


# Continuity of State-Level Presidential Voting Pattern, 2000 and 2004




#### Partisan Voting in Presidential Elections, 1952-2004





Democratic Advantage in Party Identification, 1952-2007




#### Democratic Advantage in Party Identification, South and Non-South, 1952-2004


