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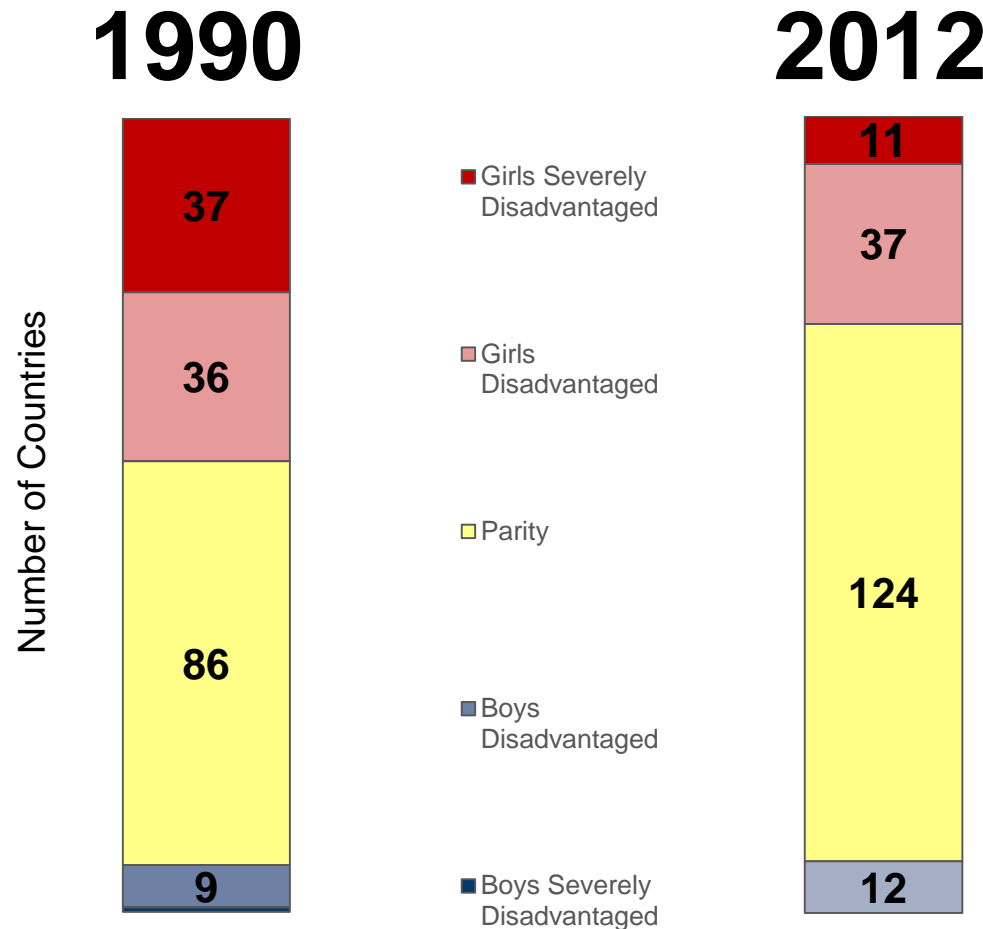
Global Goals

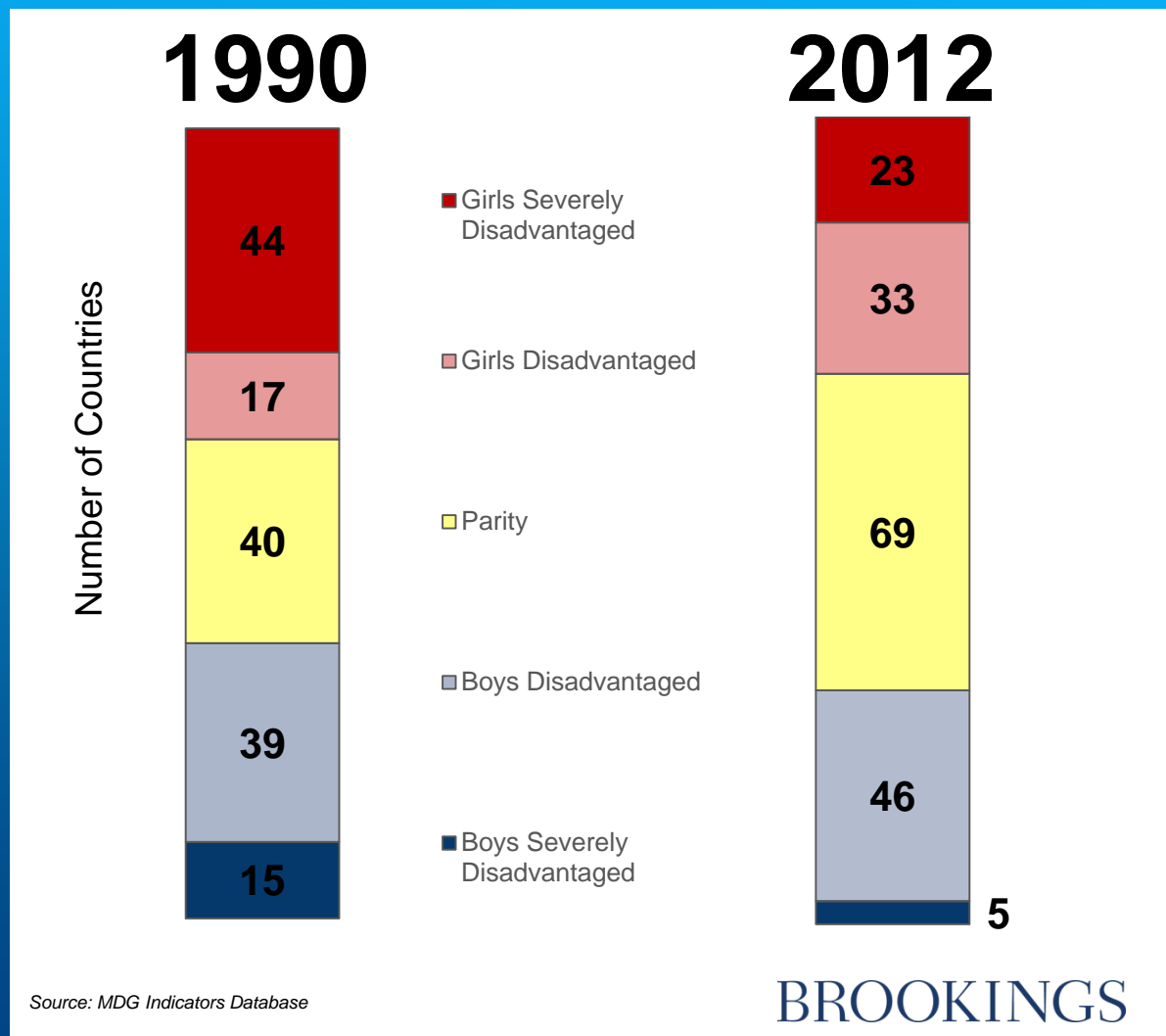
Countries with Gender Parity in Primary School

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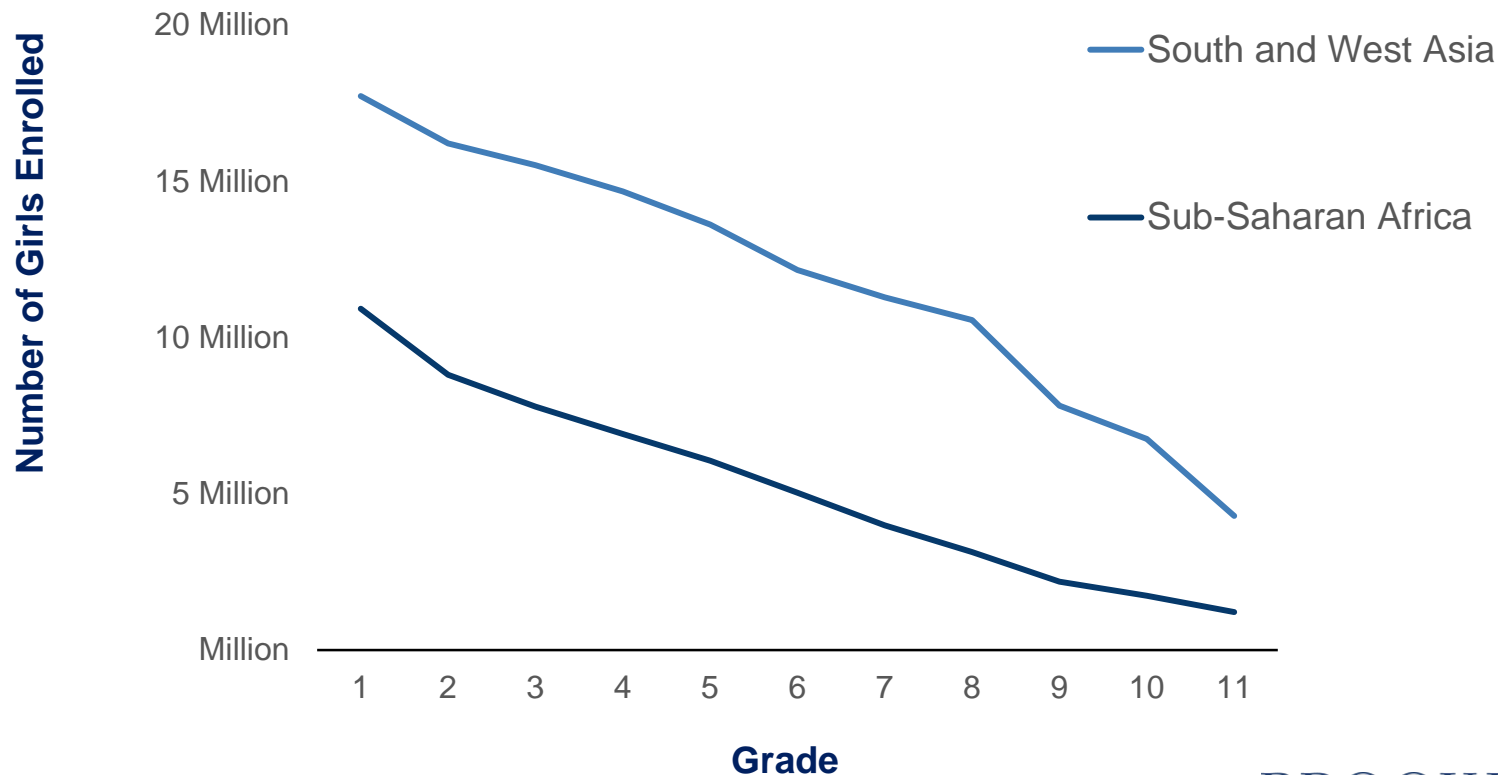

Number of Girls Enrolled in School in Hotspot Countries

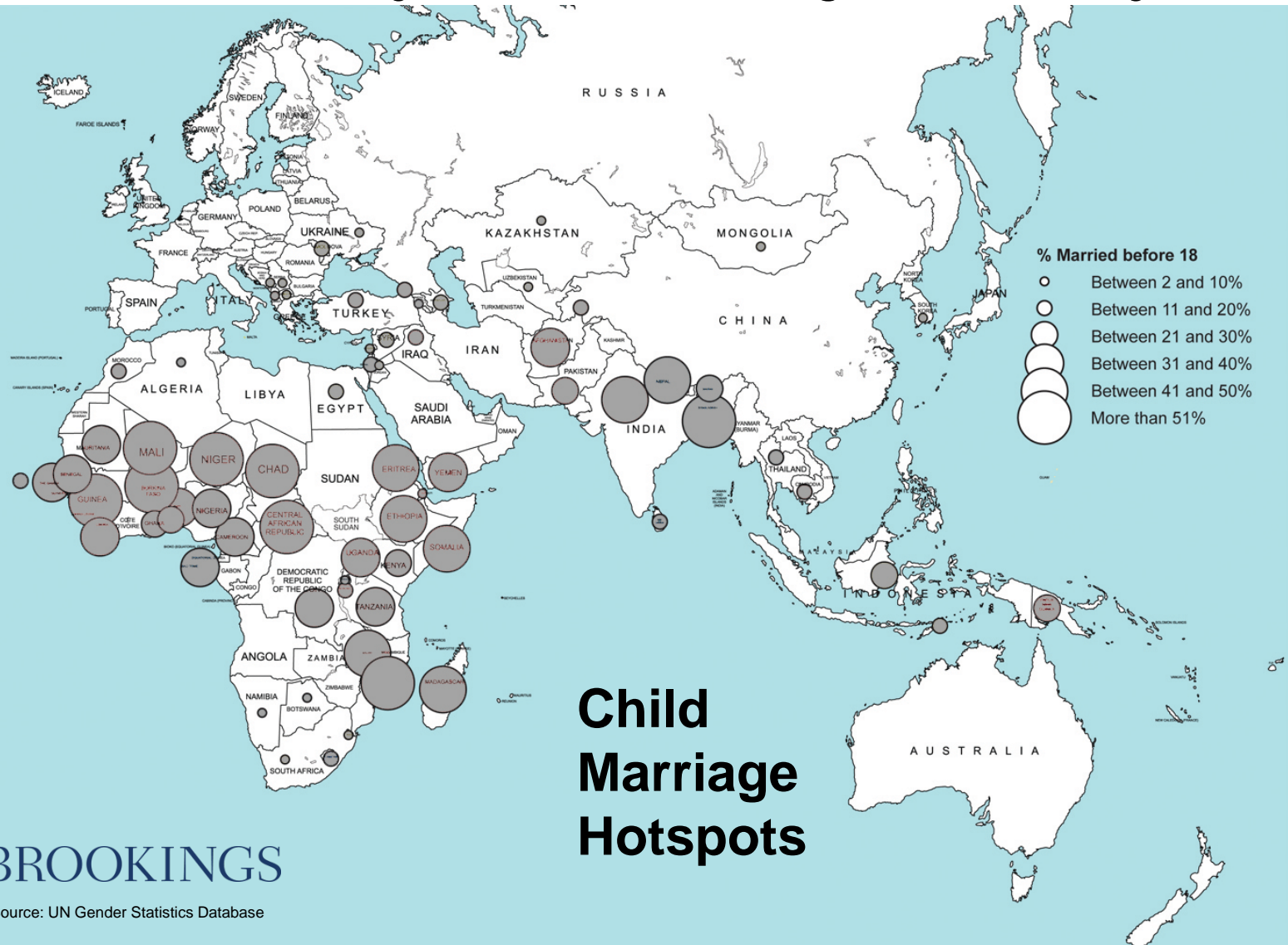

100 girls hospitalized after being gassed at school

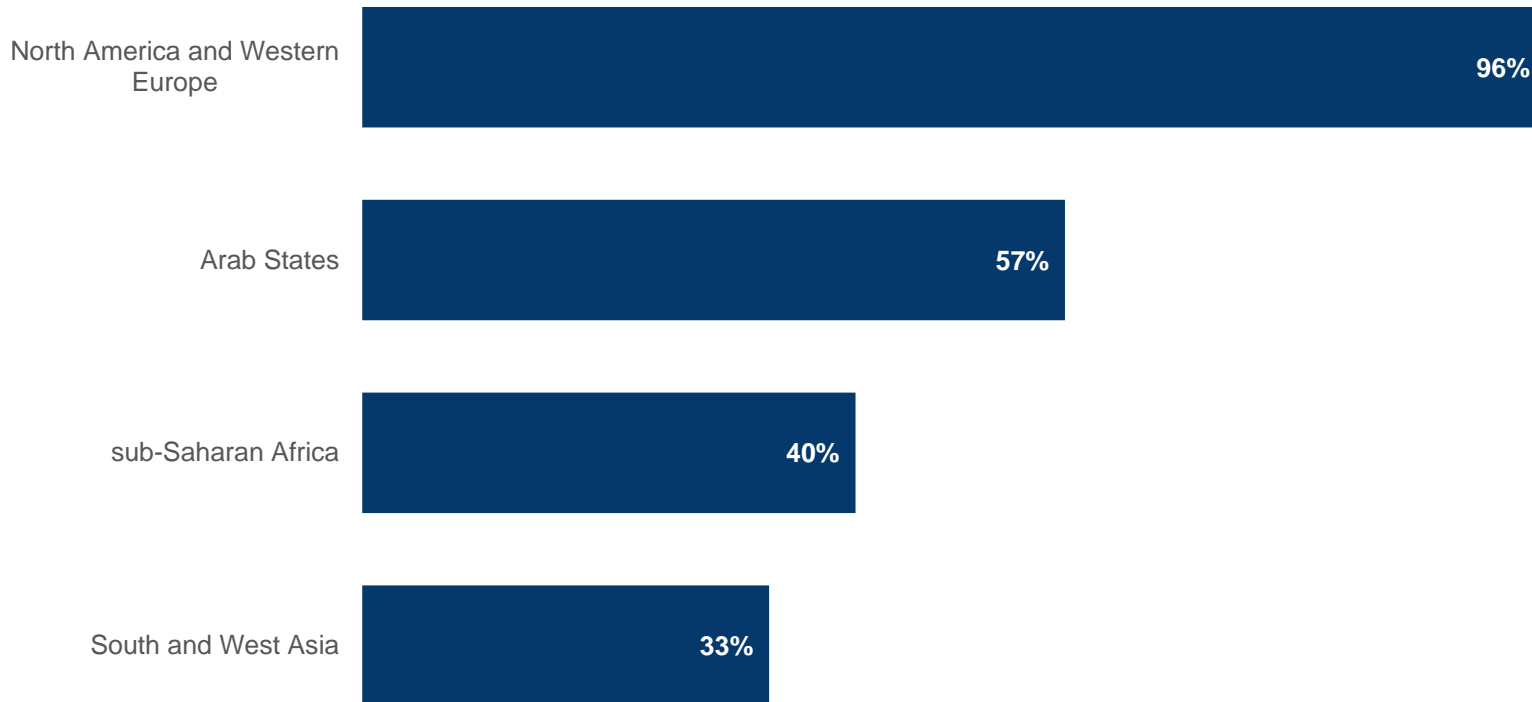
120,000 girls forced to quit school after violent campaign

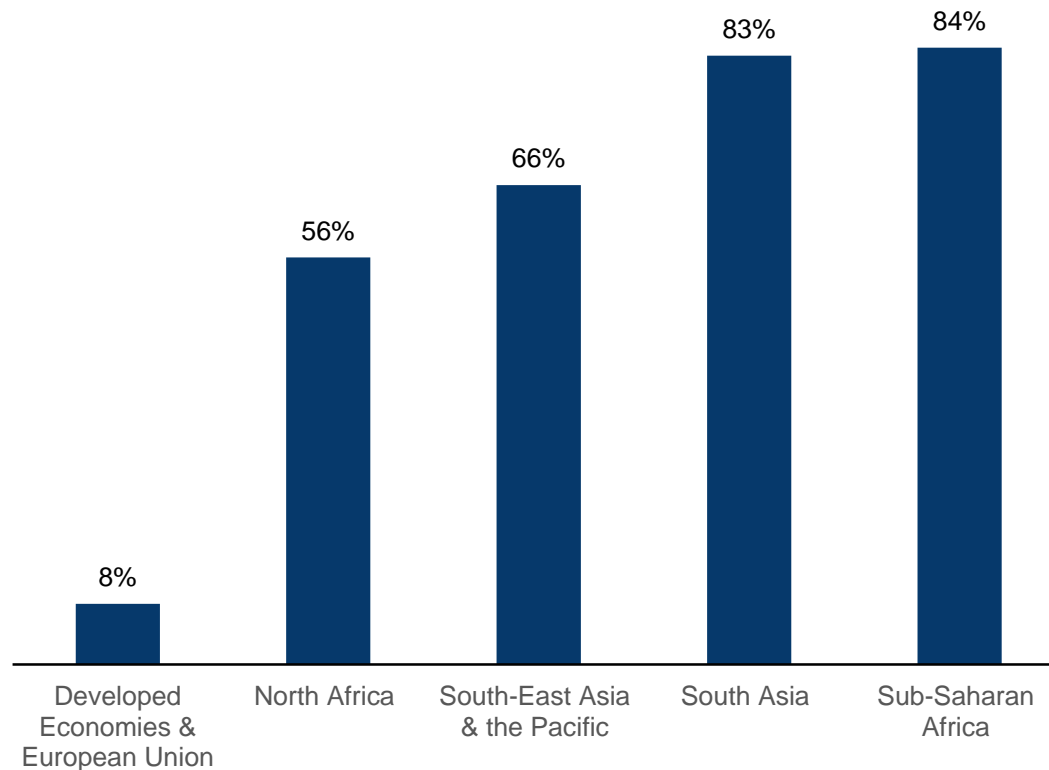
