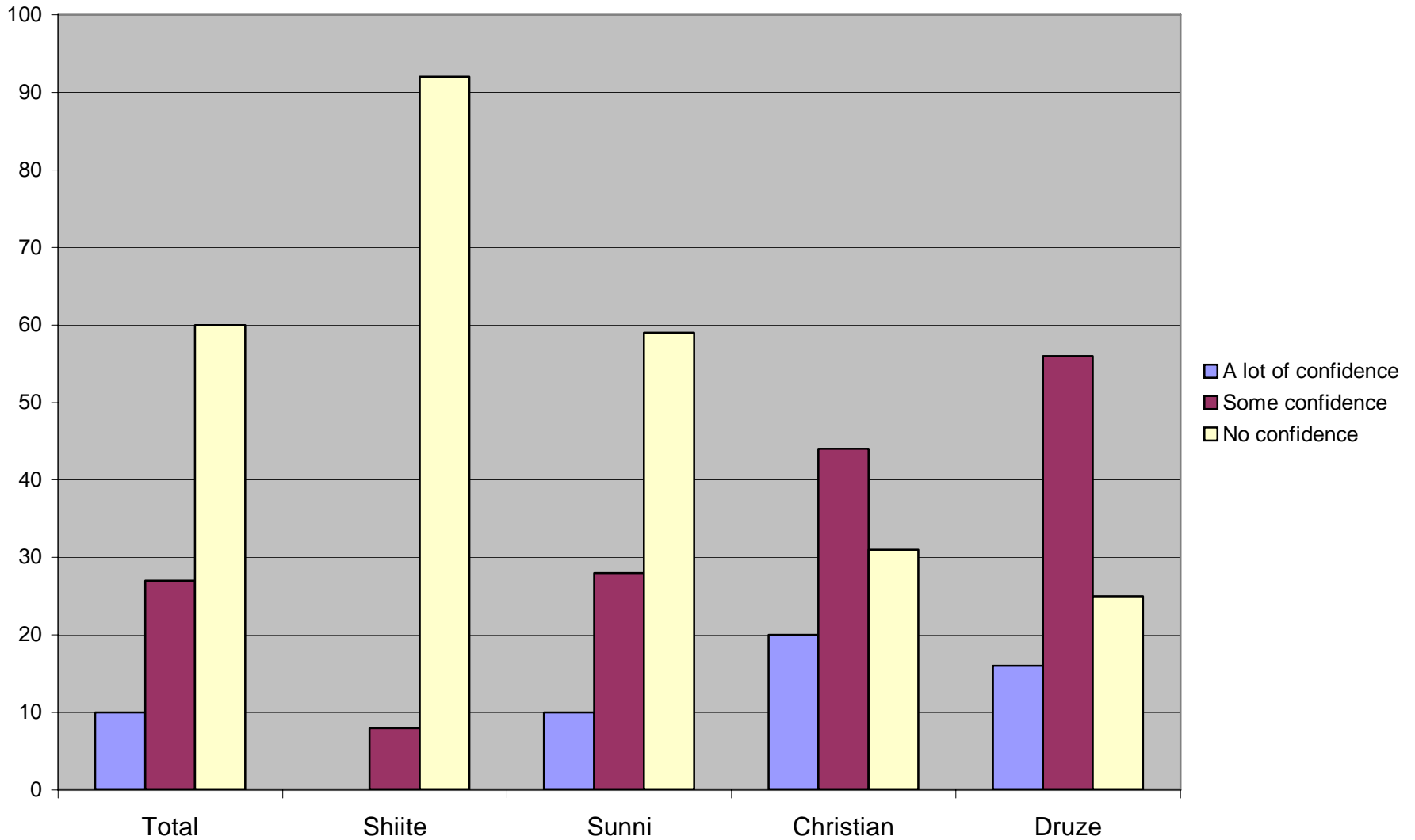

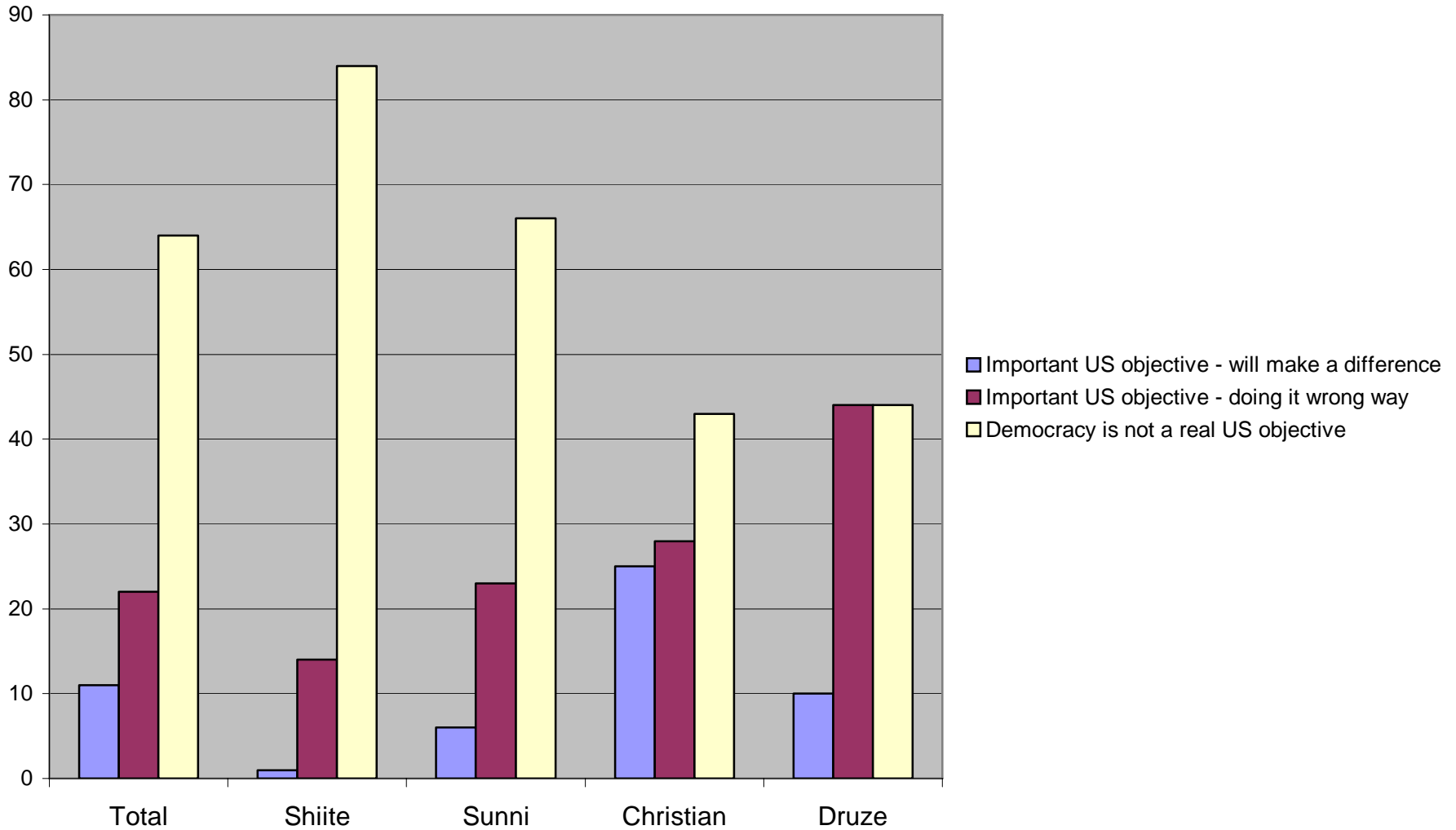
When you examine the Middle East policy of US President George W. Bush do you believe his primary motivation is:



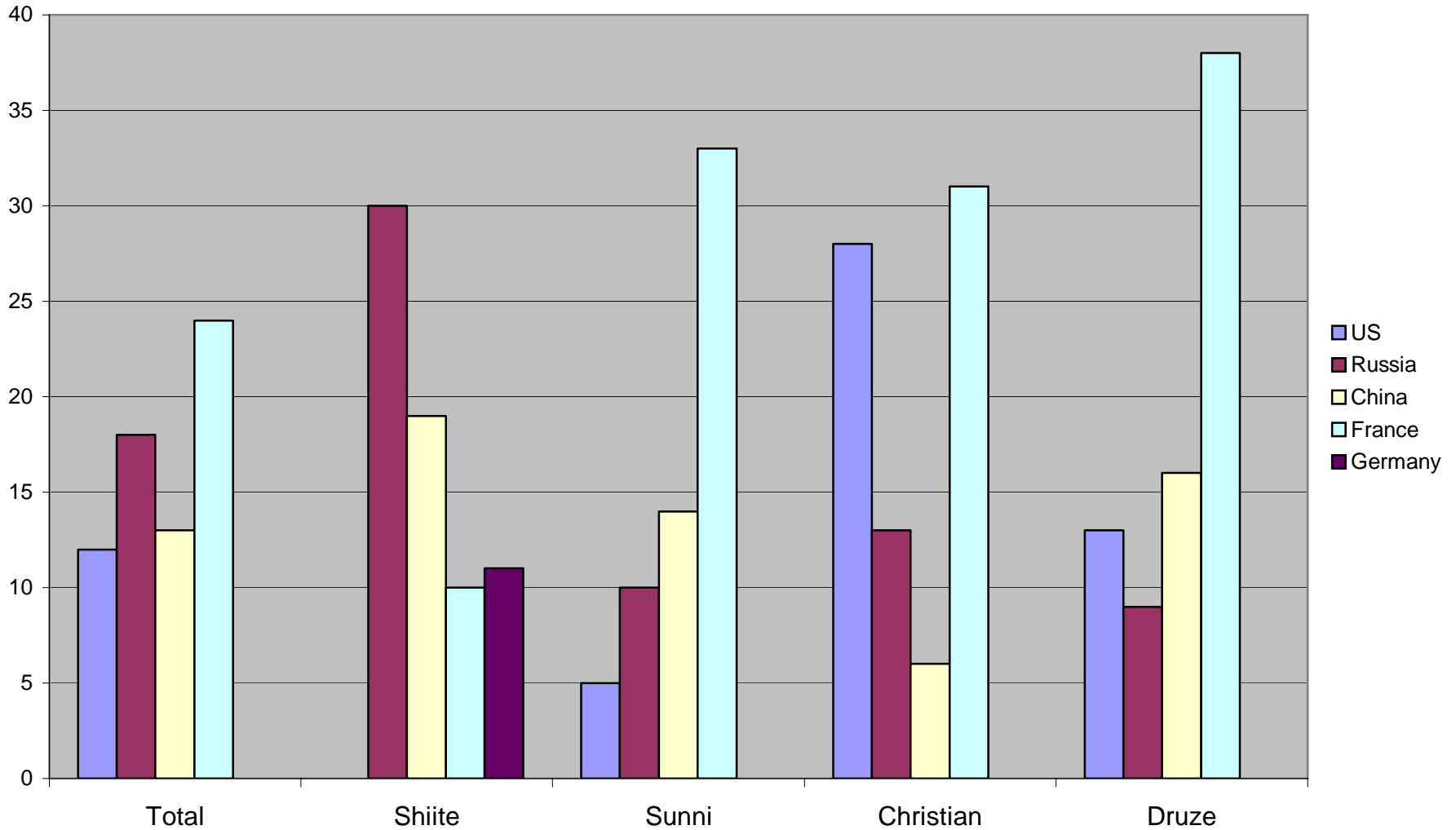
How much confidence do you have in the US?



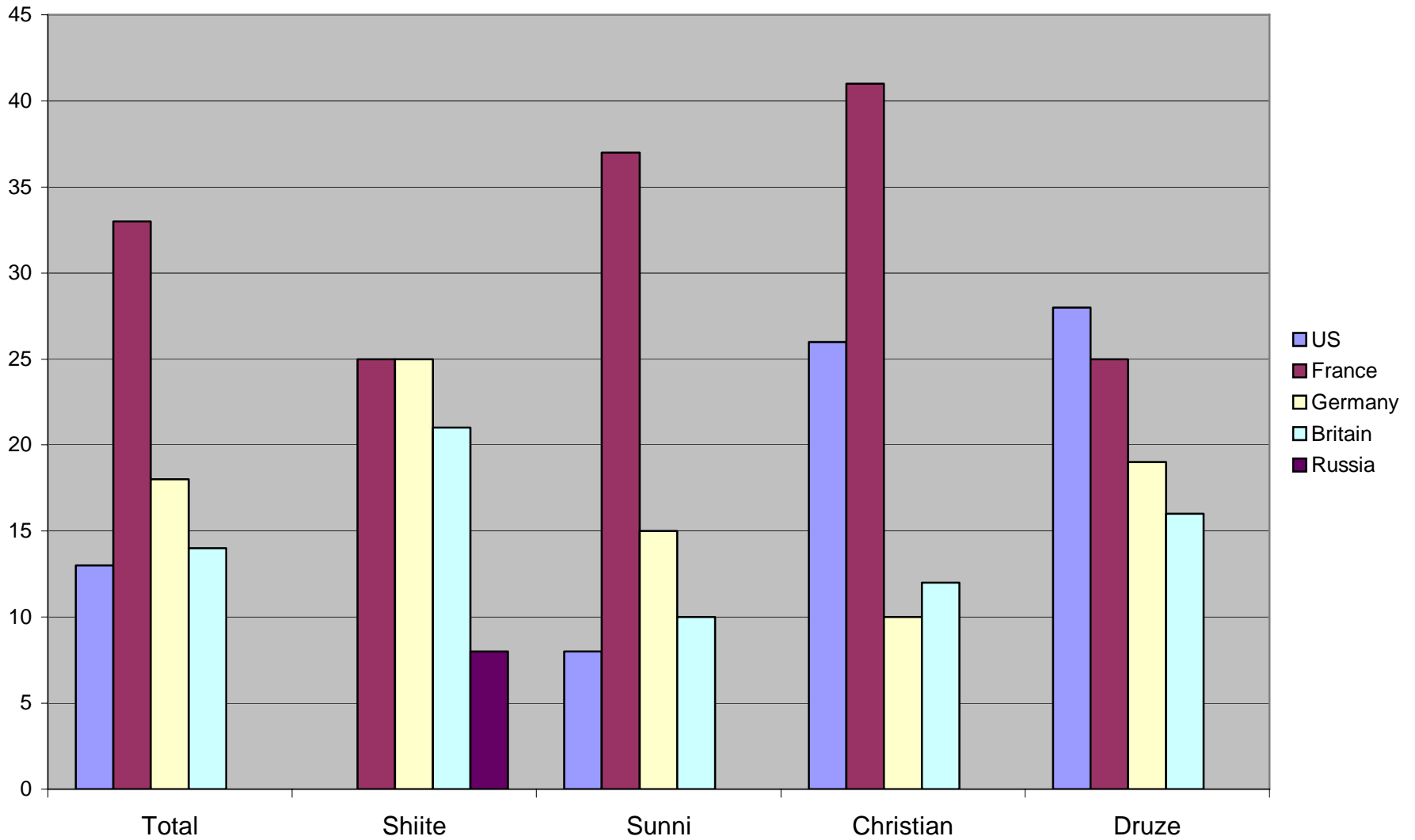

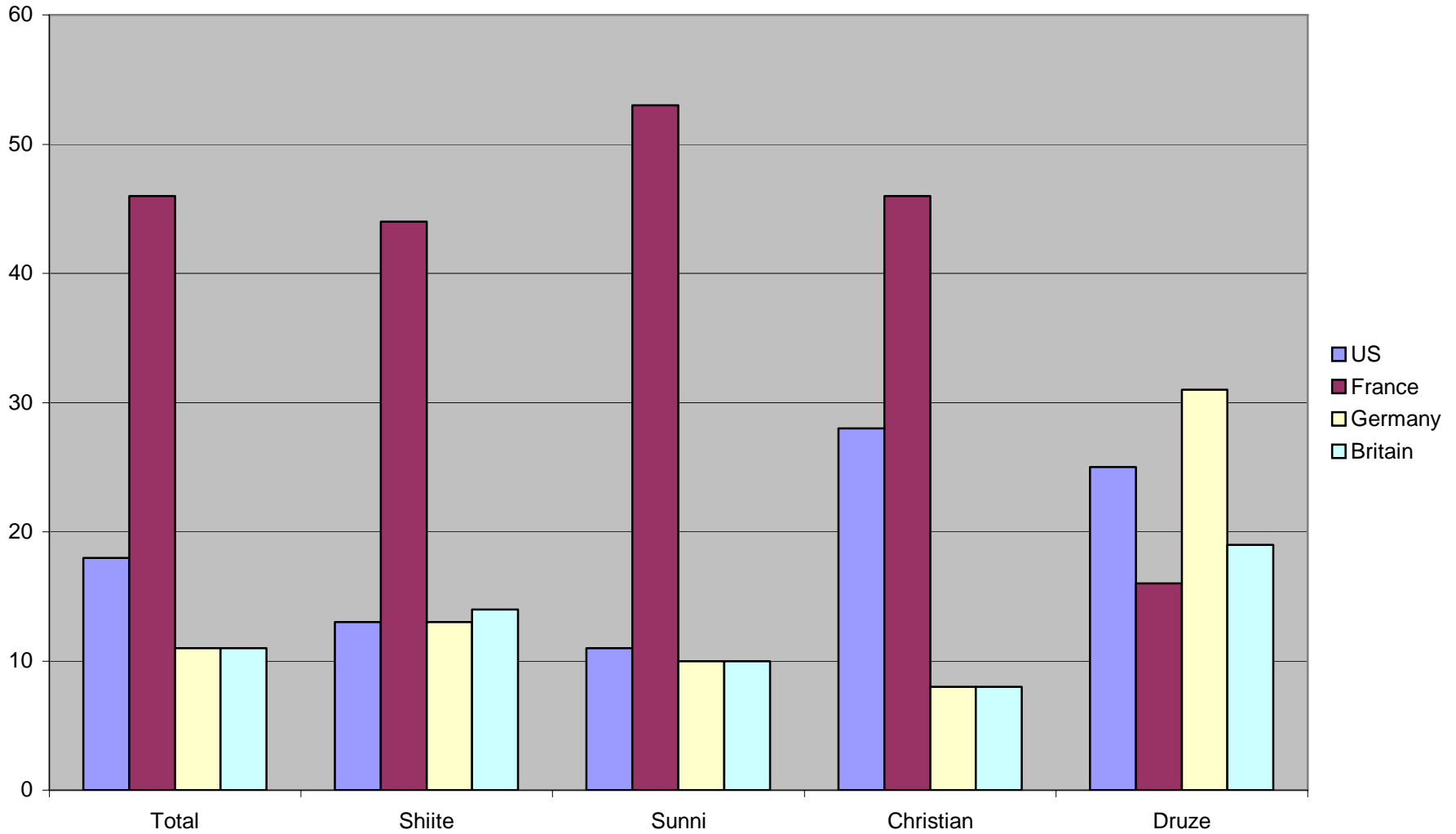
In a world where there is only one superpower which of the following countries would you prefer more than the others be that superpower?



If you had to live in one of the following countries which one would you prefer most?

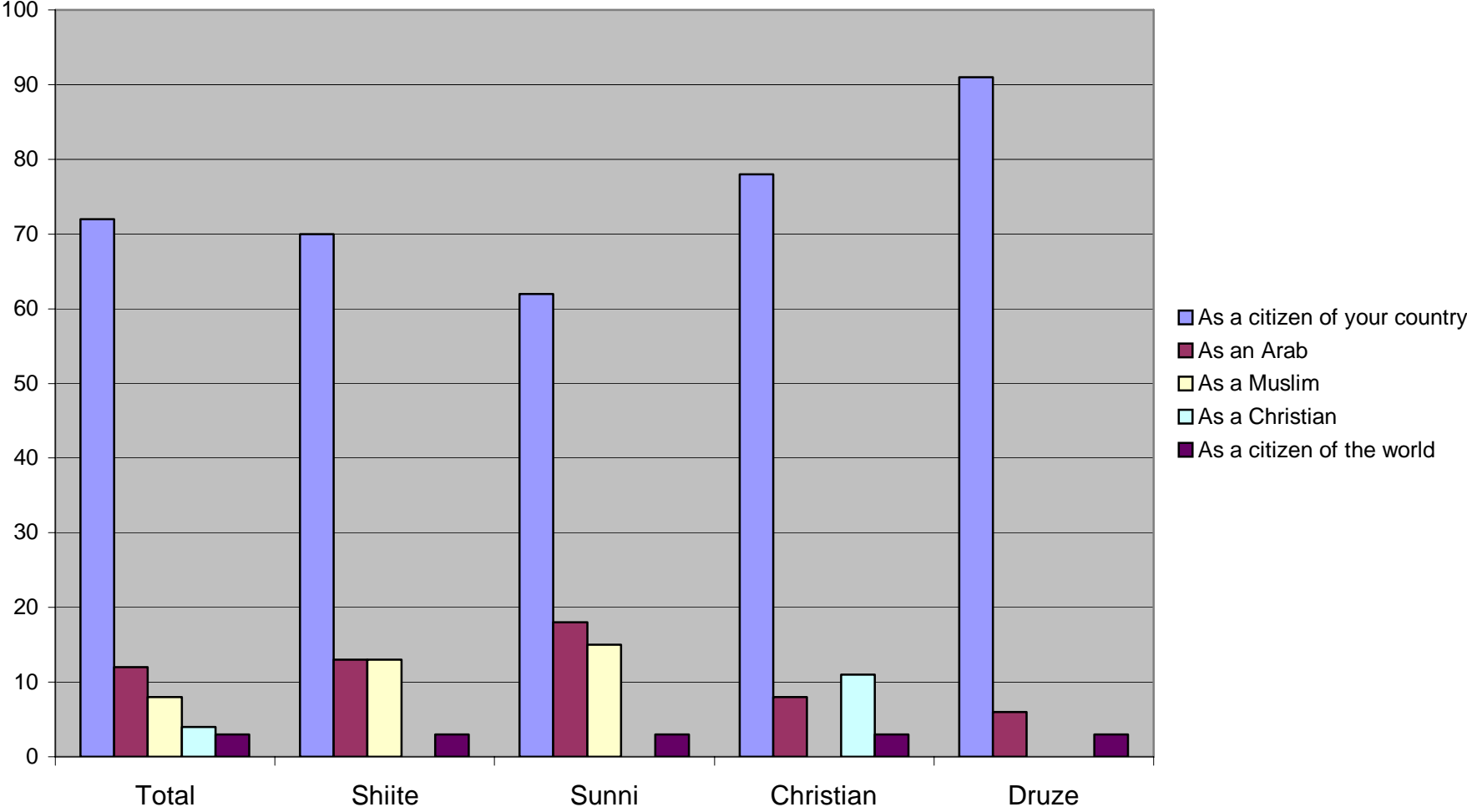

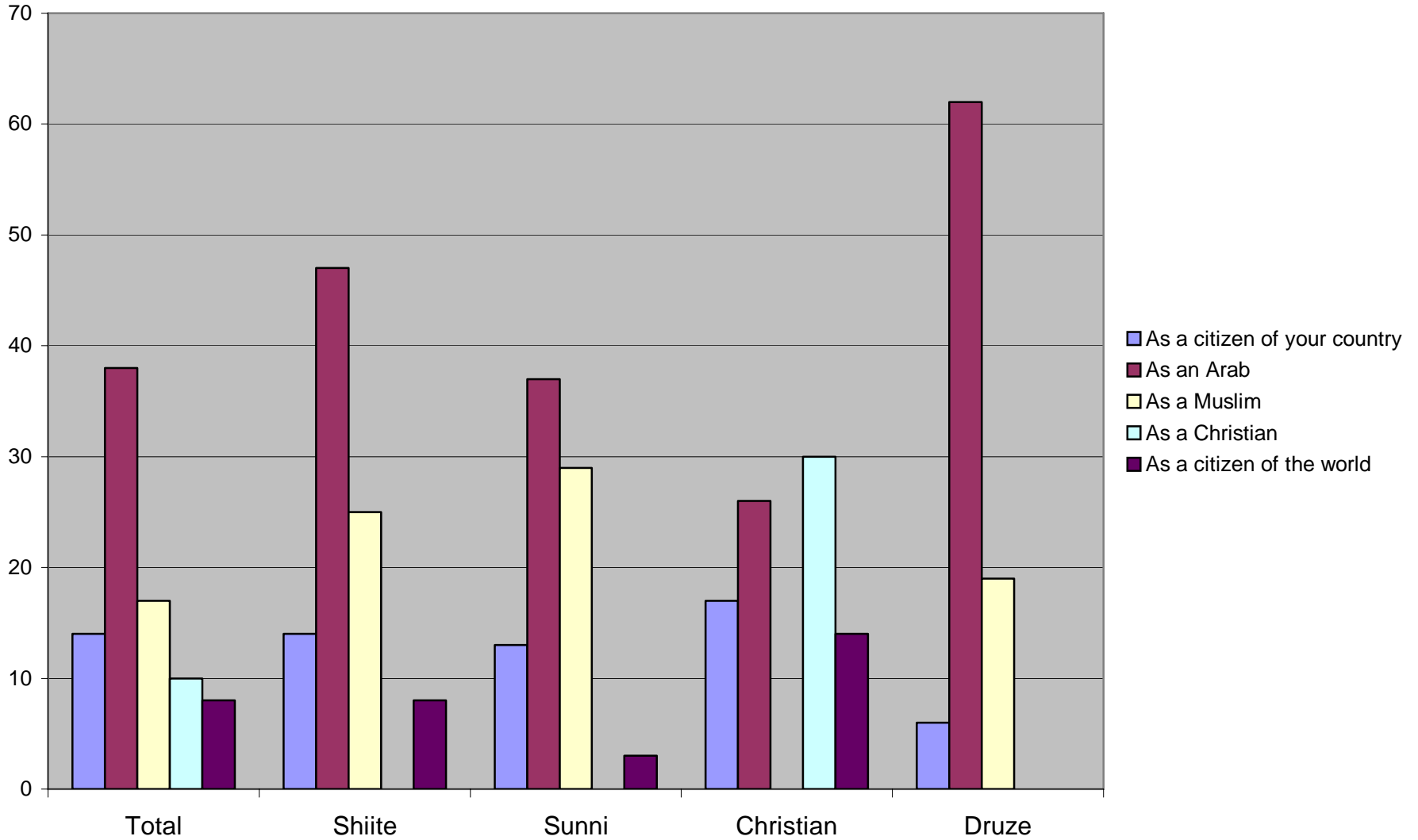

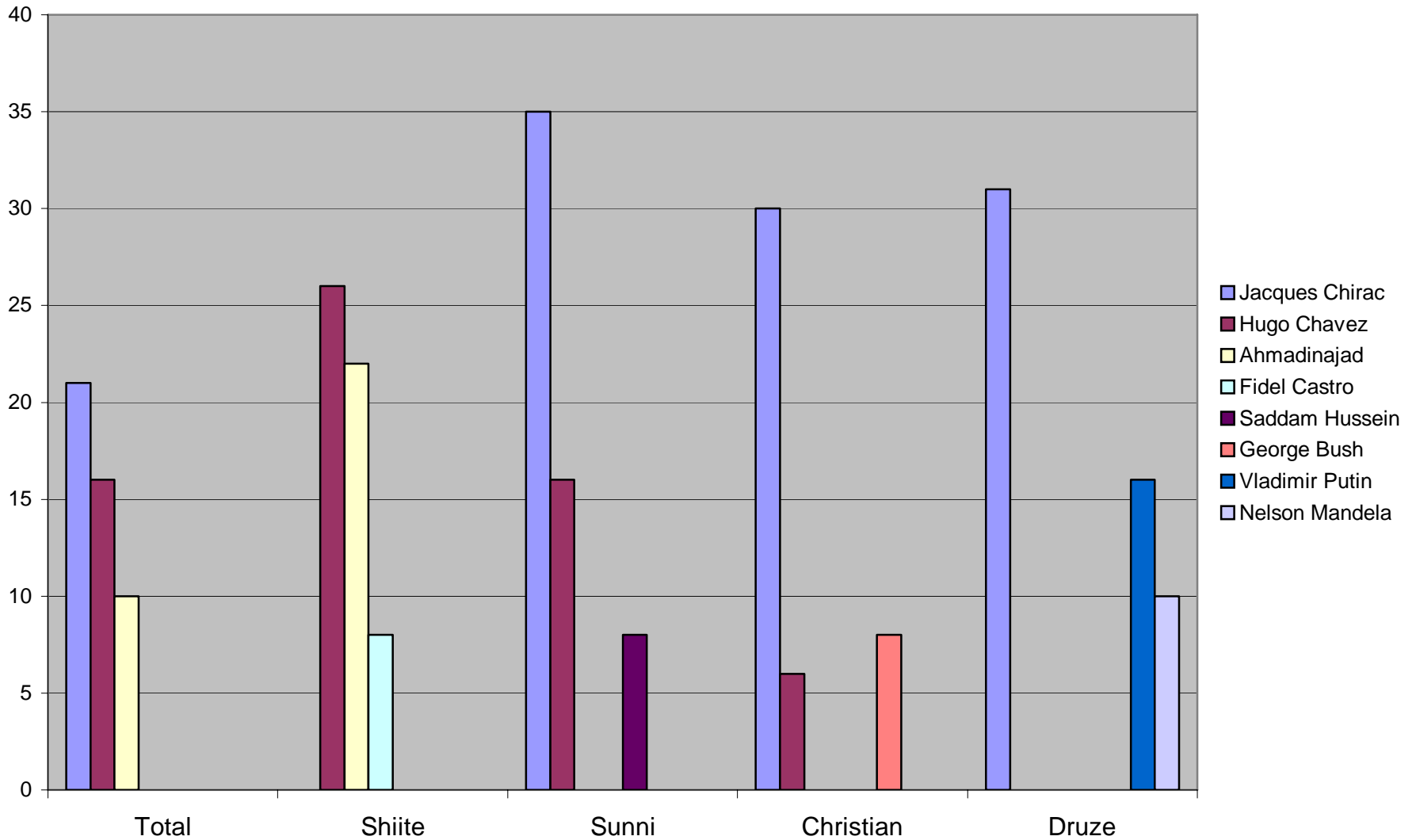
There are various aspects to one's sense of self or identity. Some are more important than others. When you think about yourself, which of the following is your most important identity?



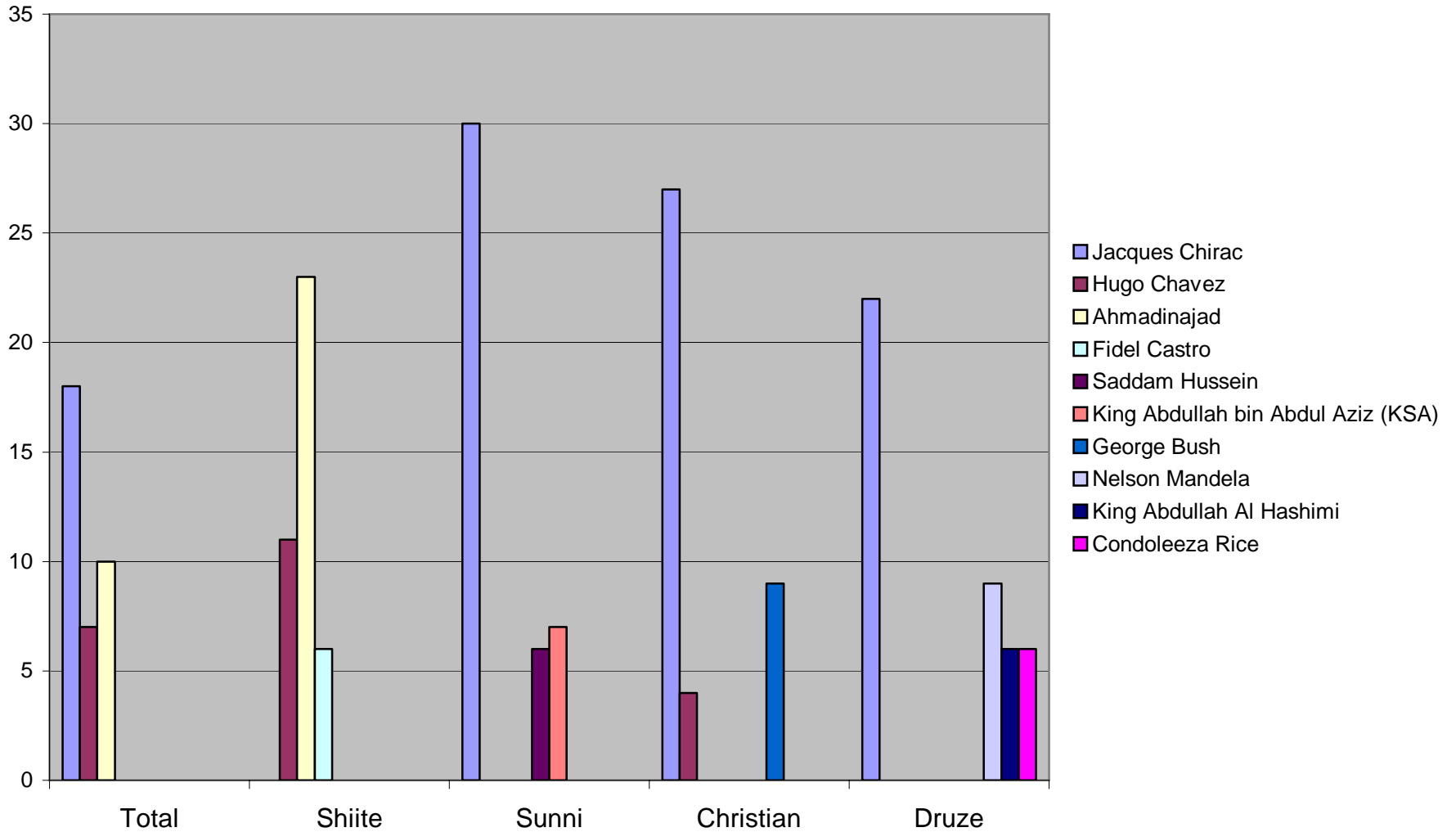
What is your second most important identity?



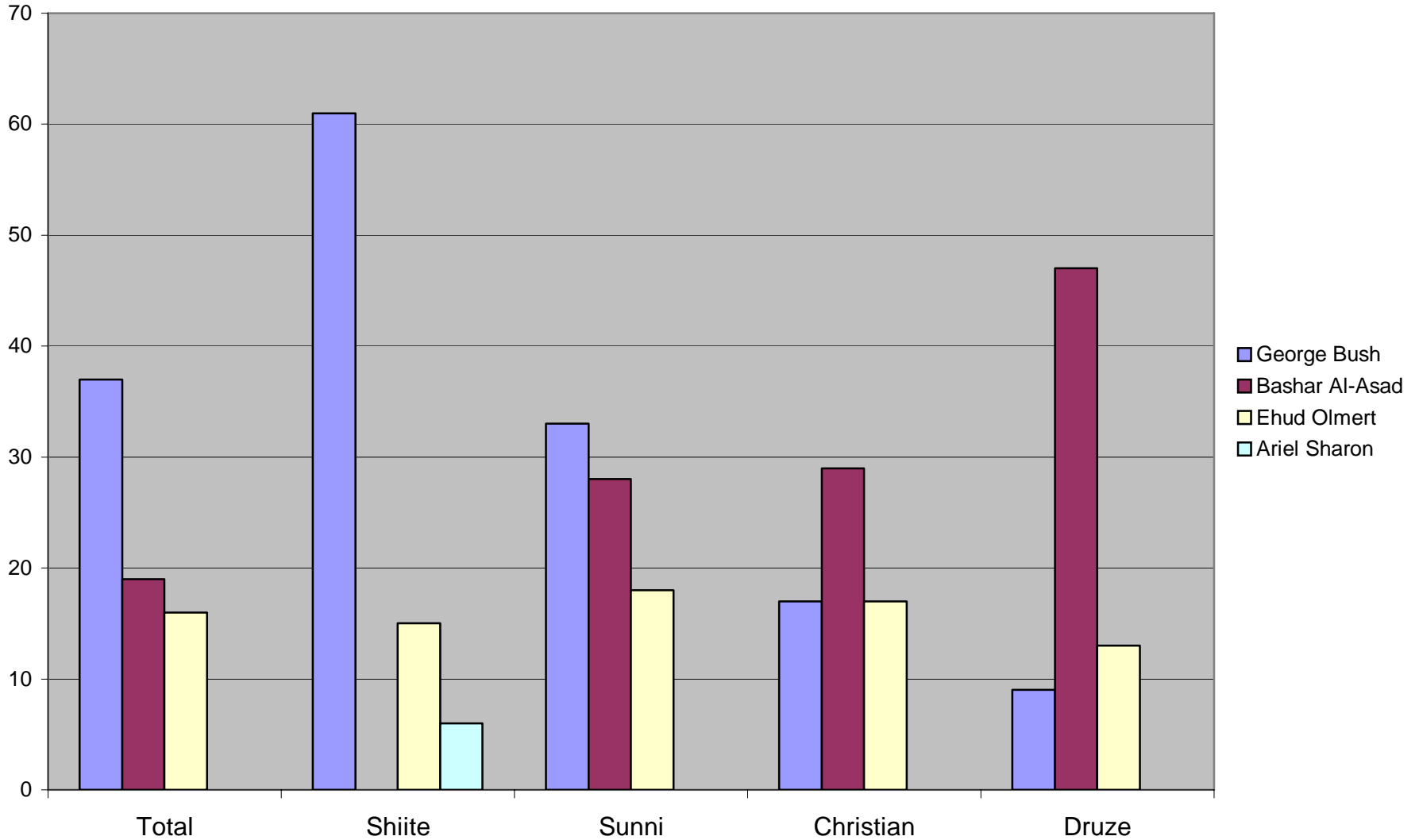
Please tell me which world leader (outside your own country) you admire most:



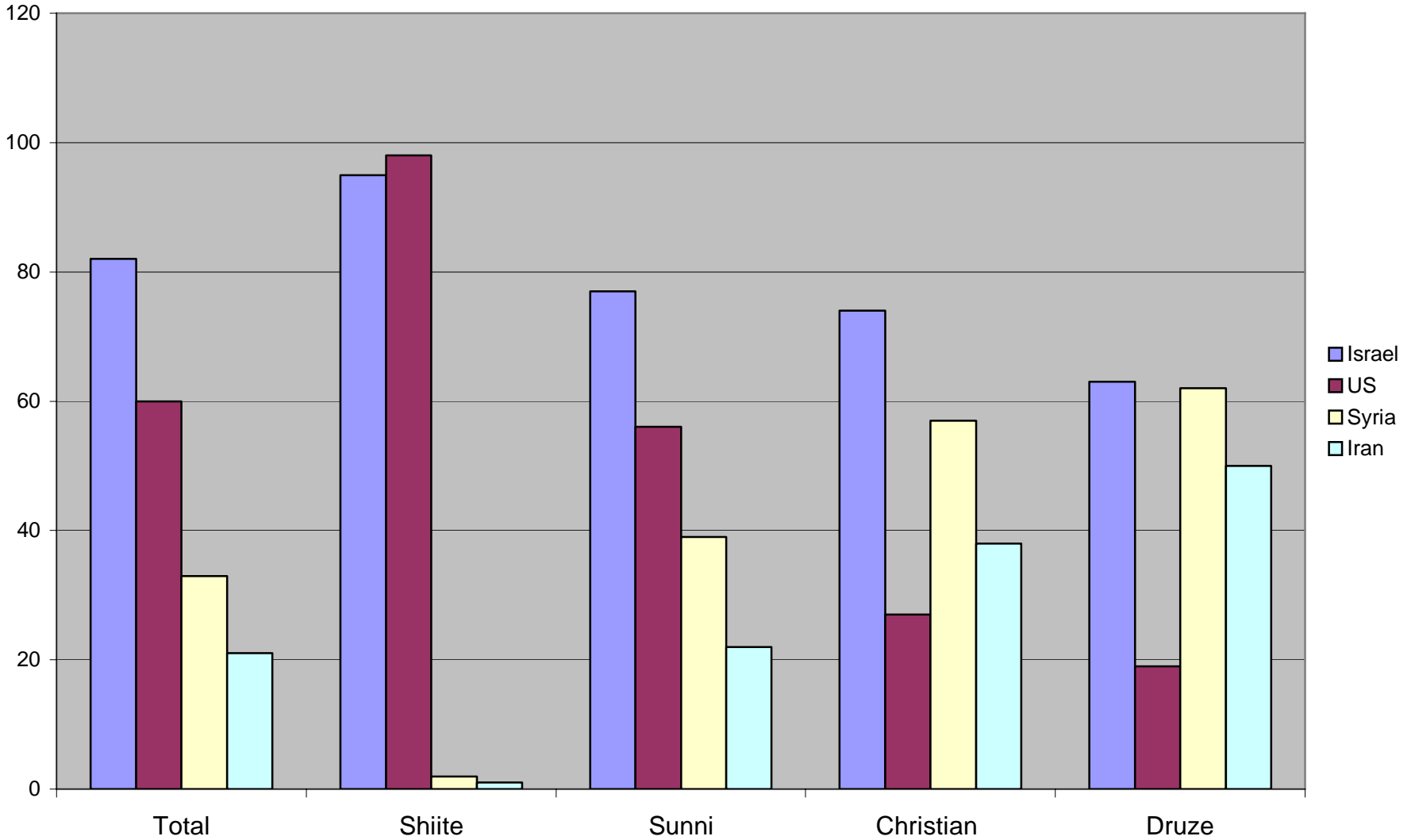
Please tell me which leader (outside your own country) you would prefer to rule over you and your family?



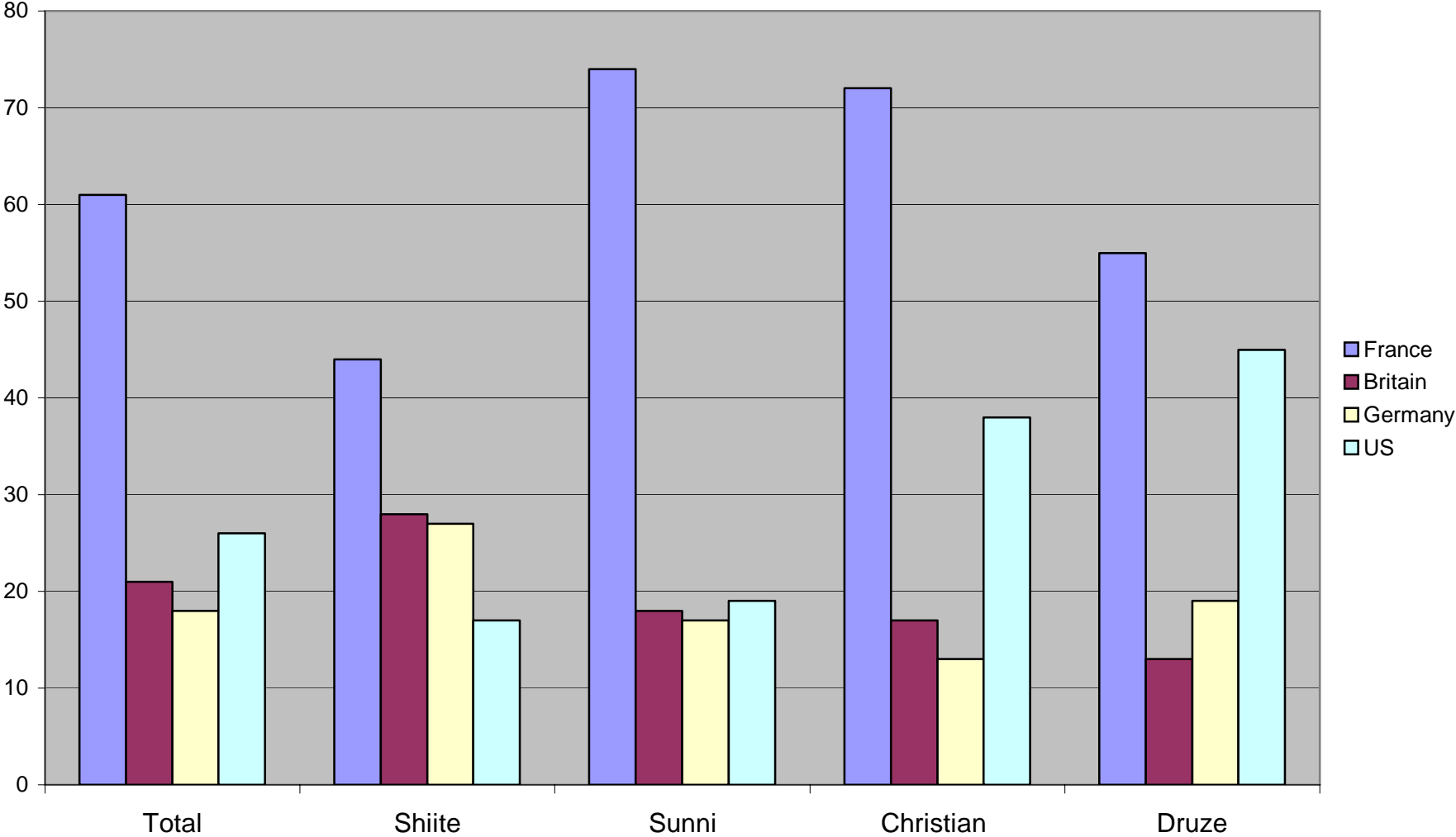
Please tell me which world leader (outside your own country) you dislike most:



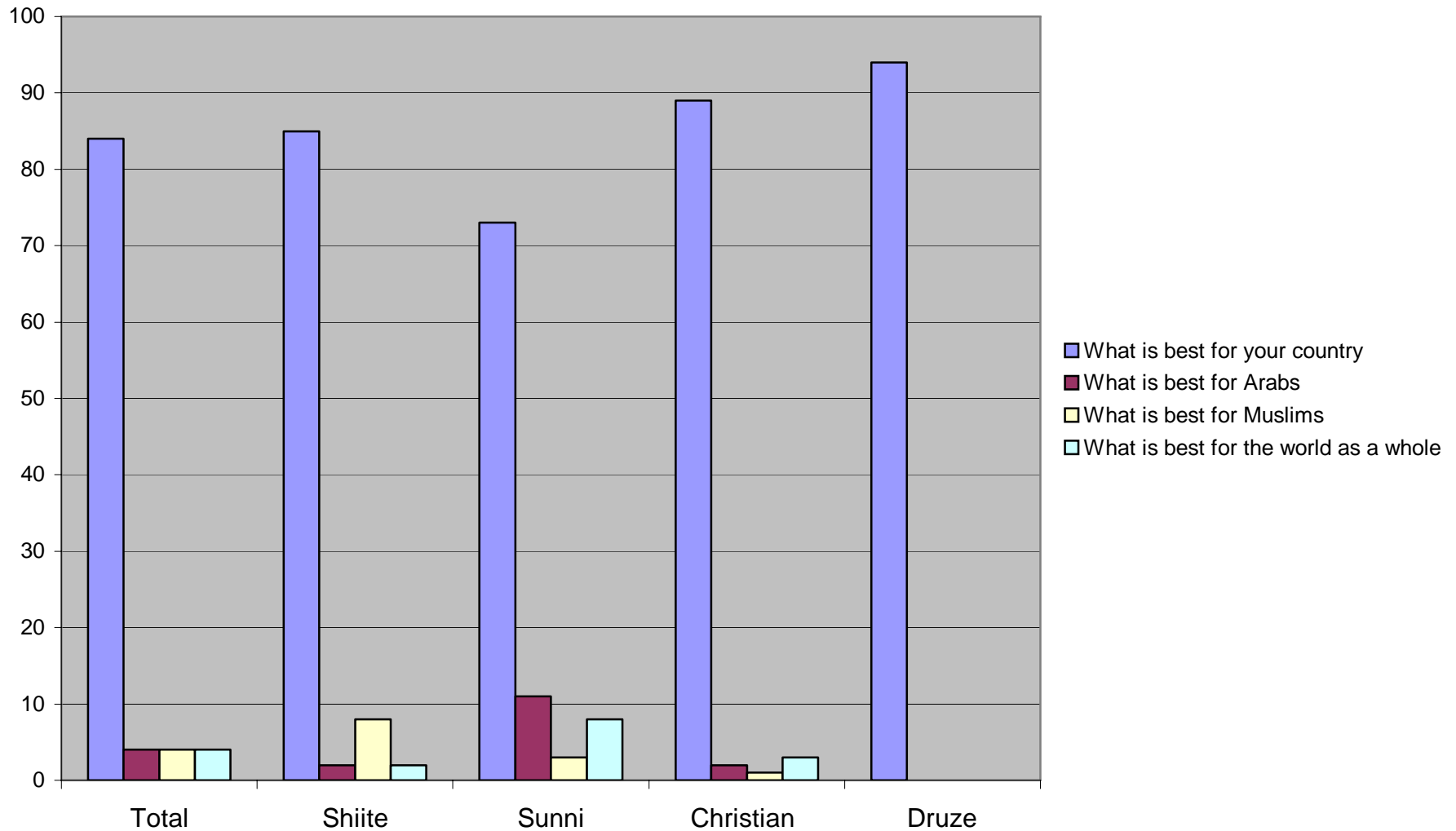

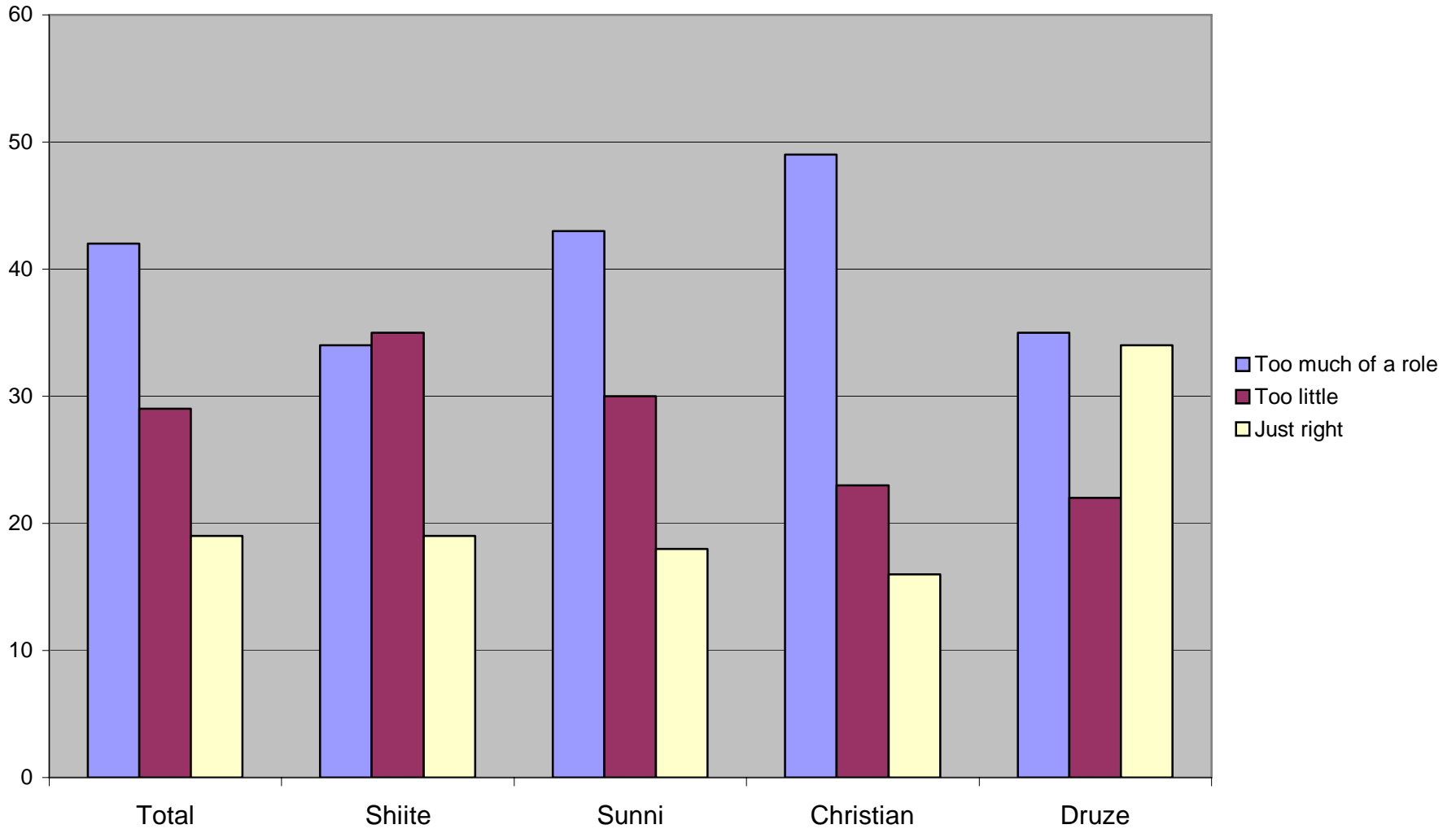
There are various concerns that governments must consider when making decisions. When your government makes decisions do you think they should be based mostly on:



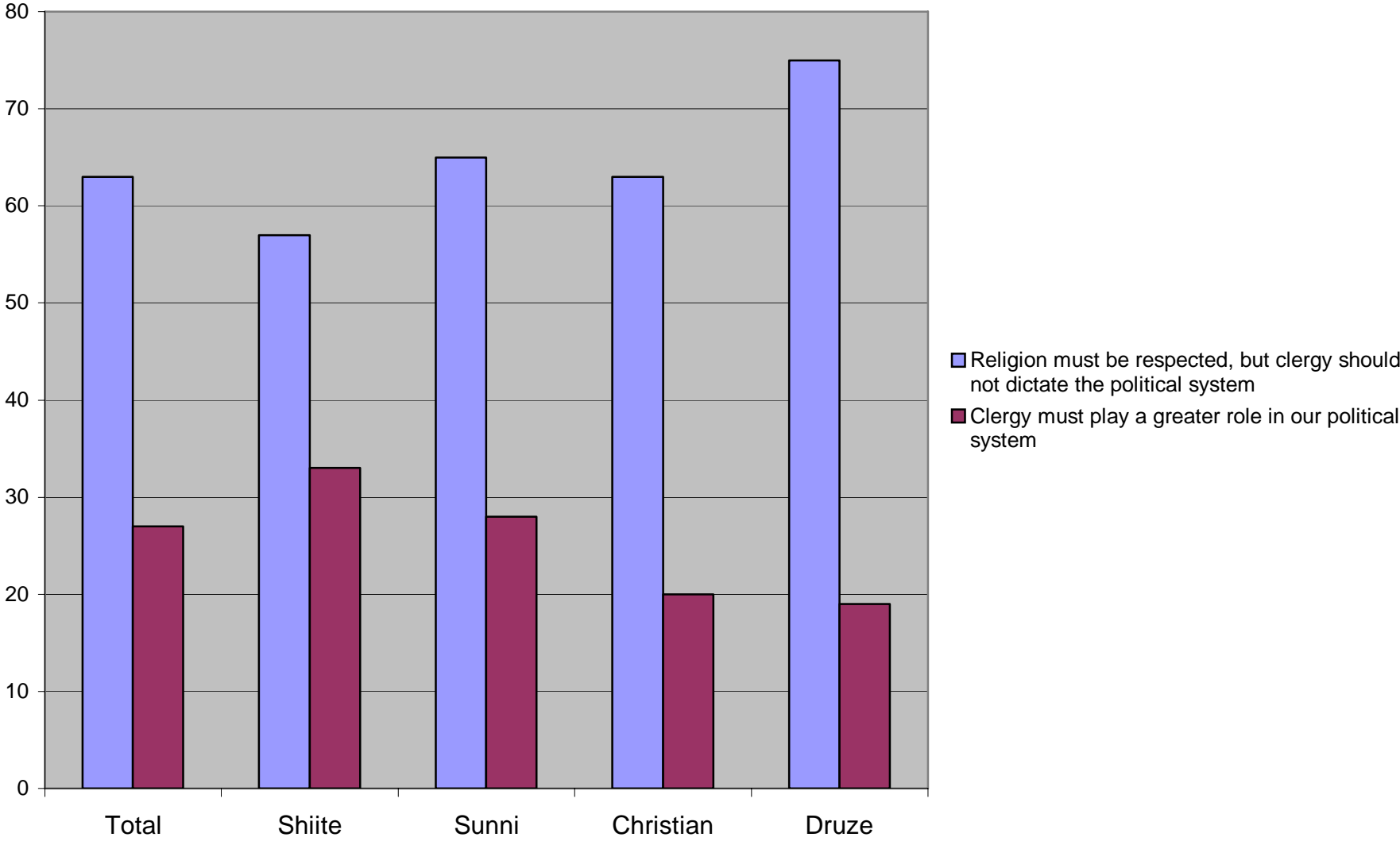

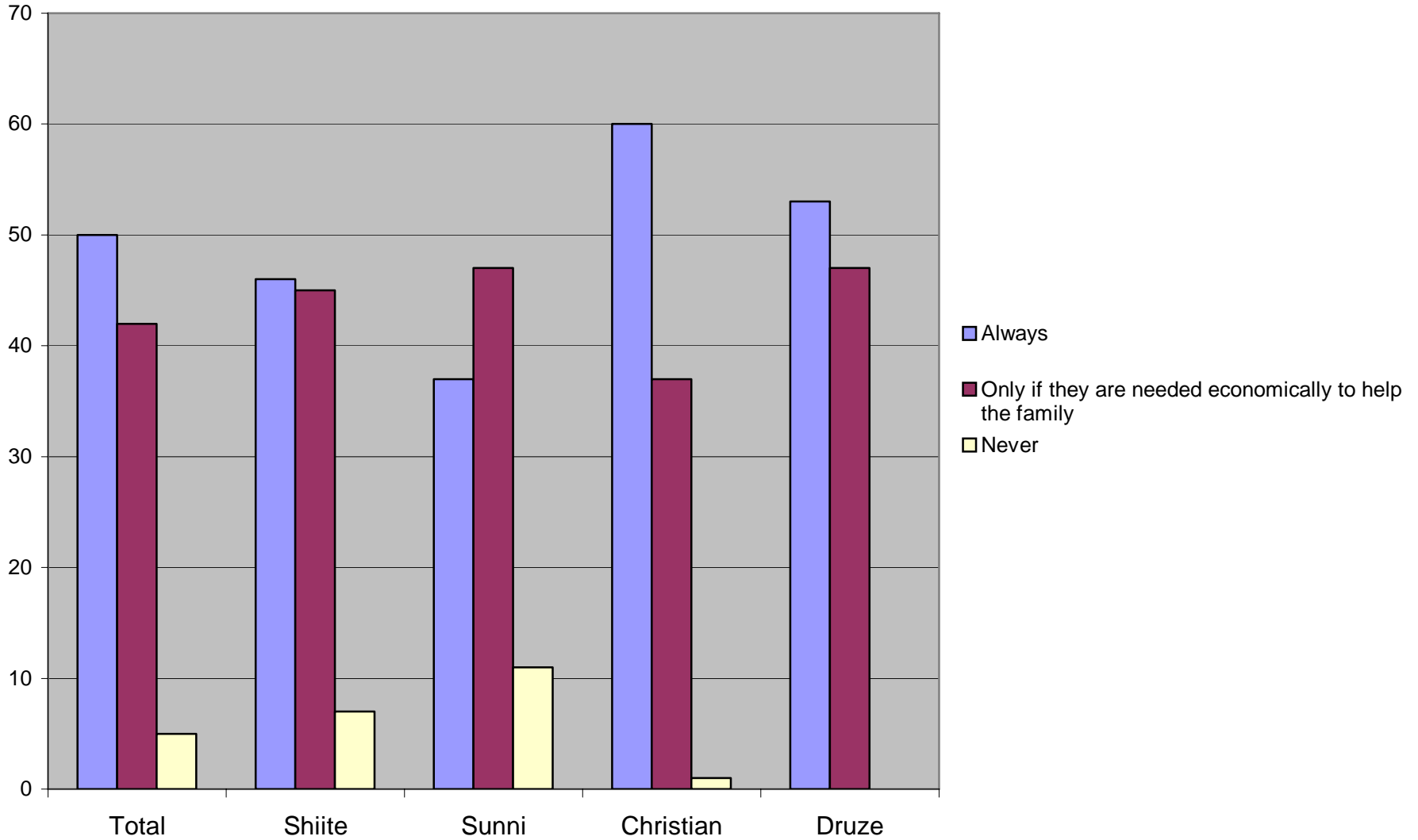
When you look at Arab countries today and think about government and politics, do you feel the clergy play too much of a role, too little or is it just right?



Which do you agree with more:

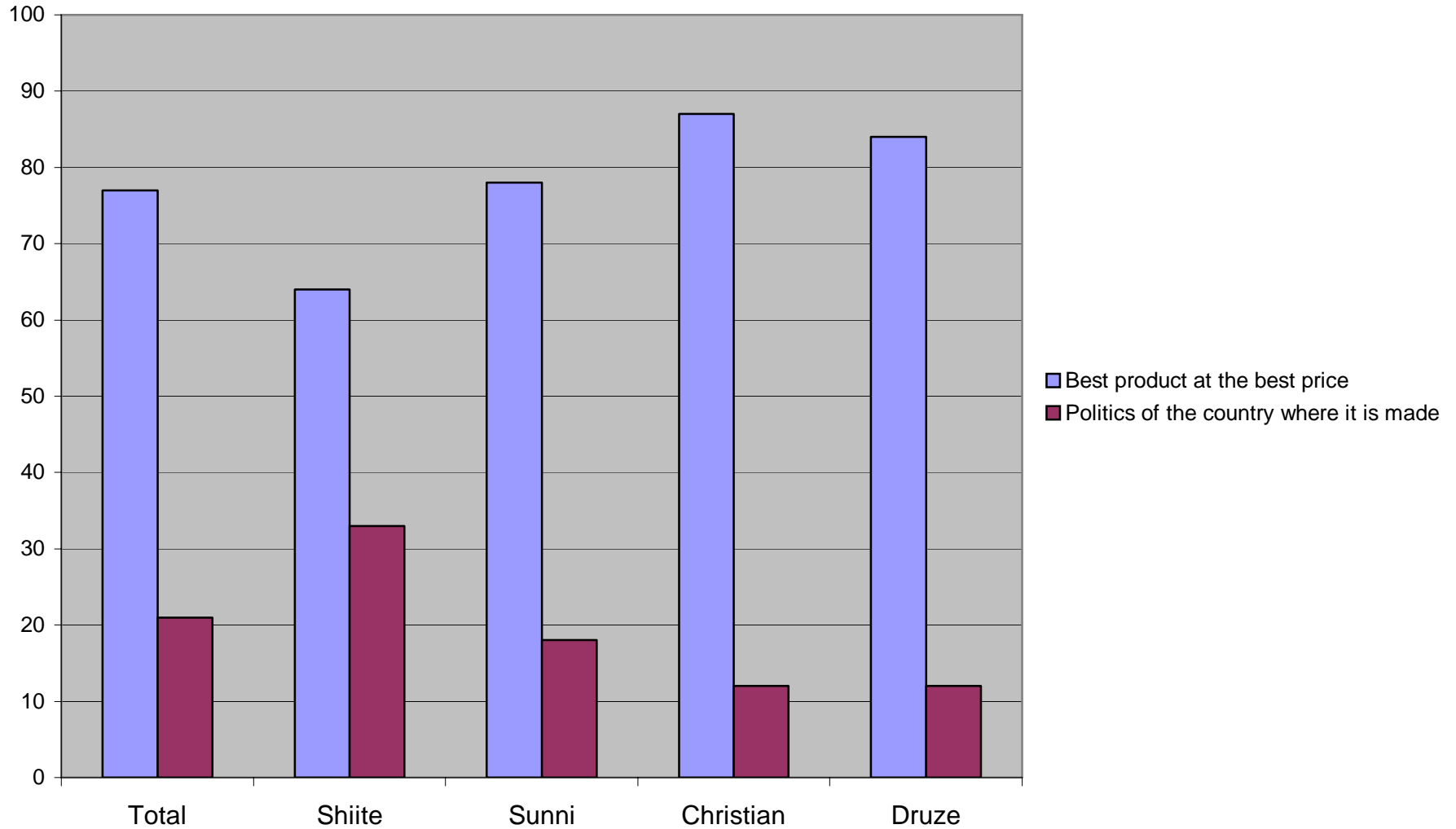


Do you think women should have the right to work outside the home?

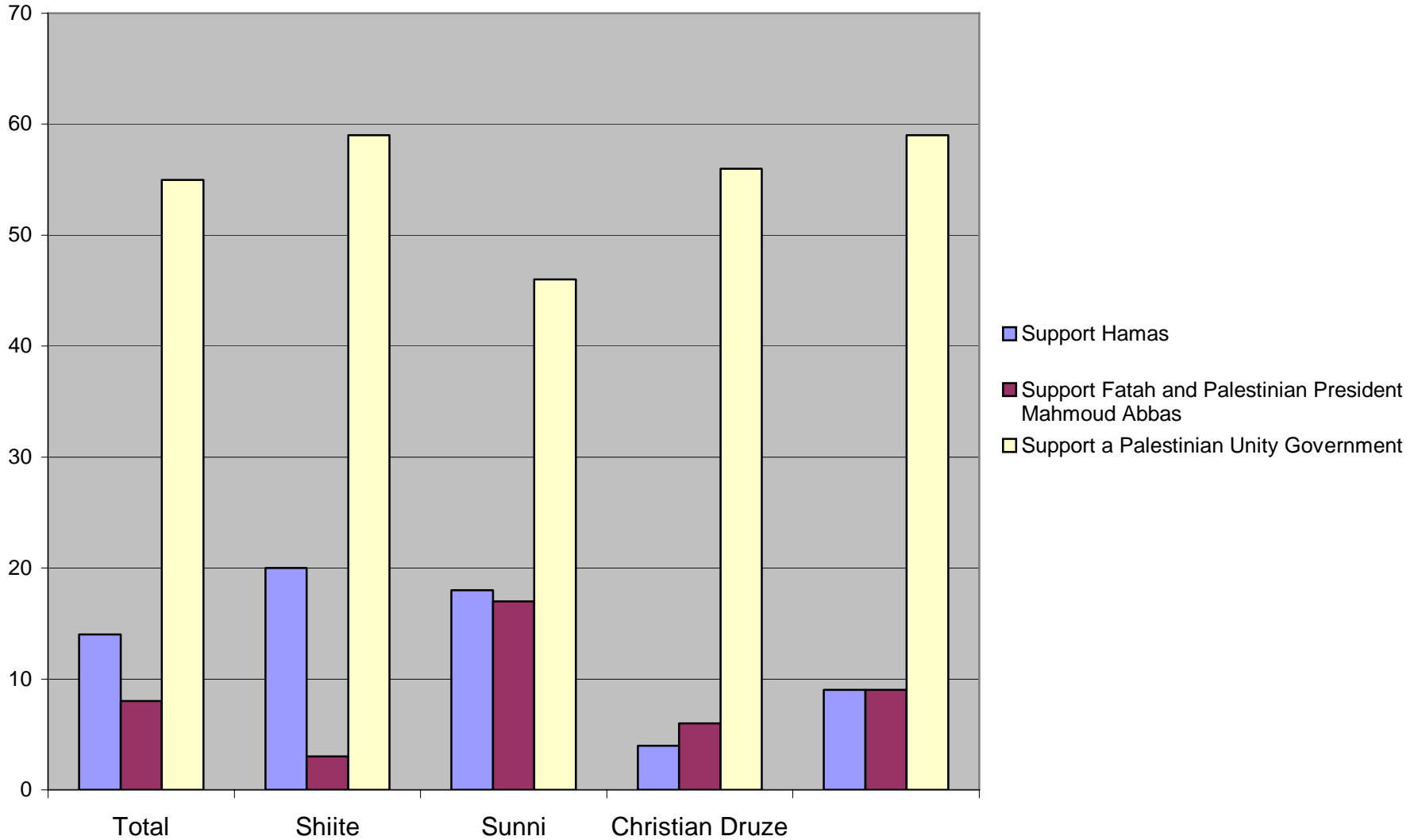
