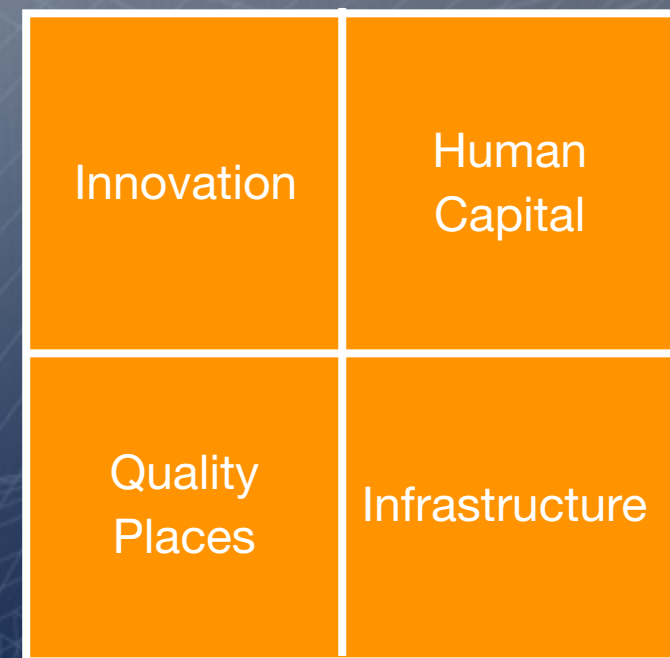

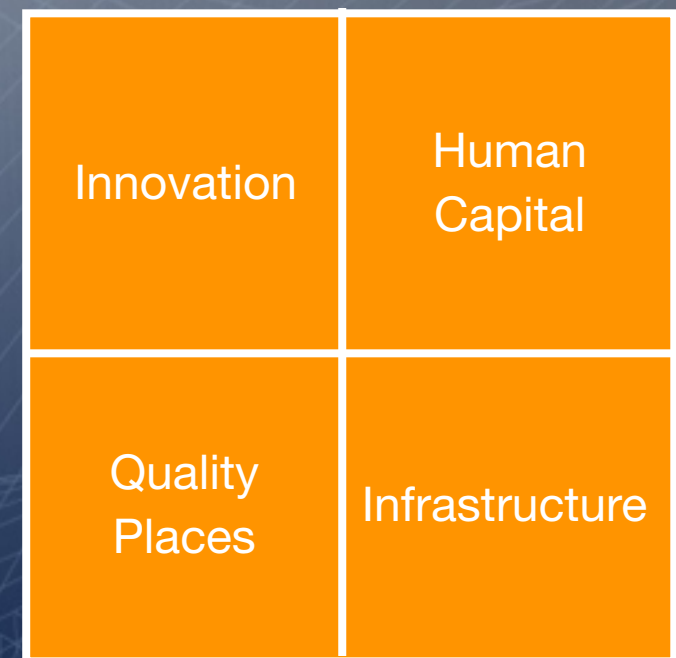

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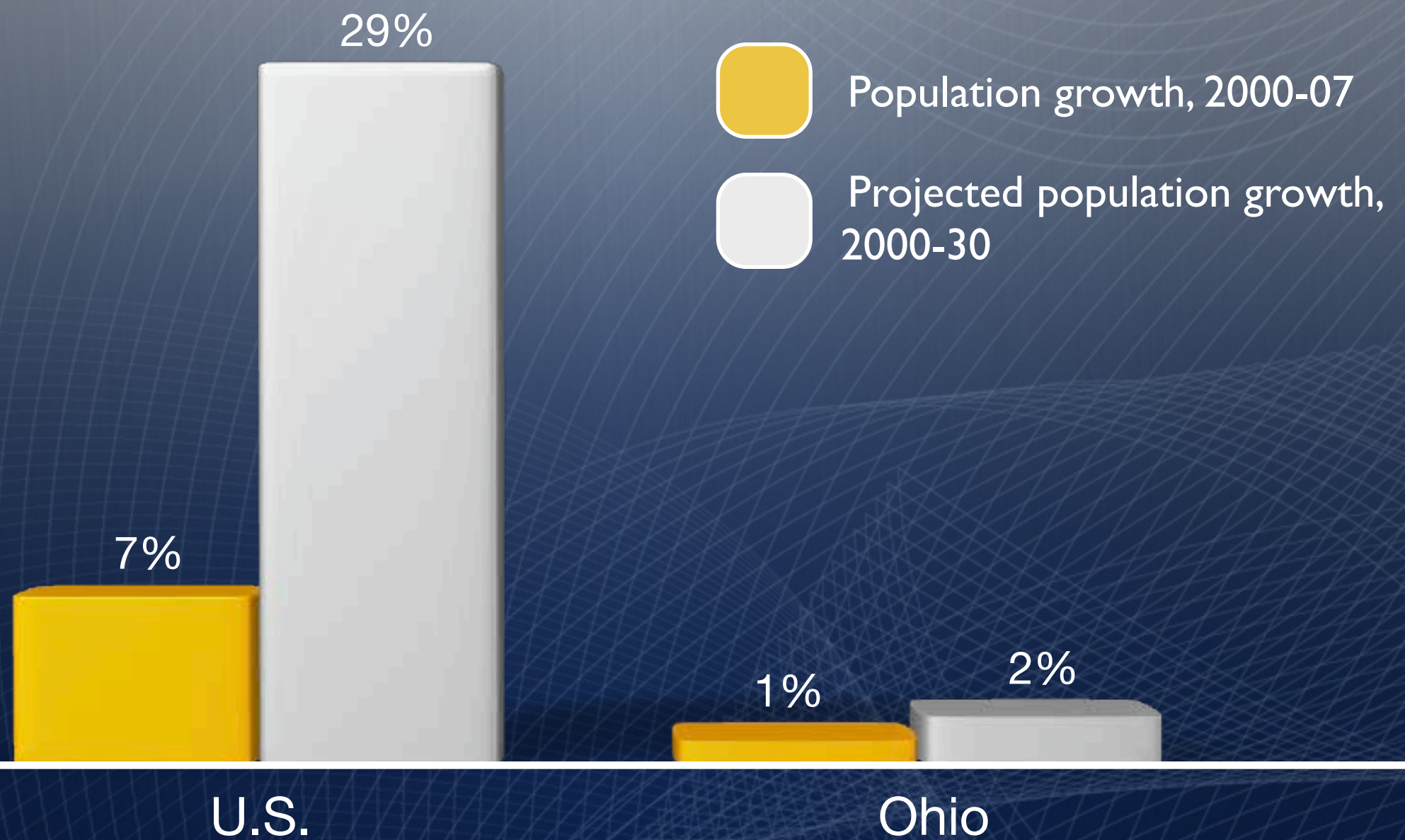
# Economic challenges

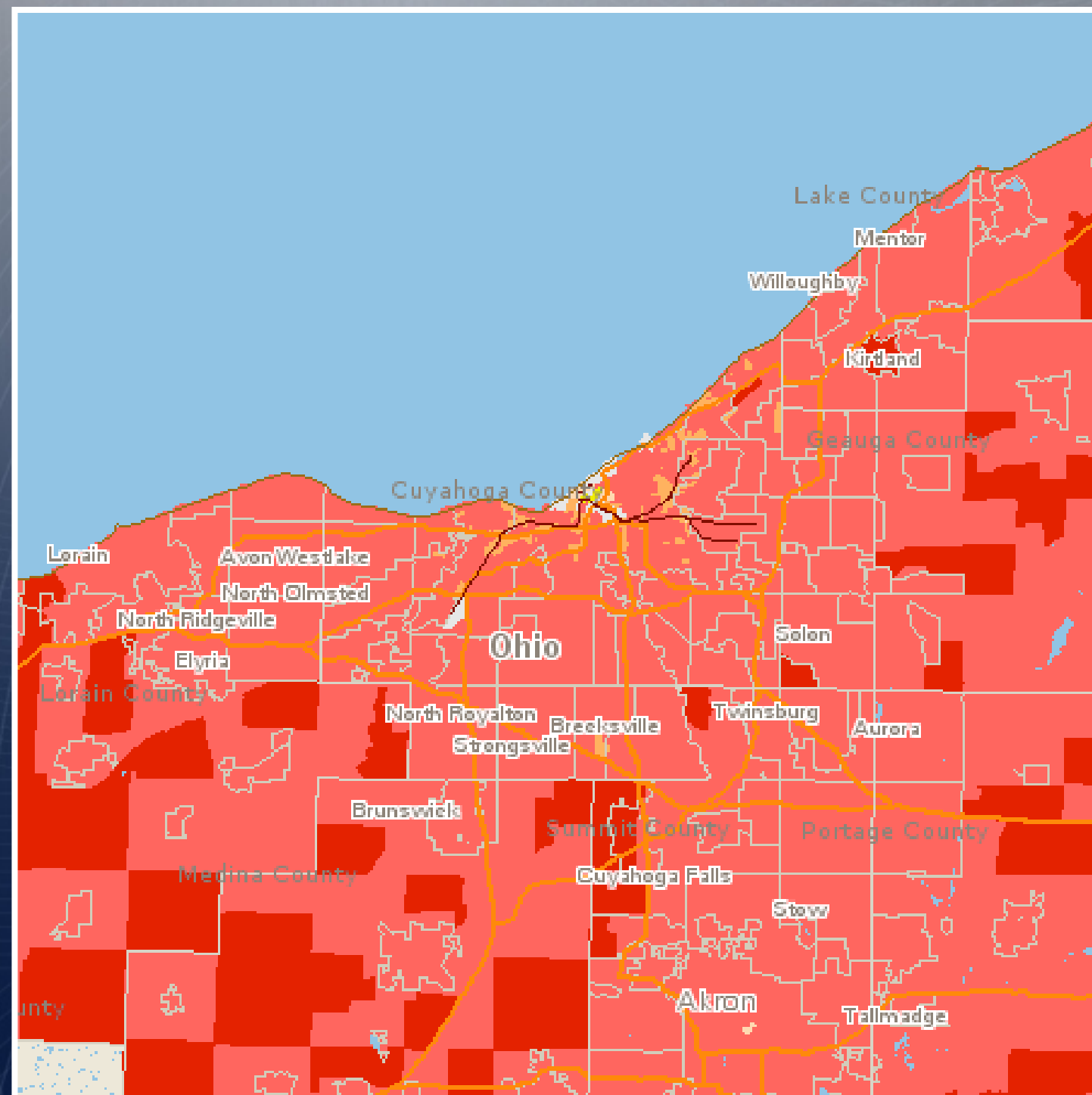
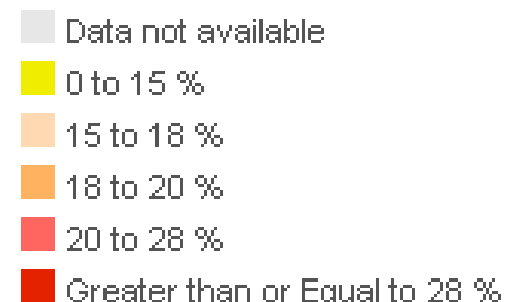


# Environmental challenges

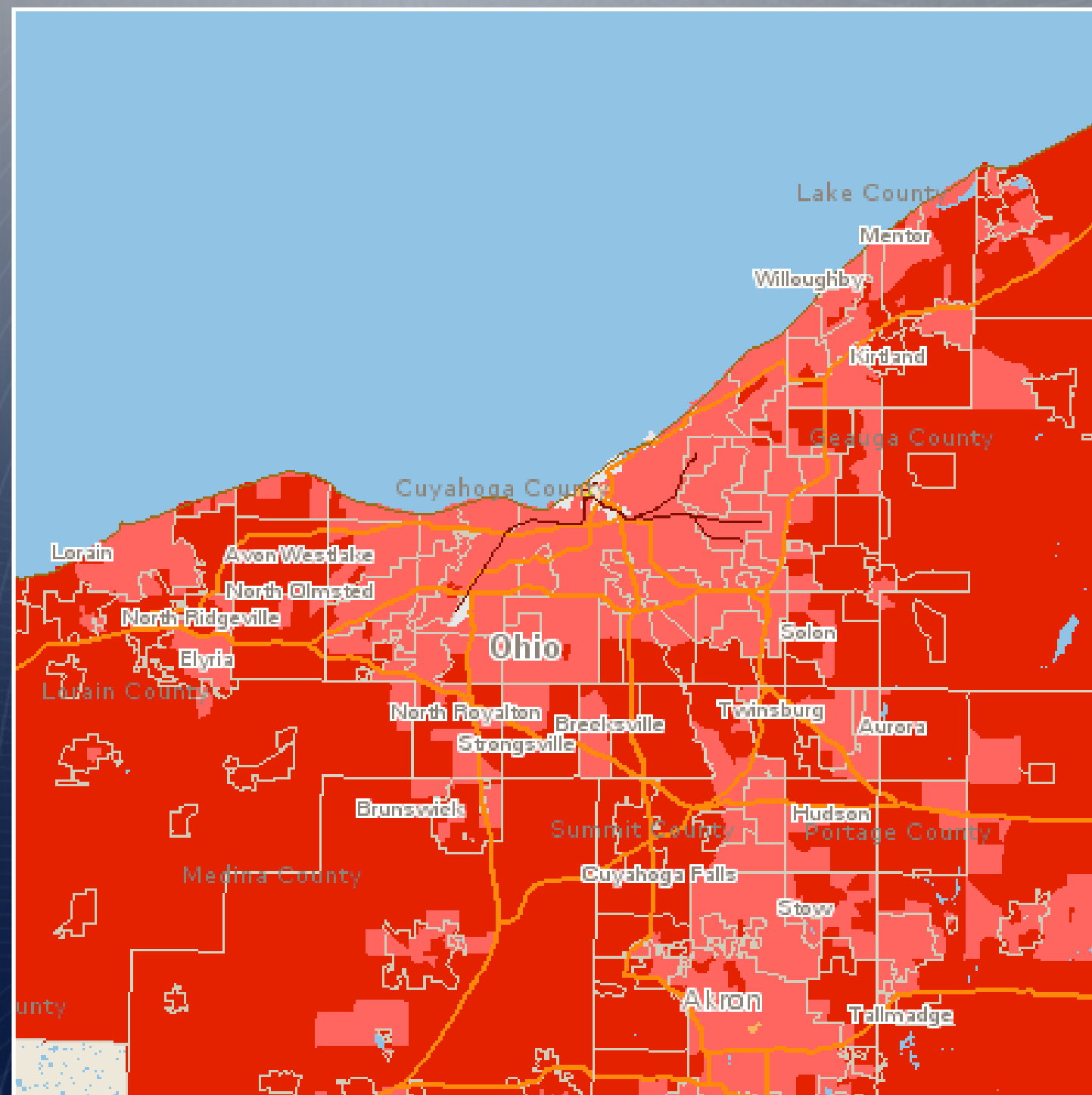

# Our Country's Top 100 Metros



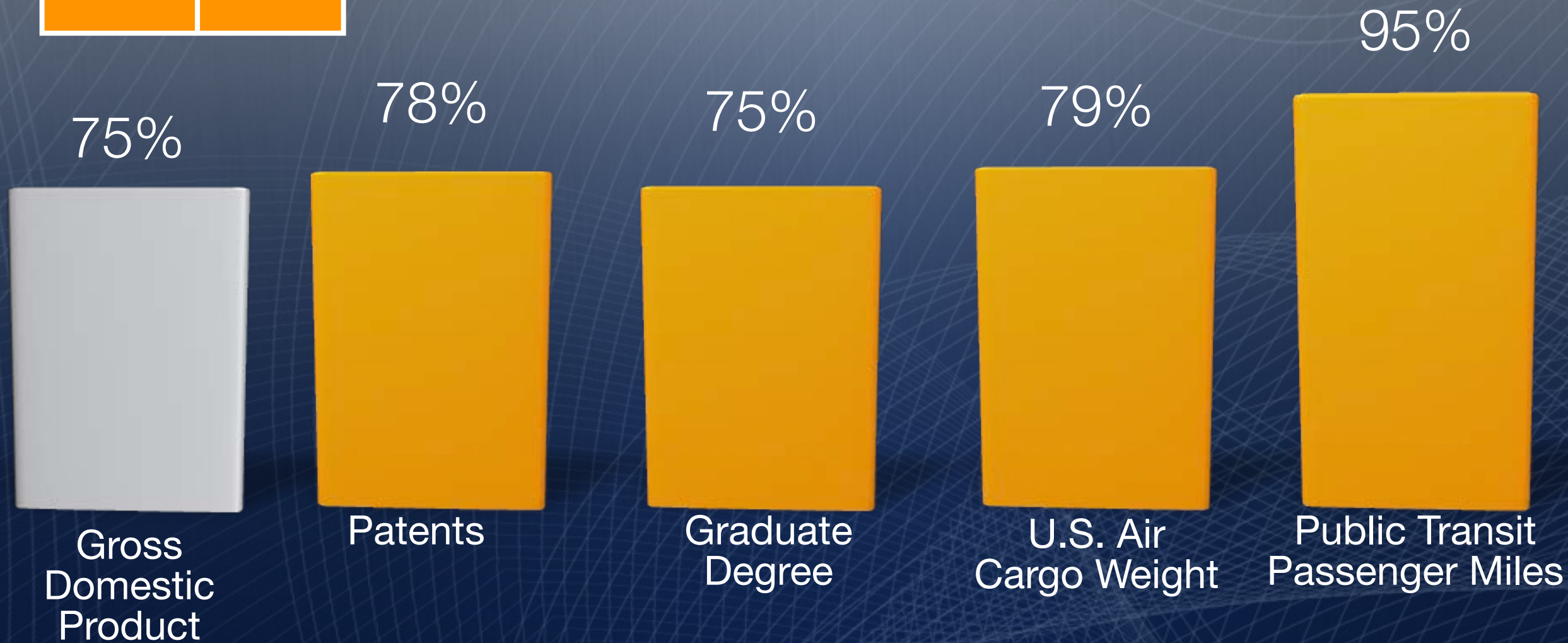

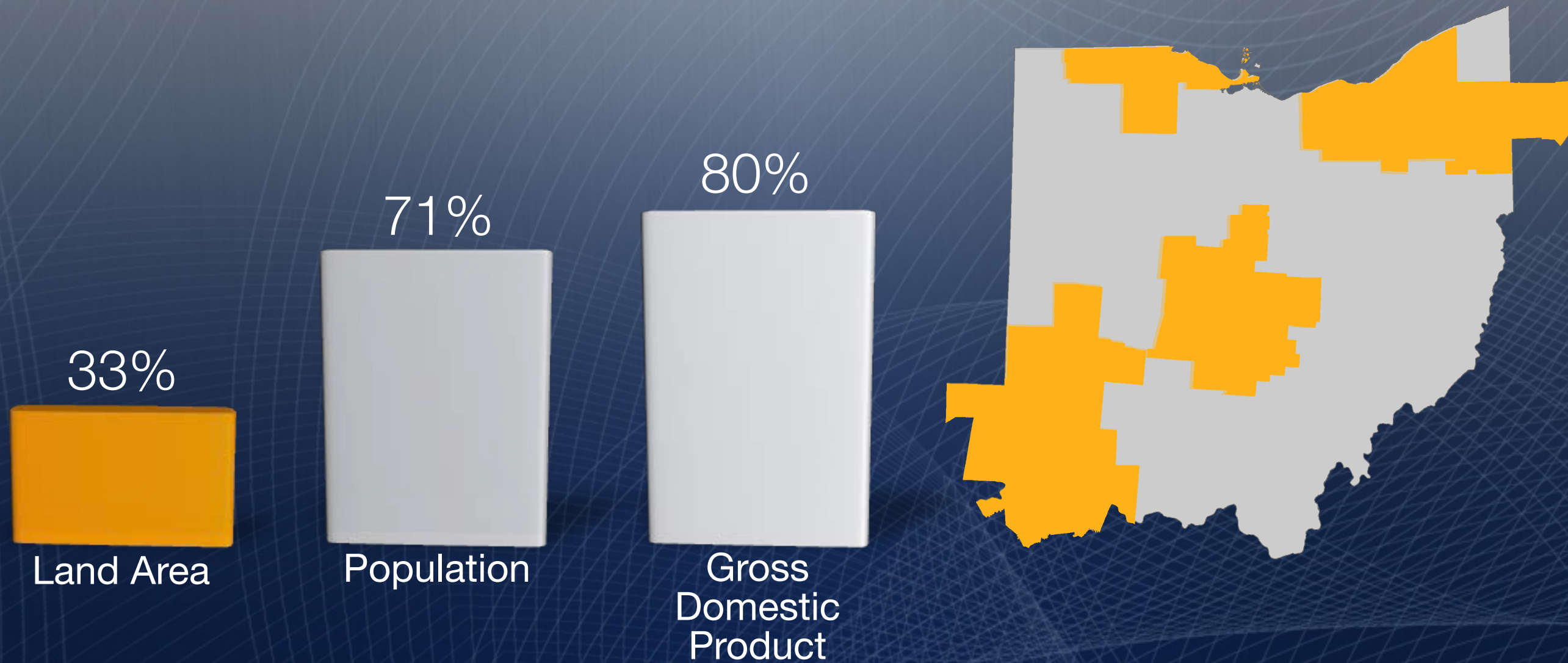

# 7 of the nation's top 100 metros are in Ohio



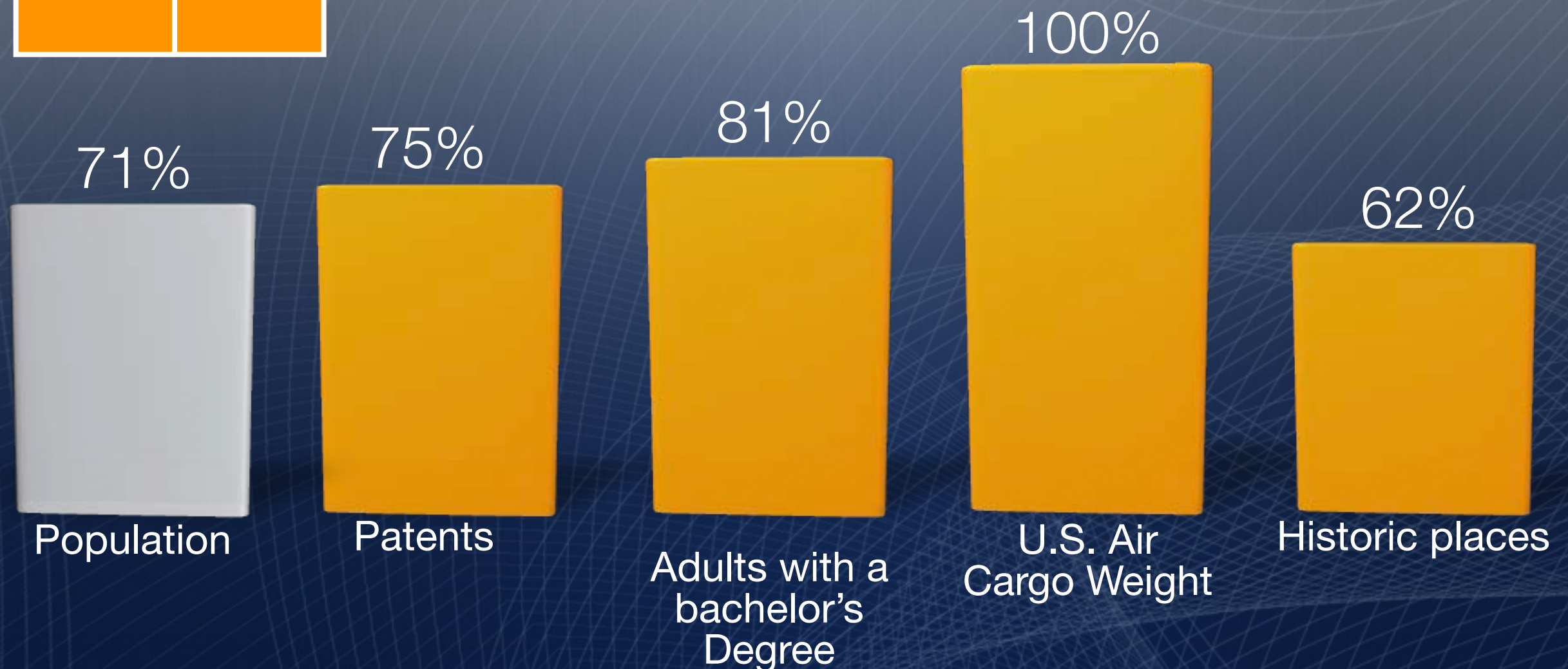

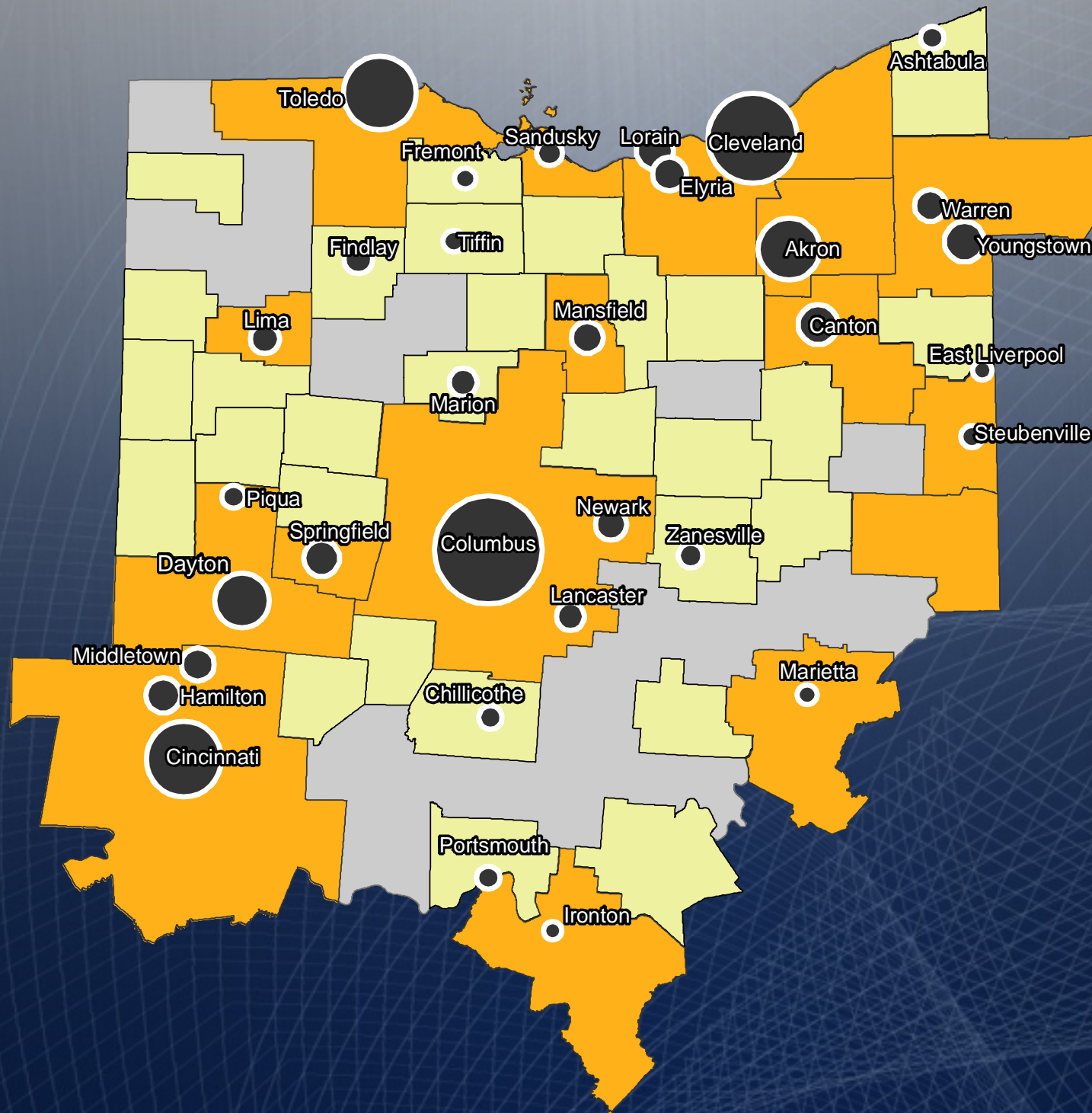

- 6 of the state's 7 ports serve these cities



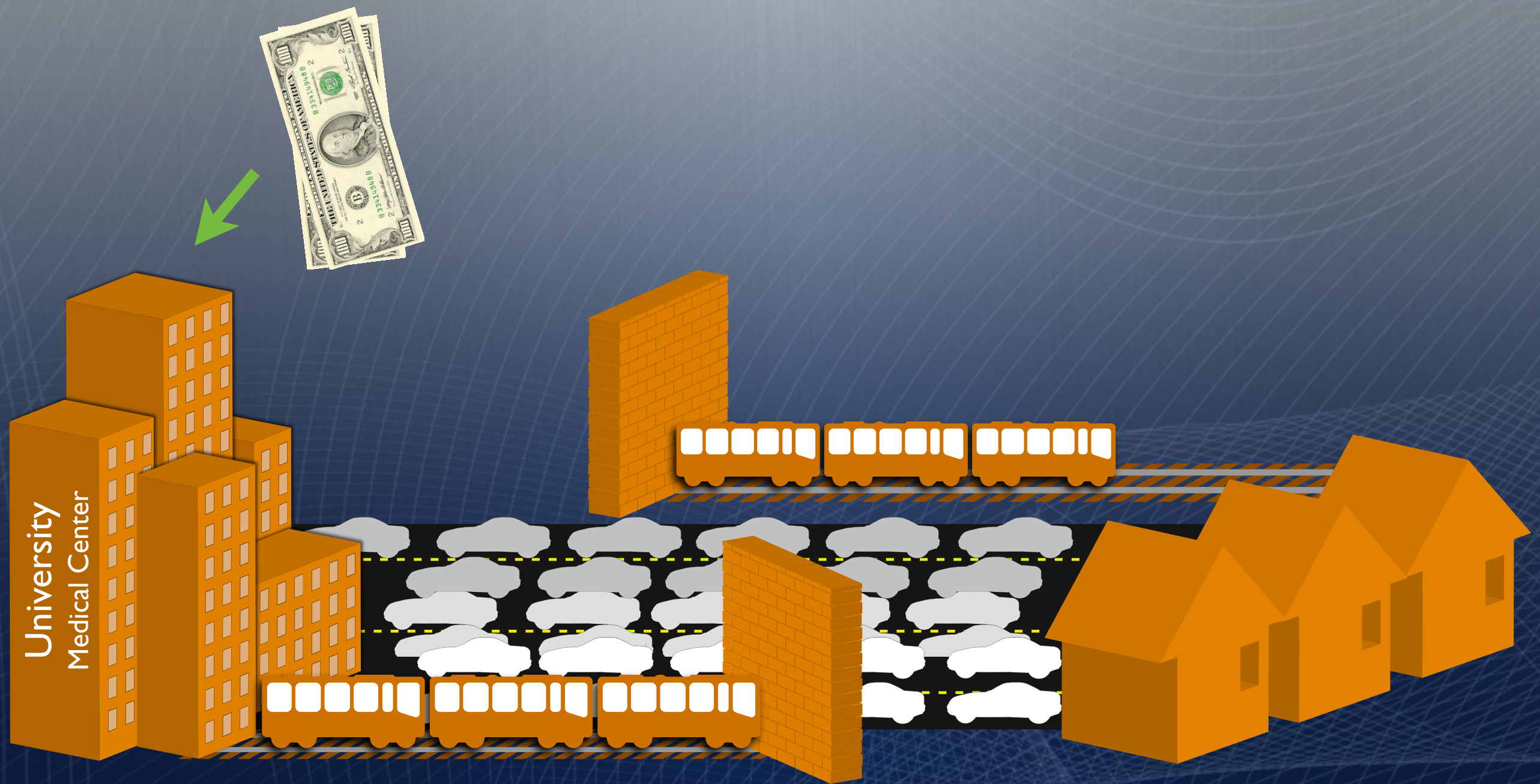

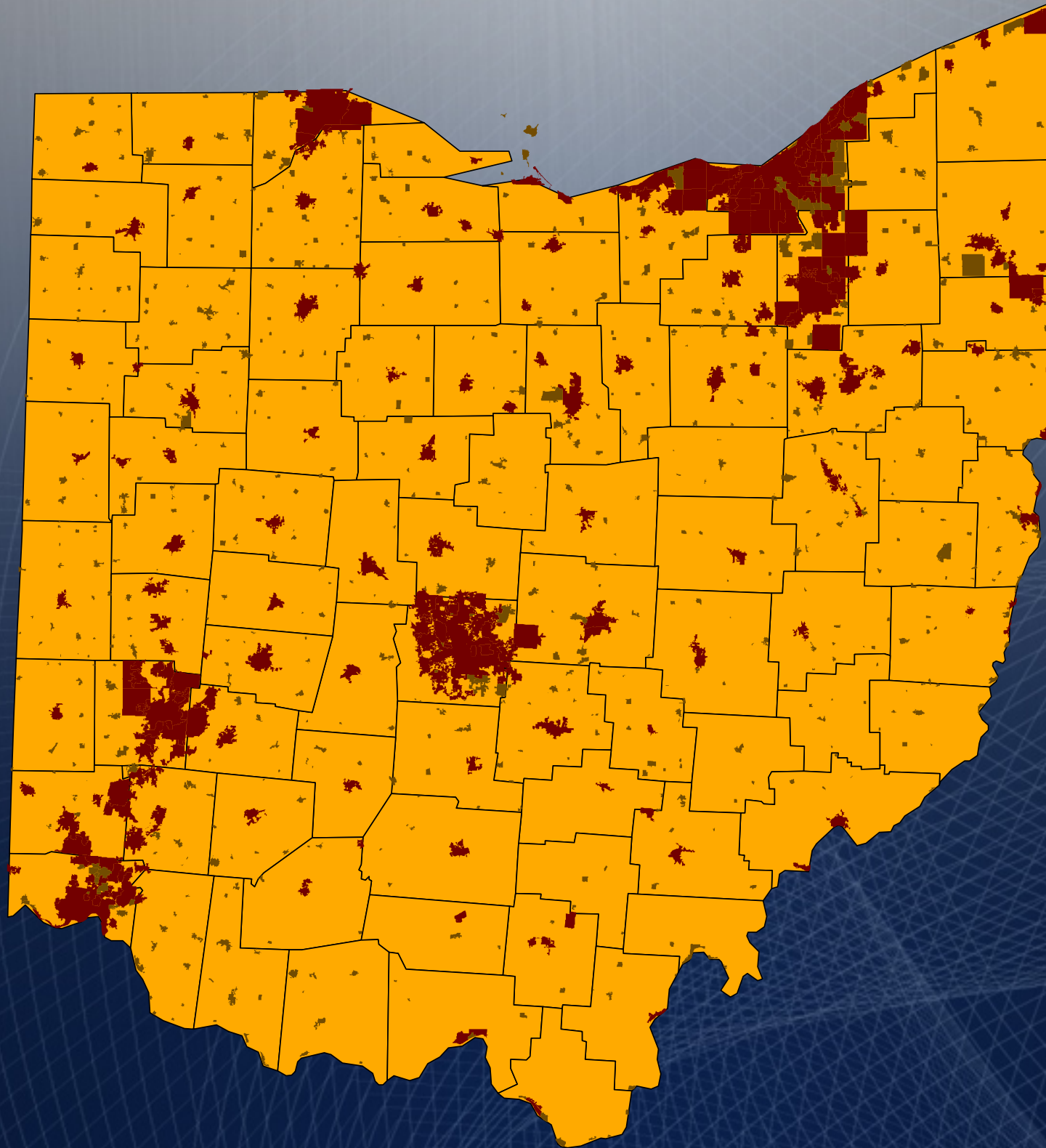

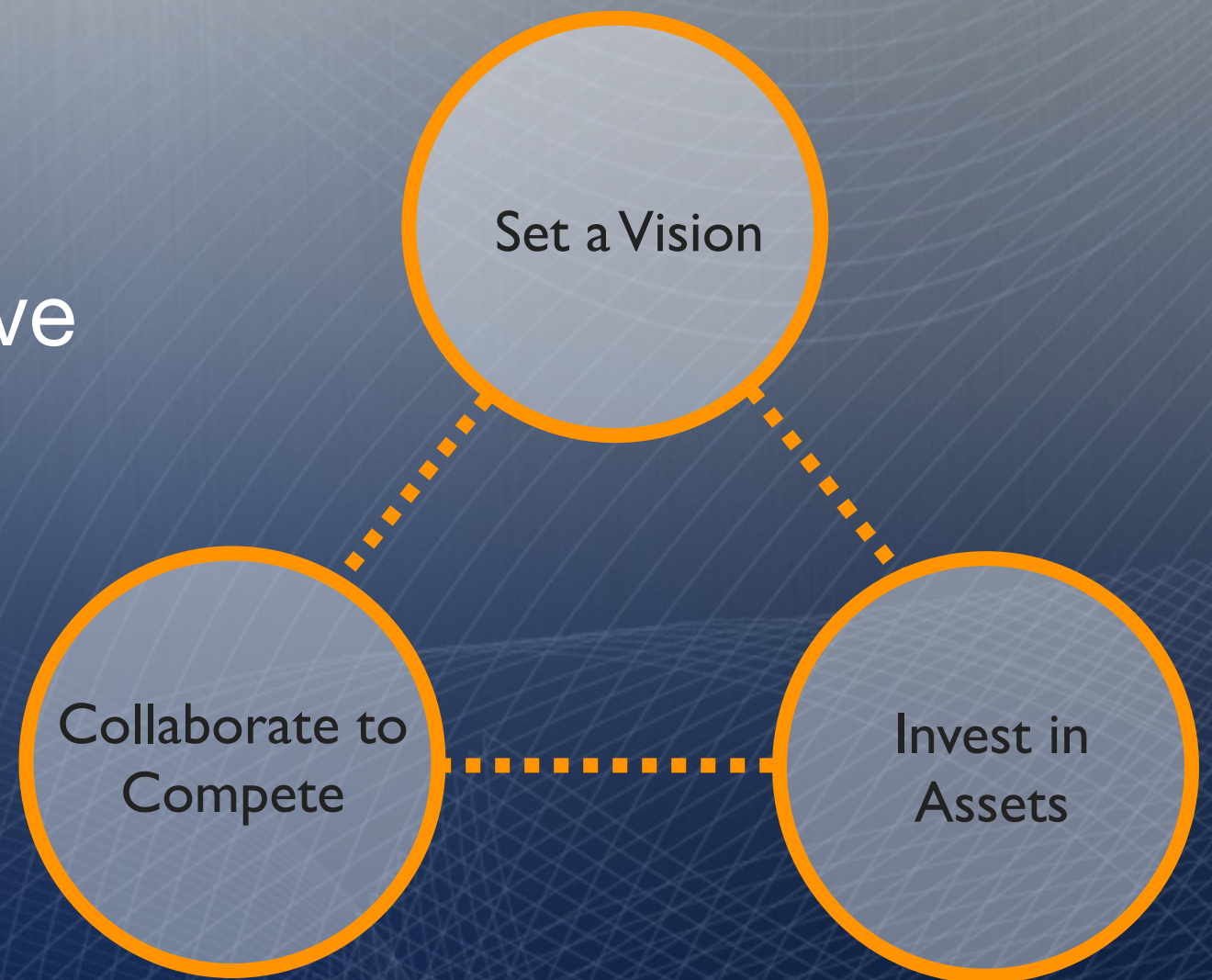

## Infrastructure

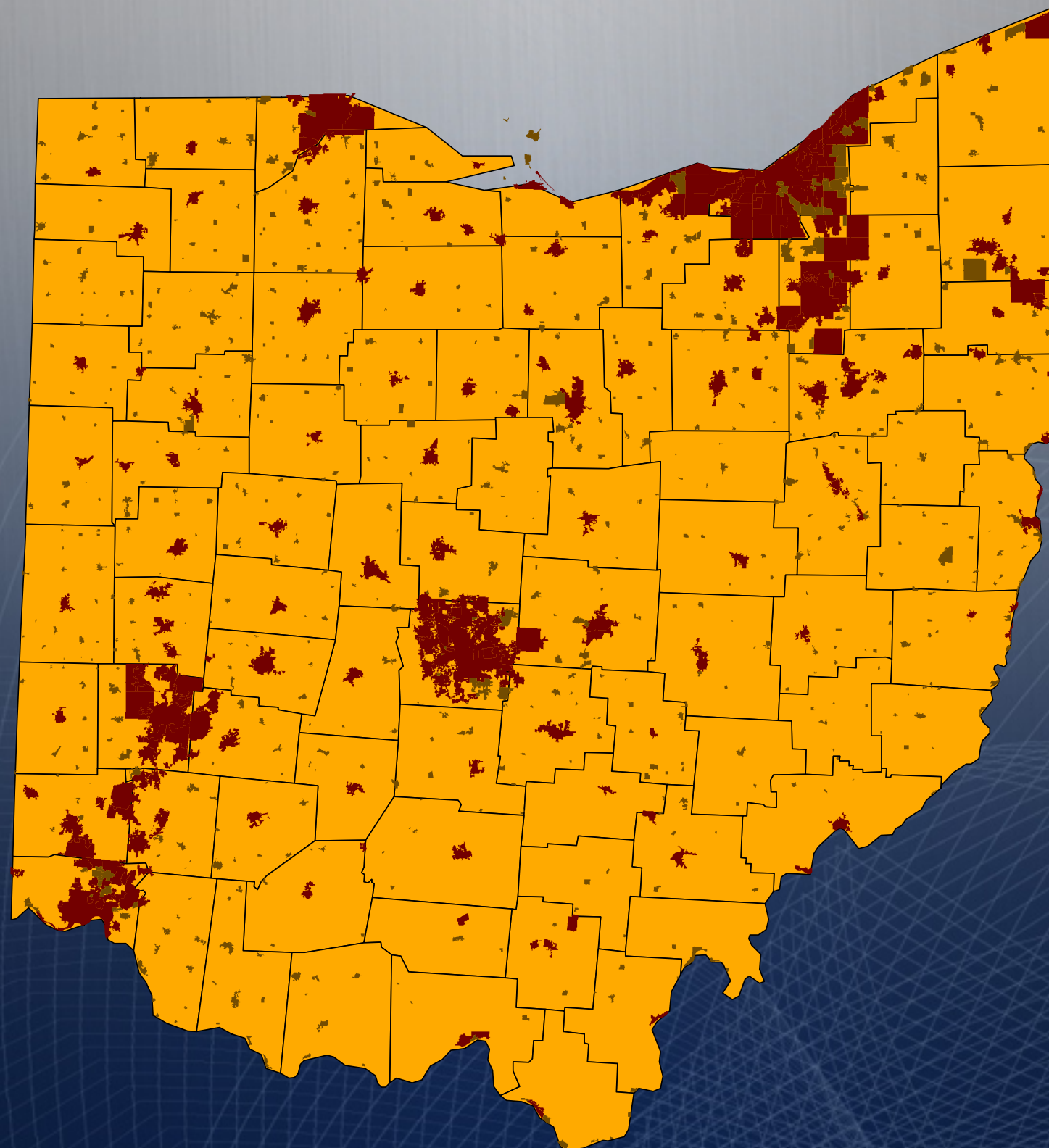
- Overhaul antiquated, sprawl-inducing transportation policies
