EQUIP2 Objectives

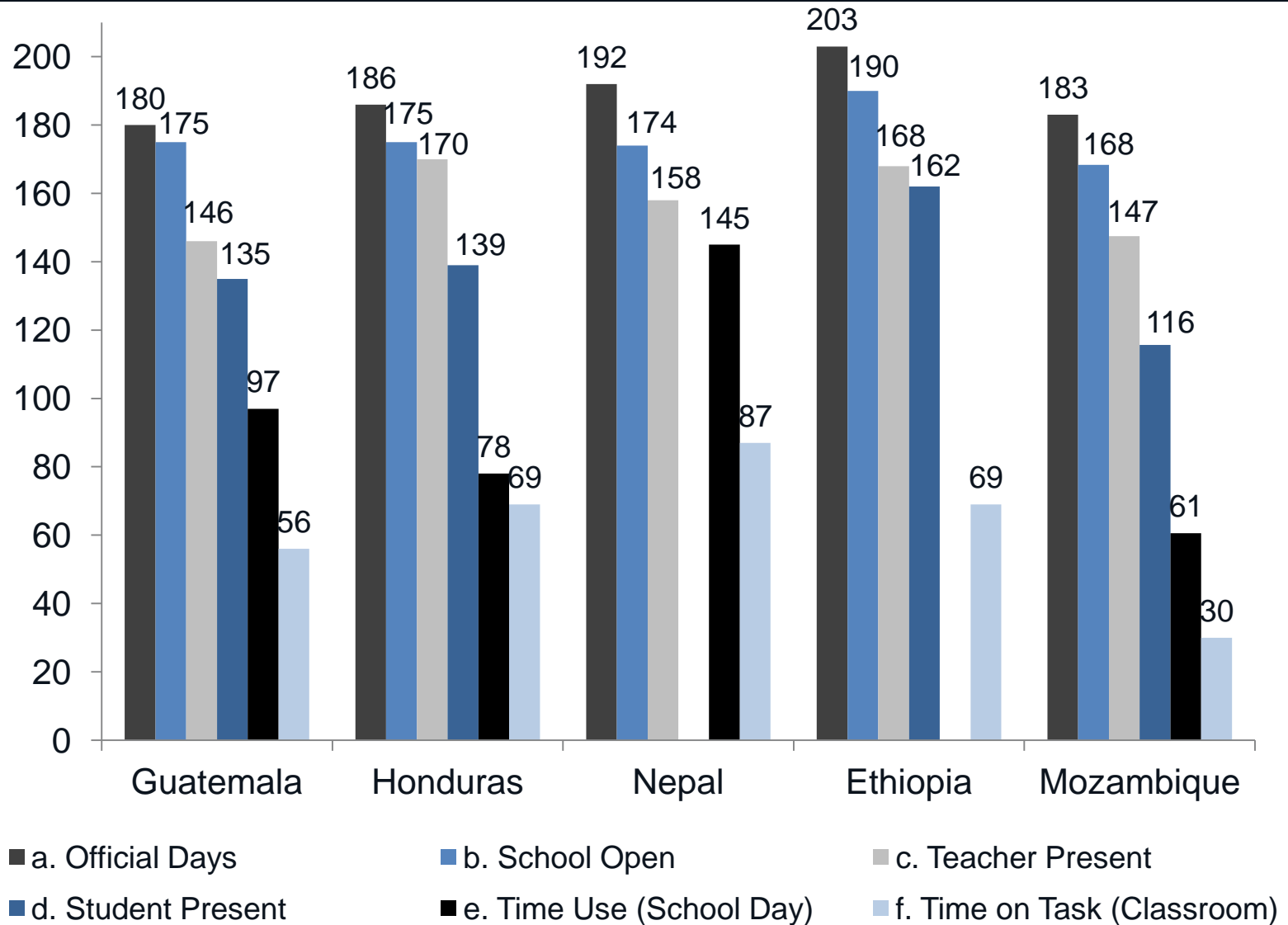
EQUIP2 focuses on improving the sustainability and impact of education programs through more effective policies, systems, management, and information.

The overall objectives are to work in partnership with governments and donor agencies to:

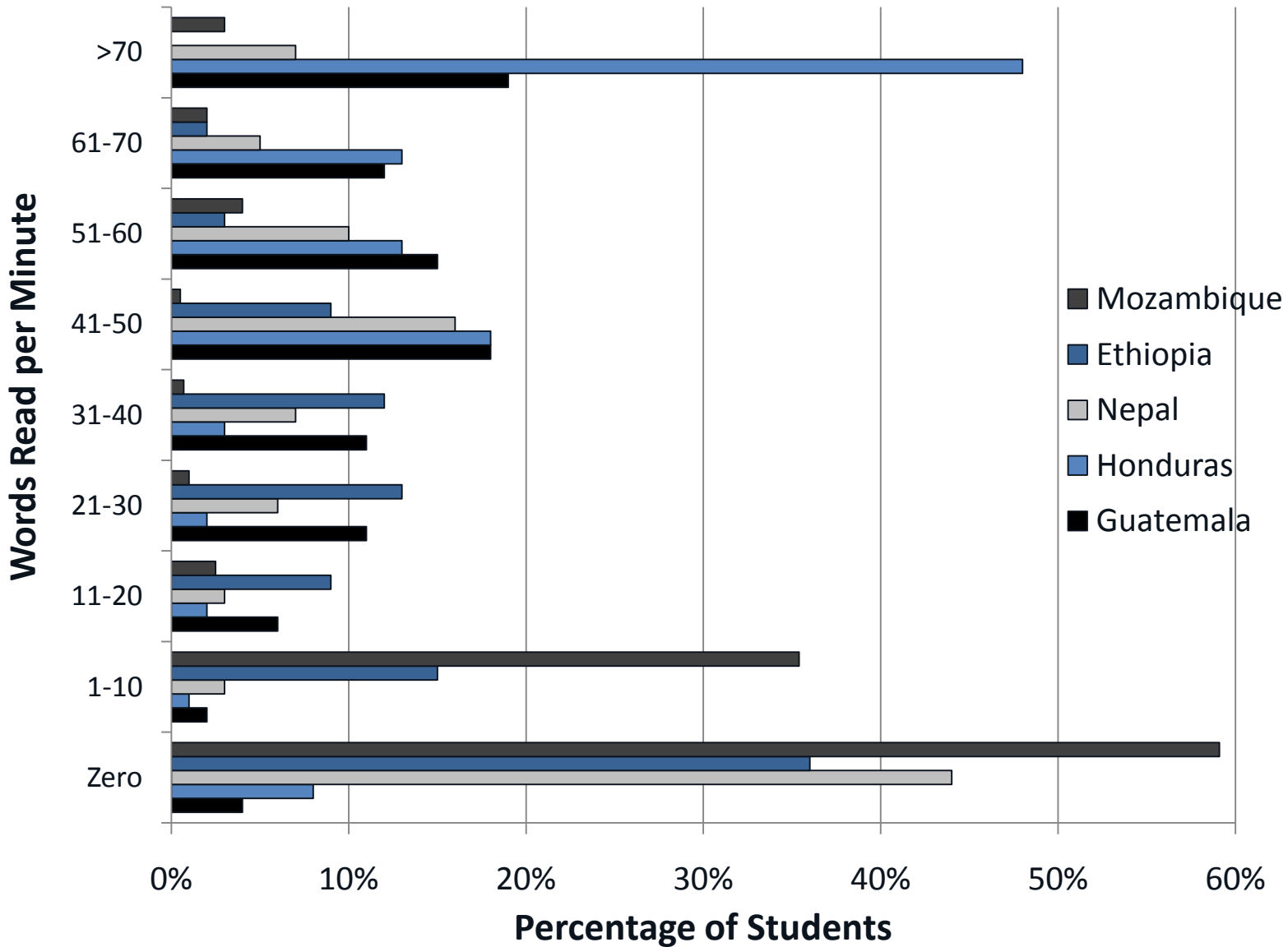
1. Formulate and implement education policy

Effective time available for learning by country



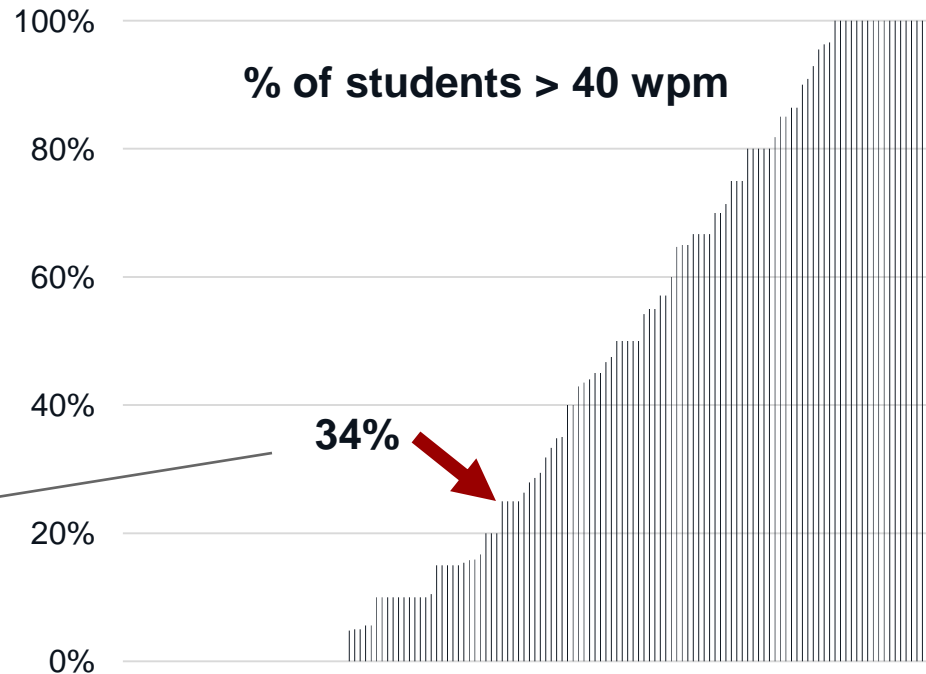
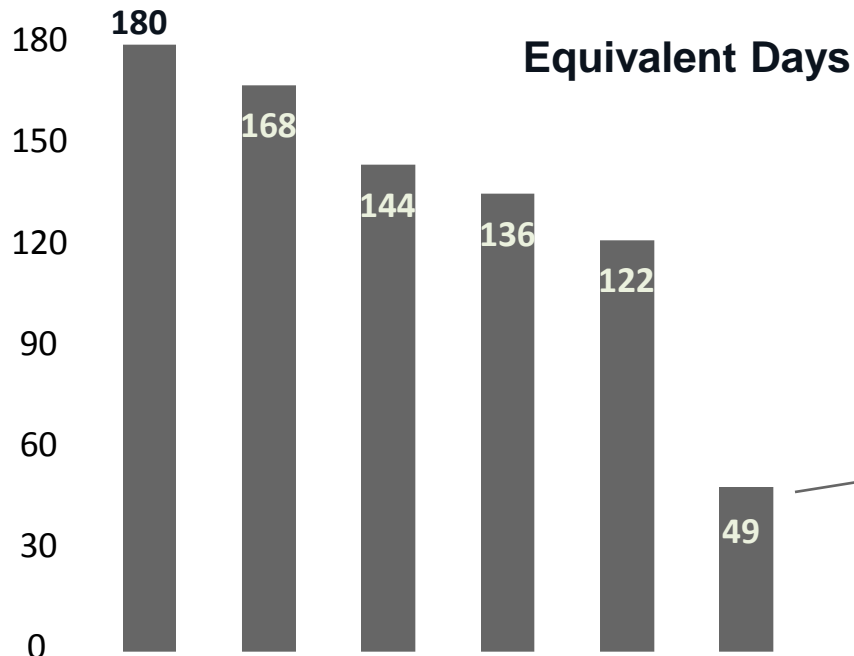
Words per minute (WPM) read by country



↑ opportunity to learn = ↑ learning outcomes

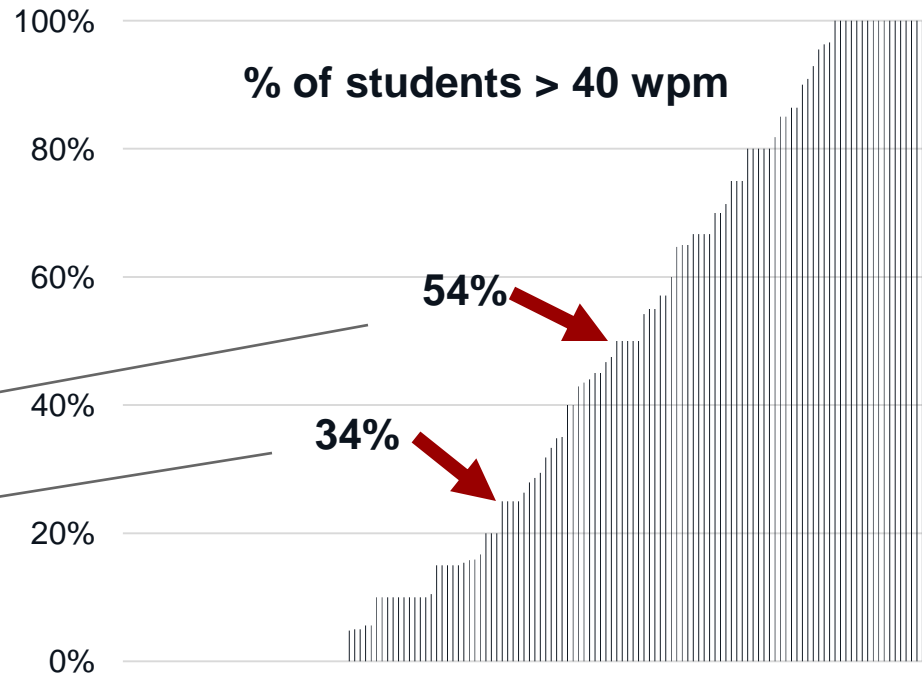
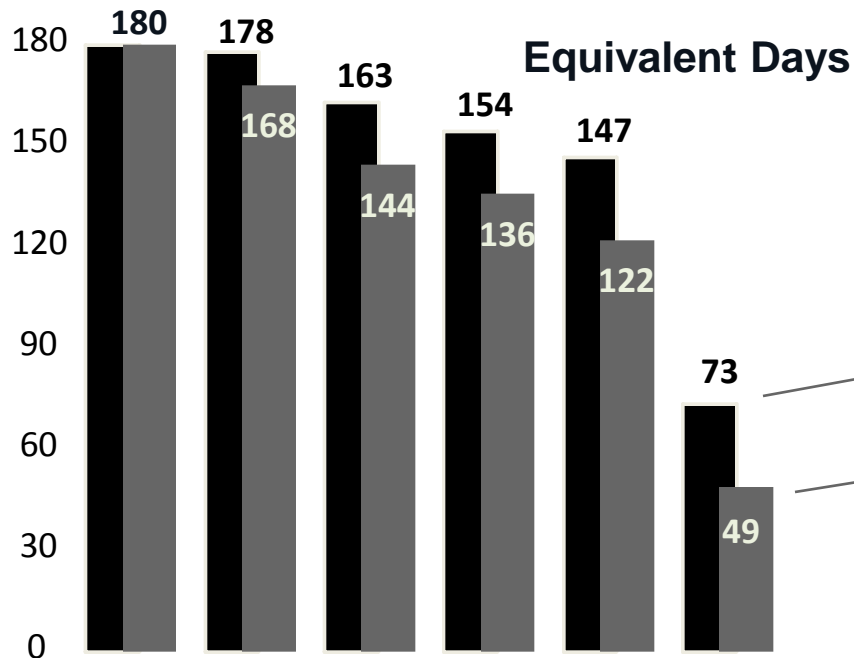
