




#### Who is the Target Audience for the Guide?

- >Gender is a cross-sectoral issue.








#### ADAPT and ACT-C Checklist


#### **ADAPT** and **ACT** Collectively to ensure gender equality

- Analyse gender differences
- Design services to meet the needs of all
- Access for women, girls, boys and men is provided equally
- Participate equally to ensure gender balance
- Train women and men equally and
- Address GBV in education and humanitarian emergency efforts
- Collect, analyse and report sex- and age-disaggregated data
- Target actions based on a gender analysis.
- **Collectively** coordinate actions with all partners
