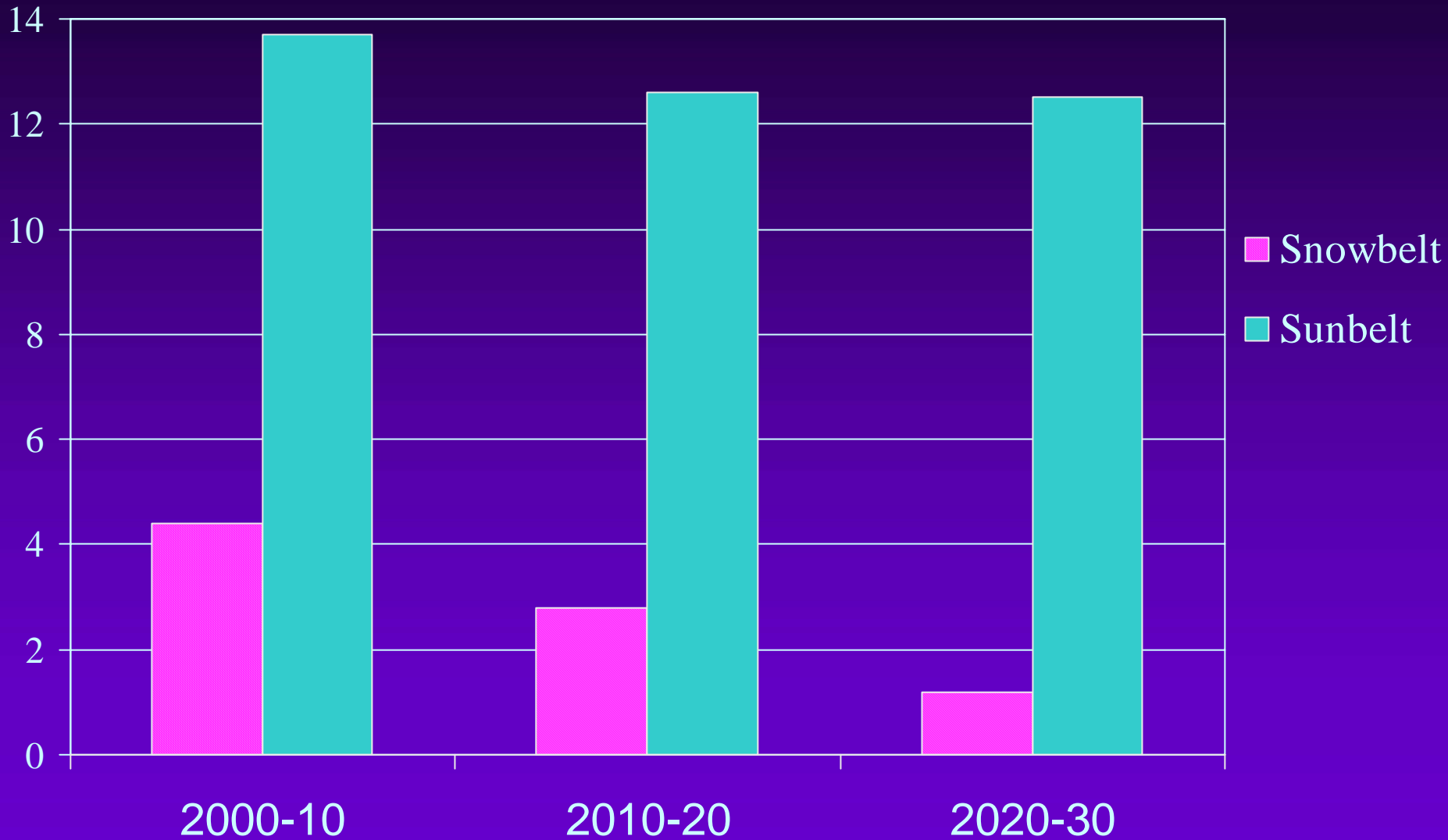

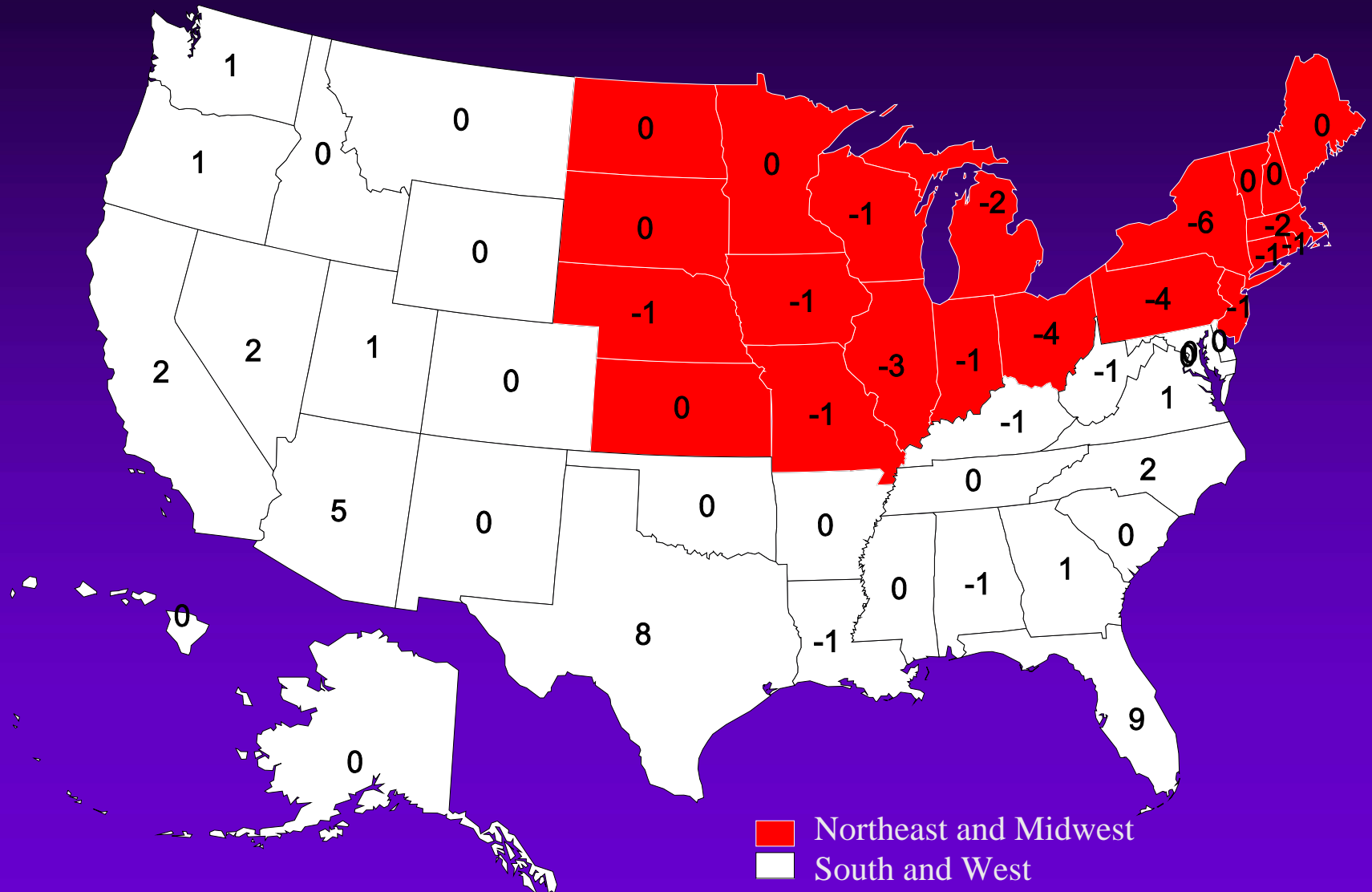

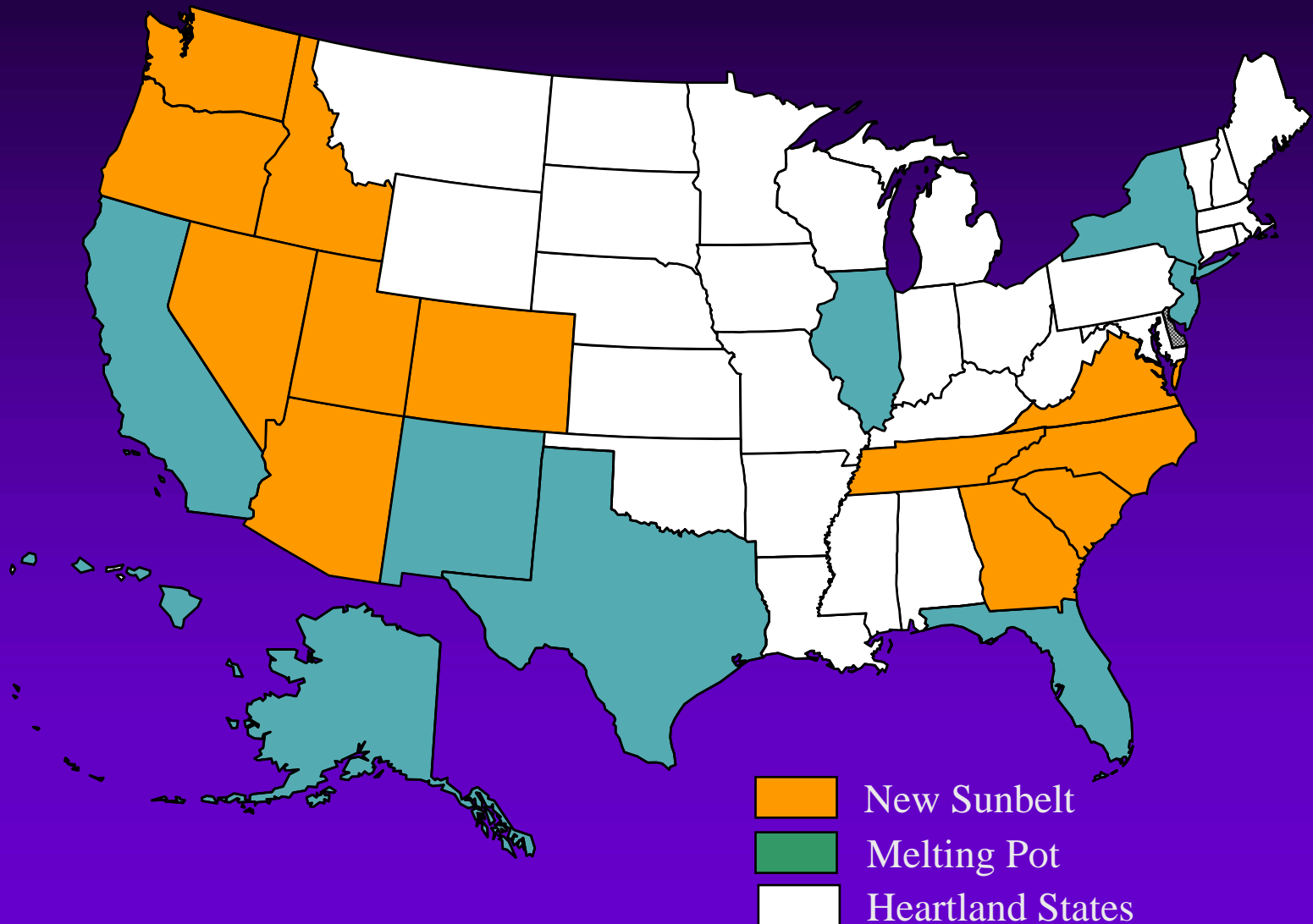

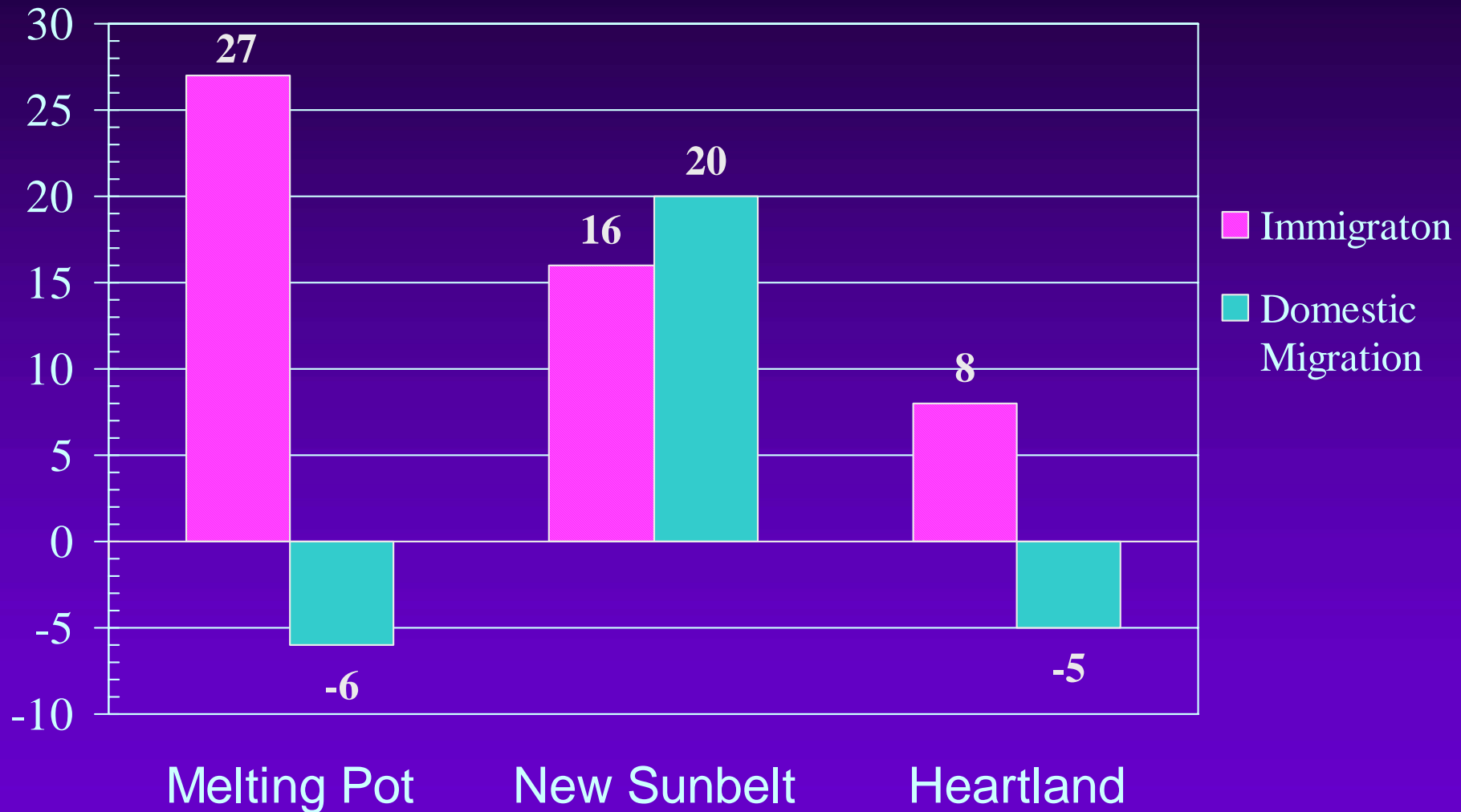

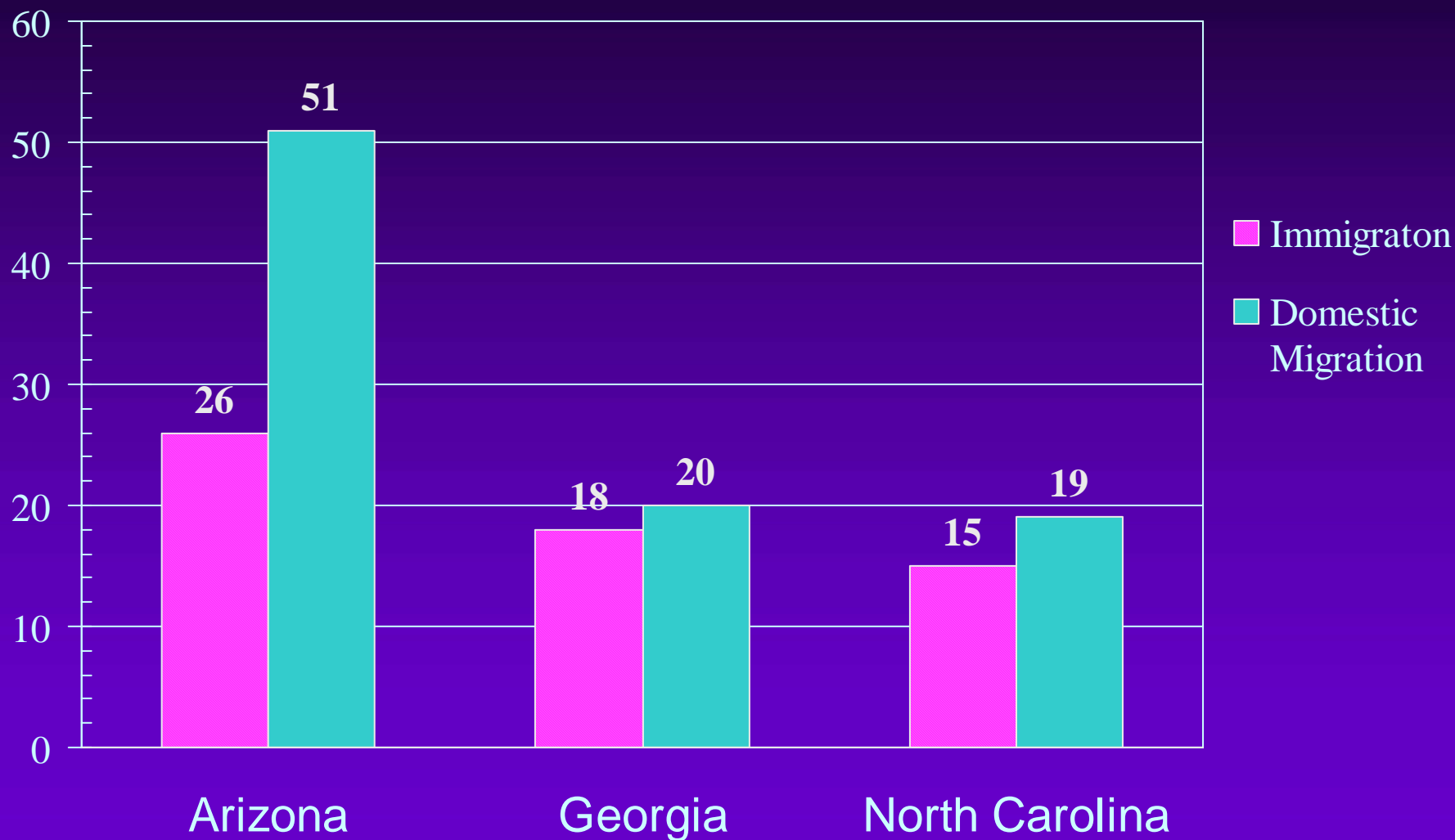

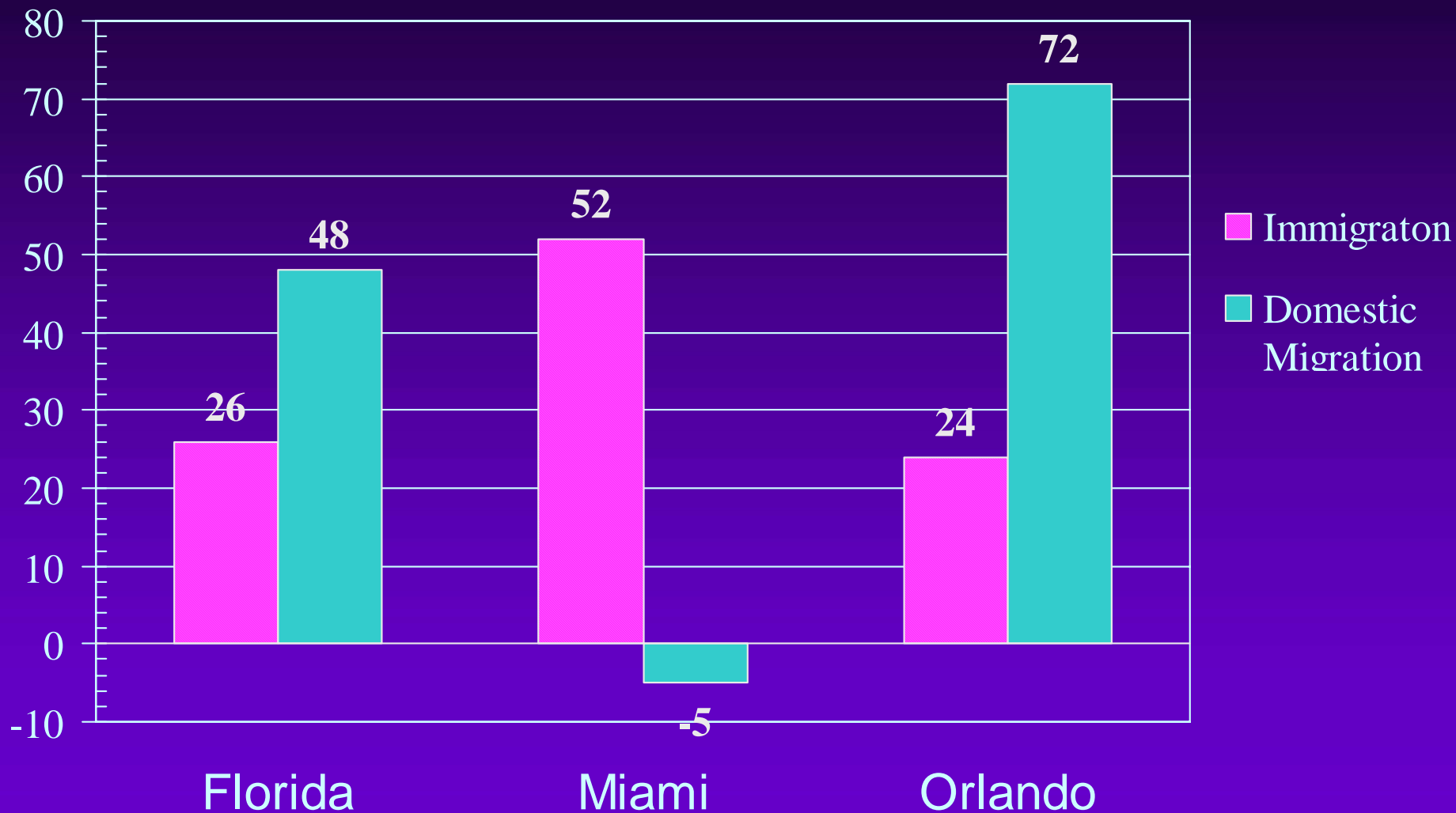
Melting Pot States: 2000-04 Components



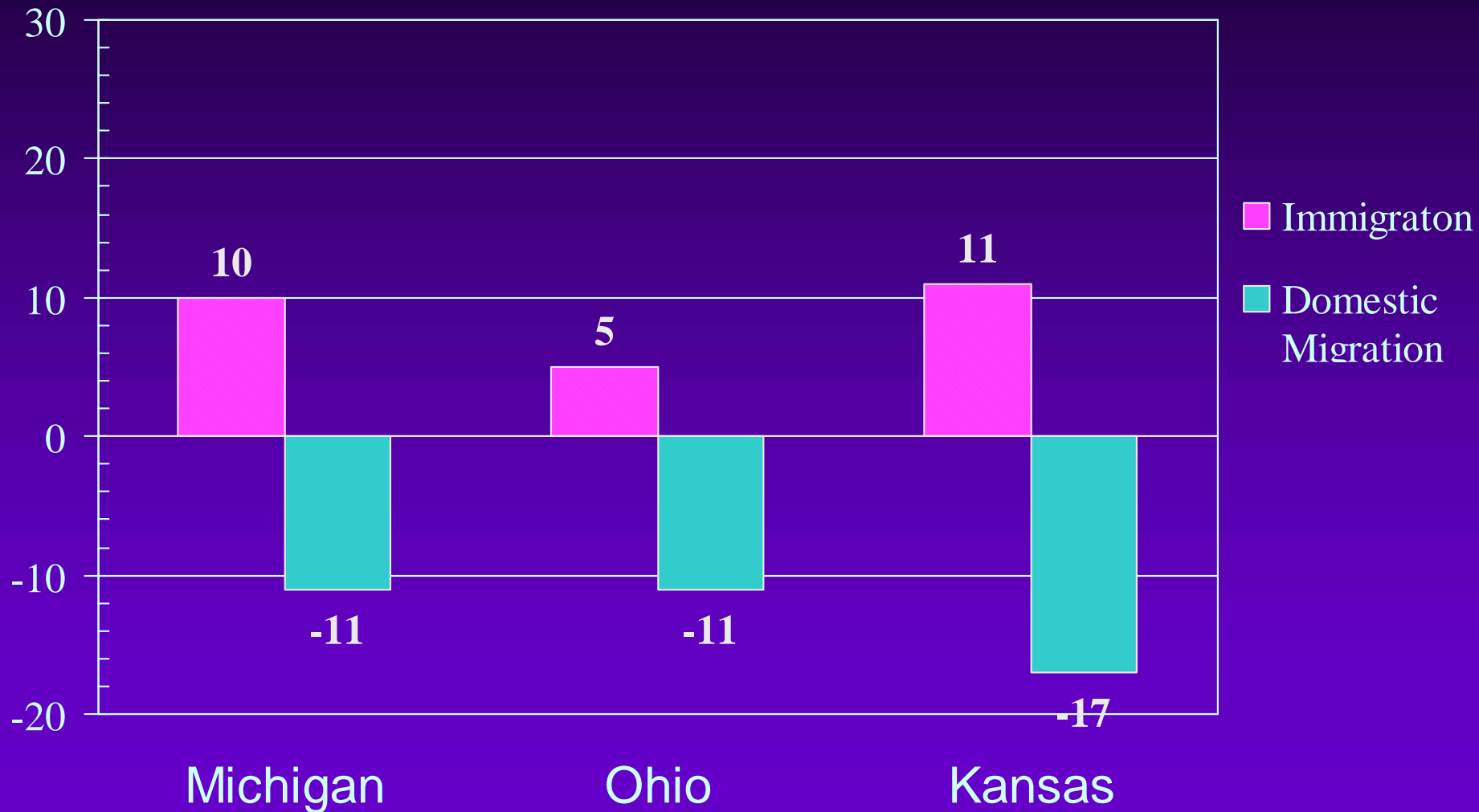
New Sunbelt: 2000-04 Components



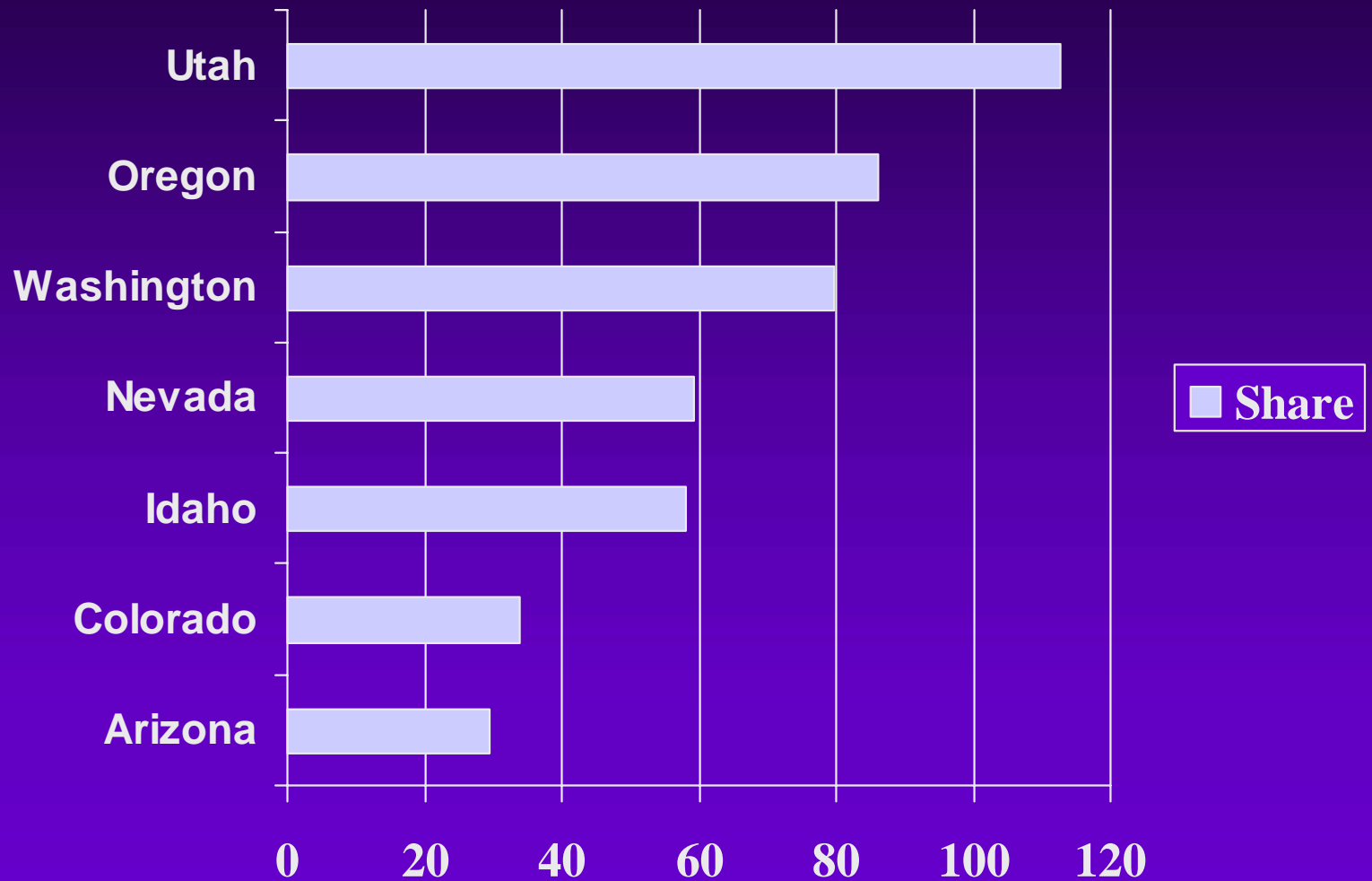
Florida: 2000-04 Components

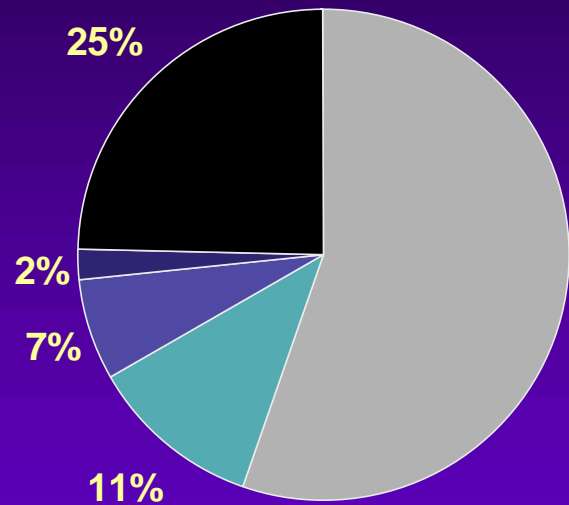


Migrant Shares from California

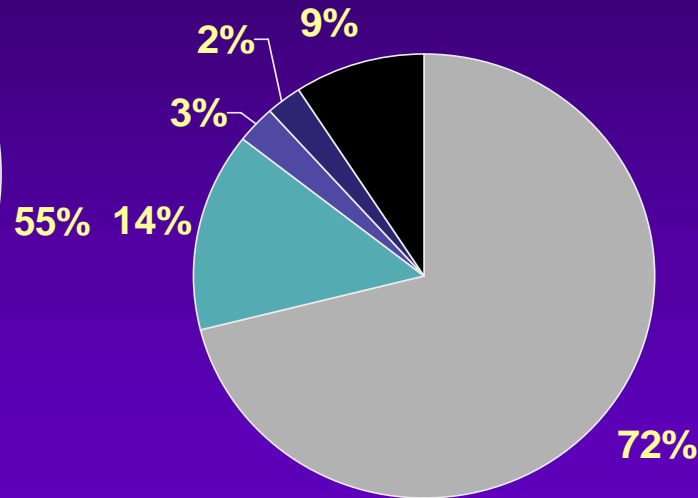


Race Composition of Regions

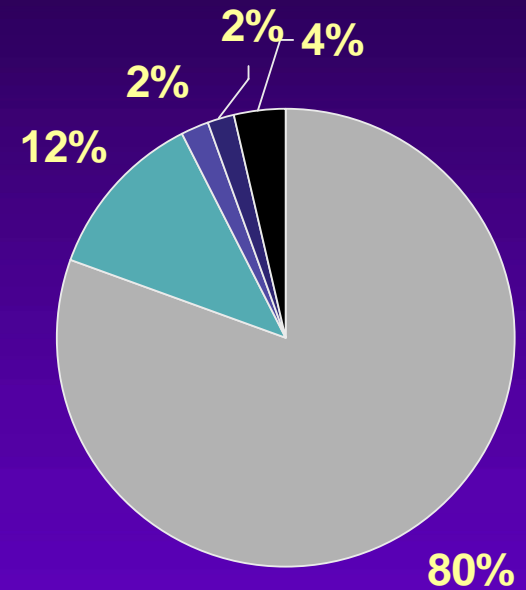

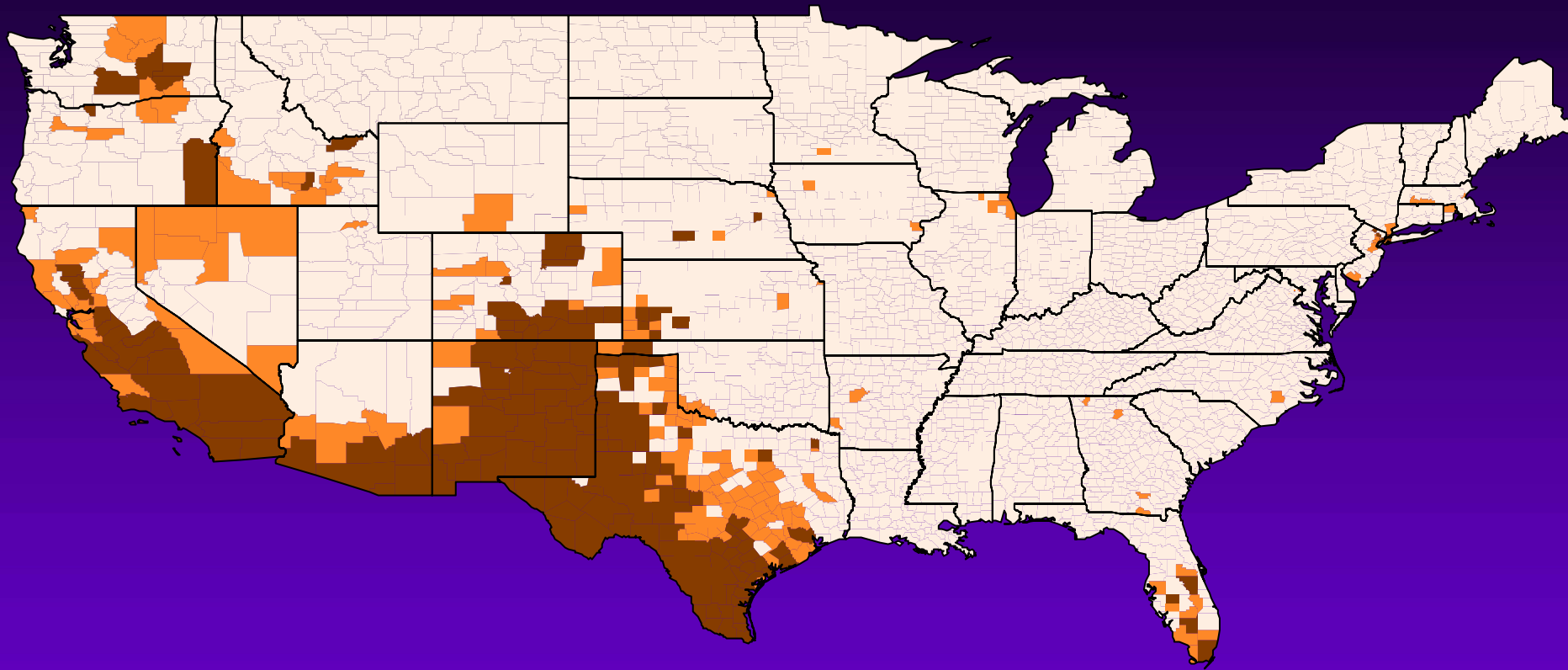

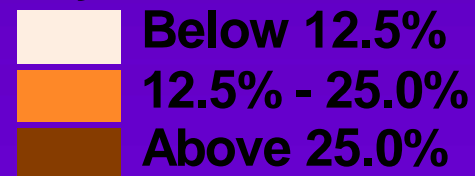

Hispanic Concentration

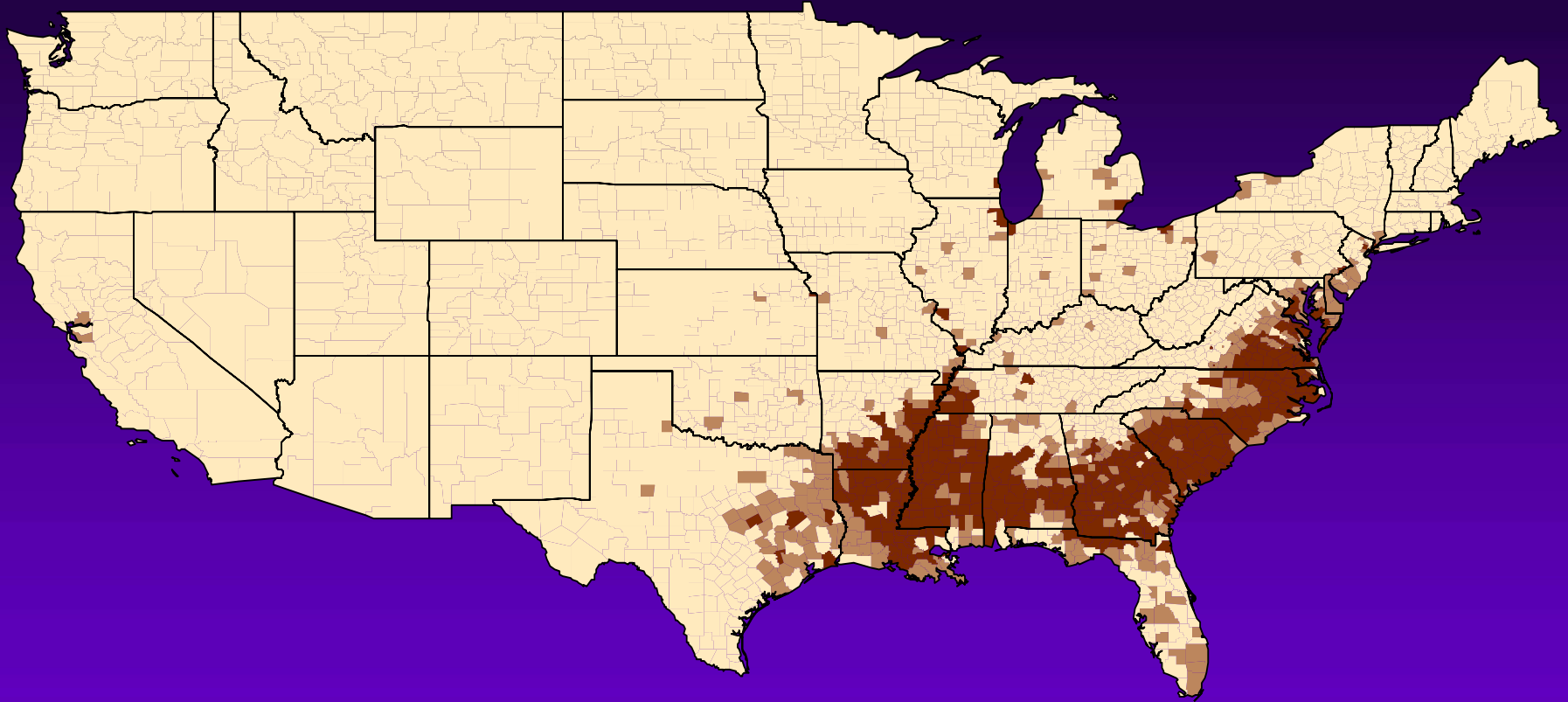

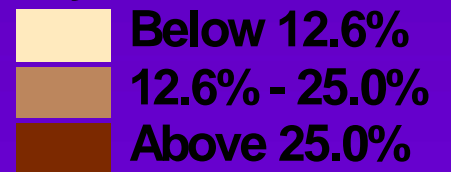

Black Concentration

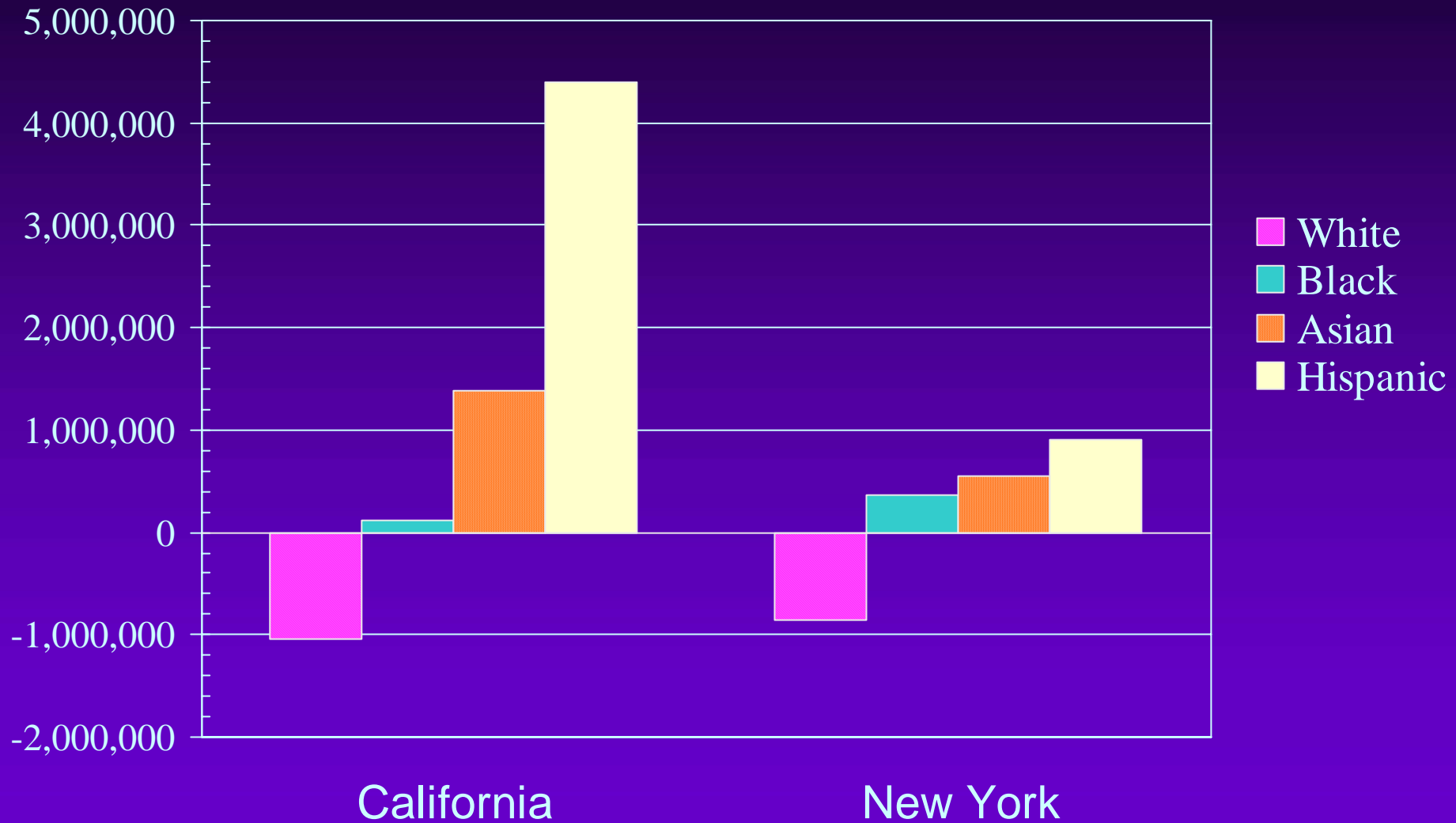

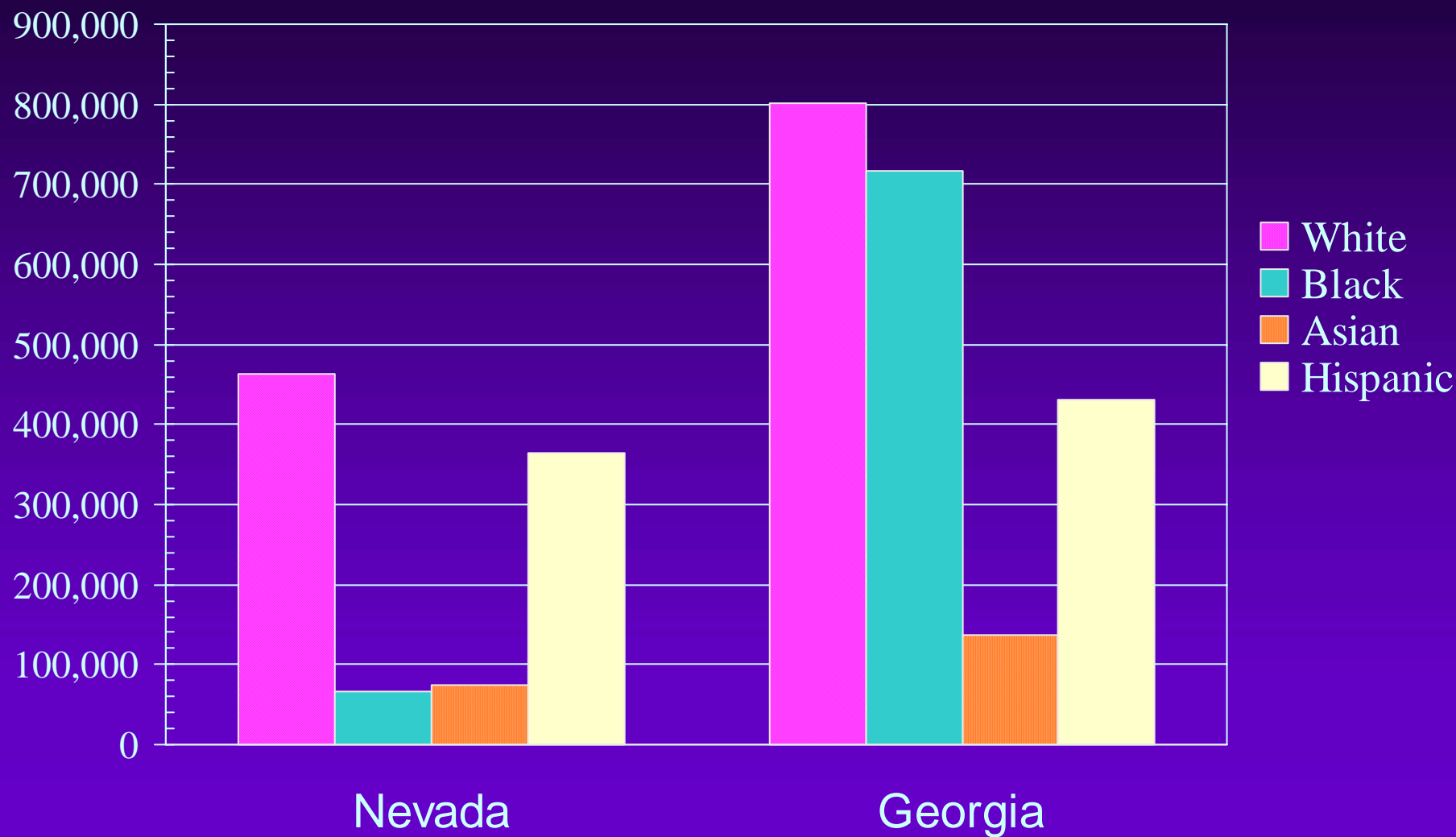

Melting Pot States: Race Change 1990-2003

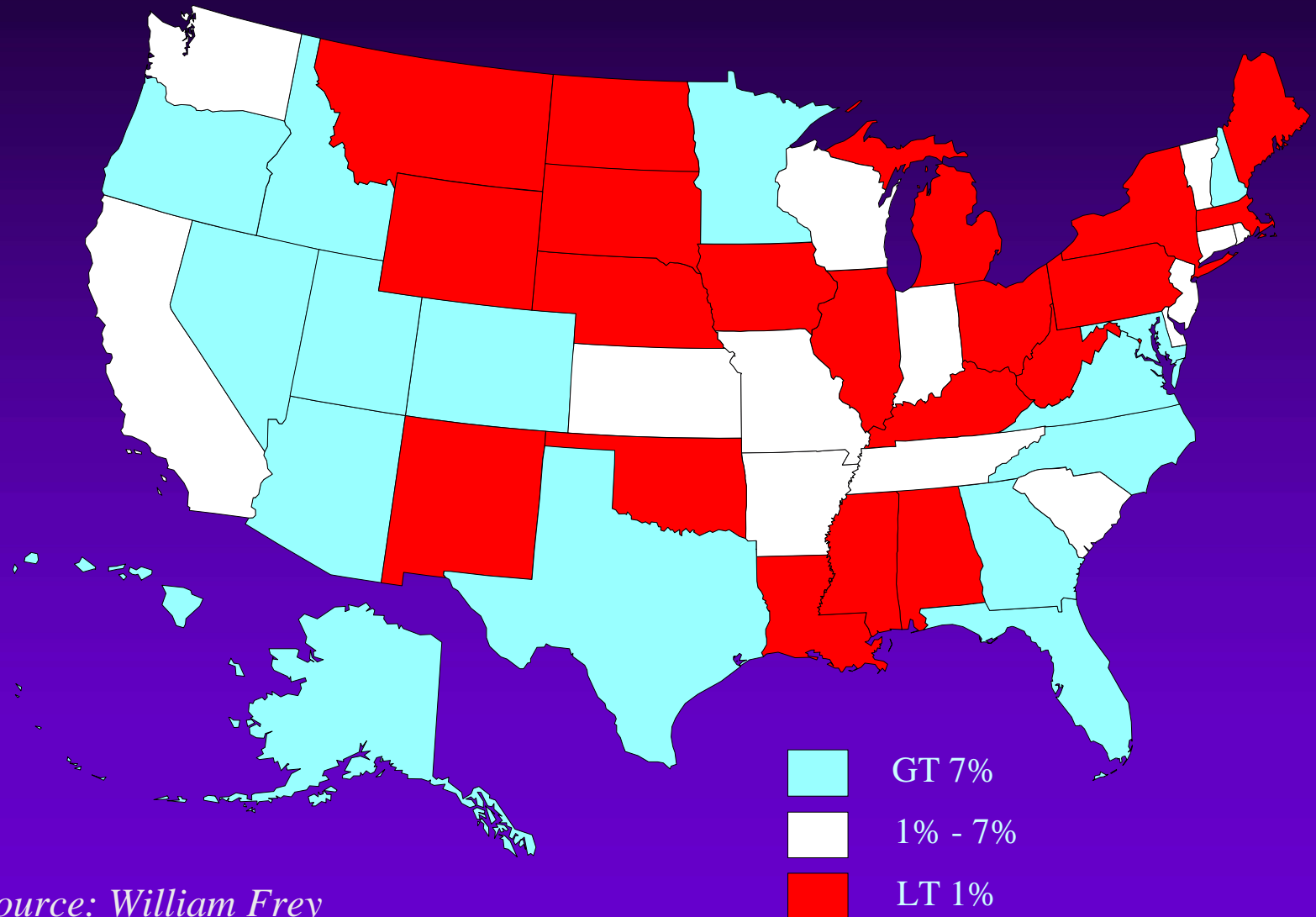

New Sunbelt: Race Change 1990-2003

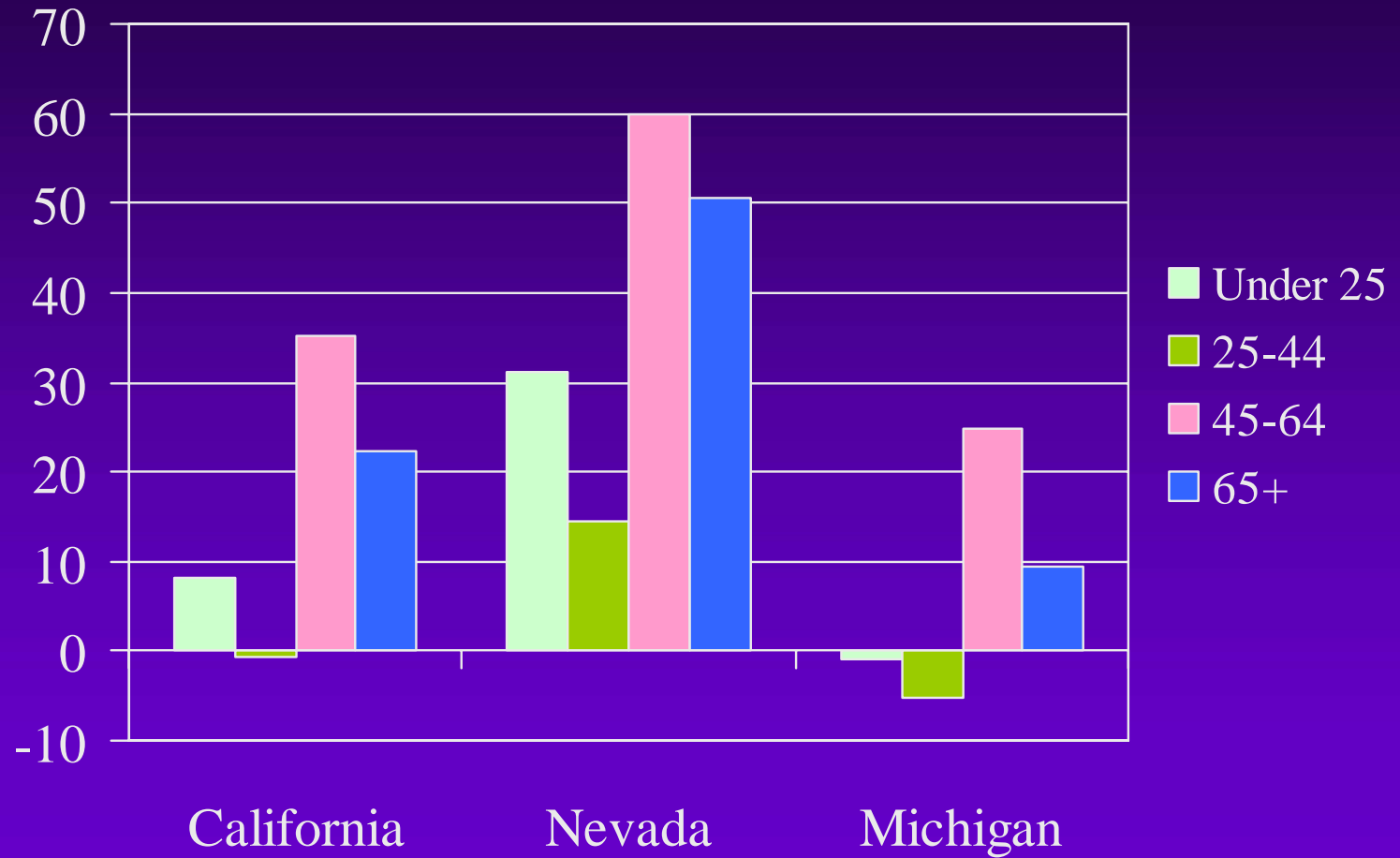


2000-10 Growth: Under Age 35

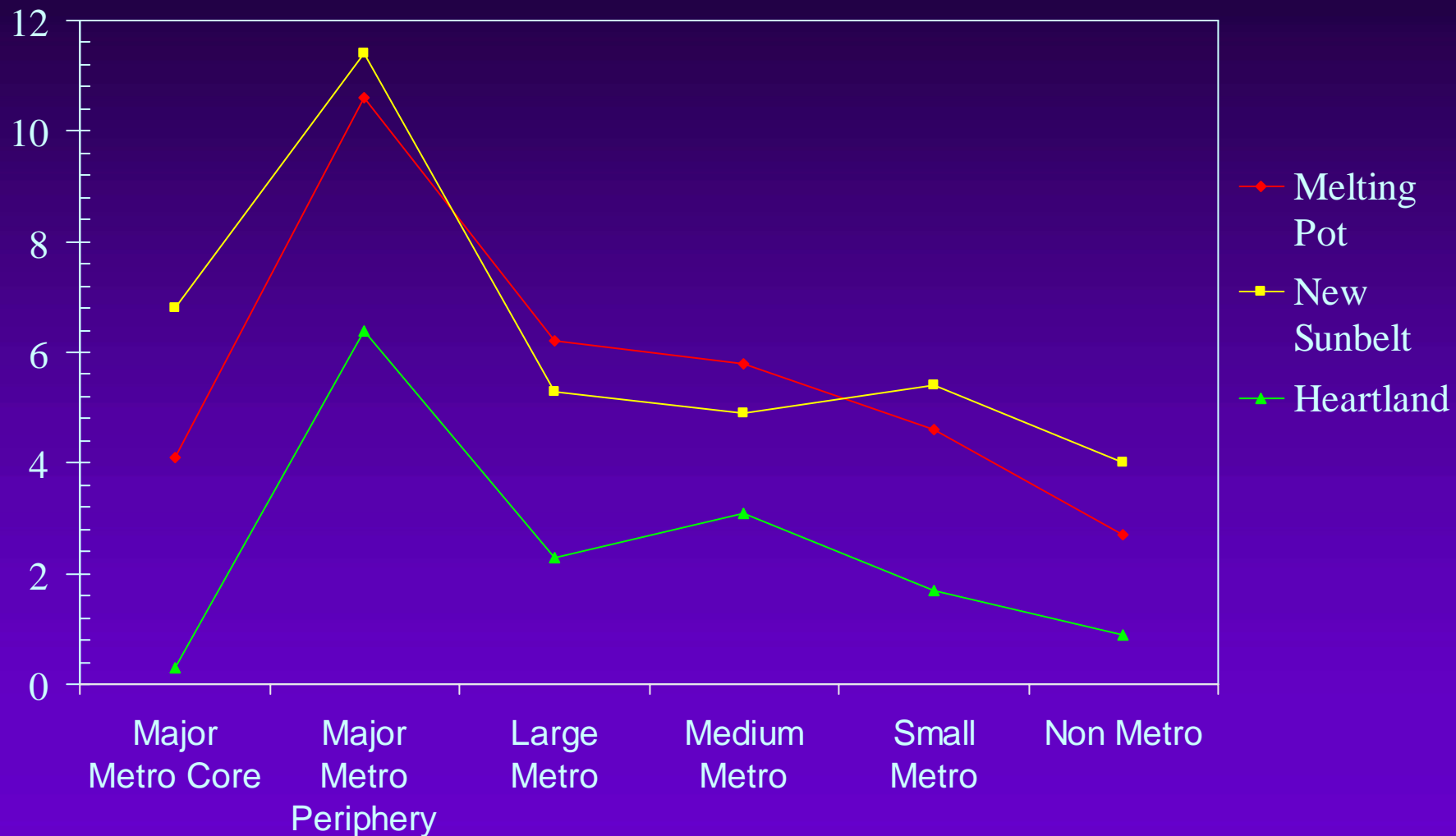

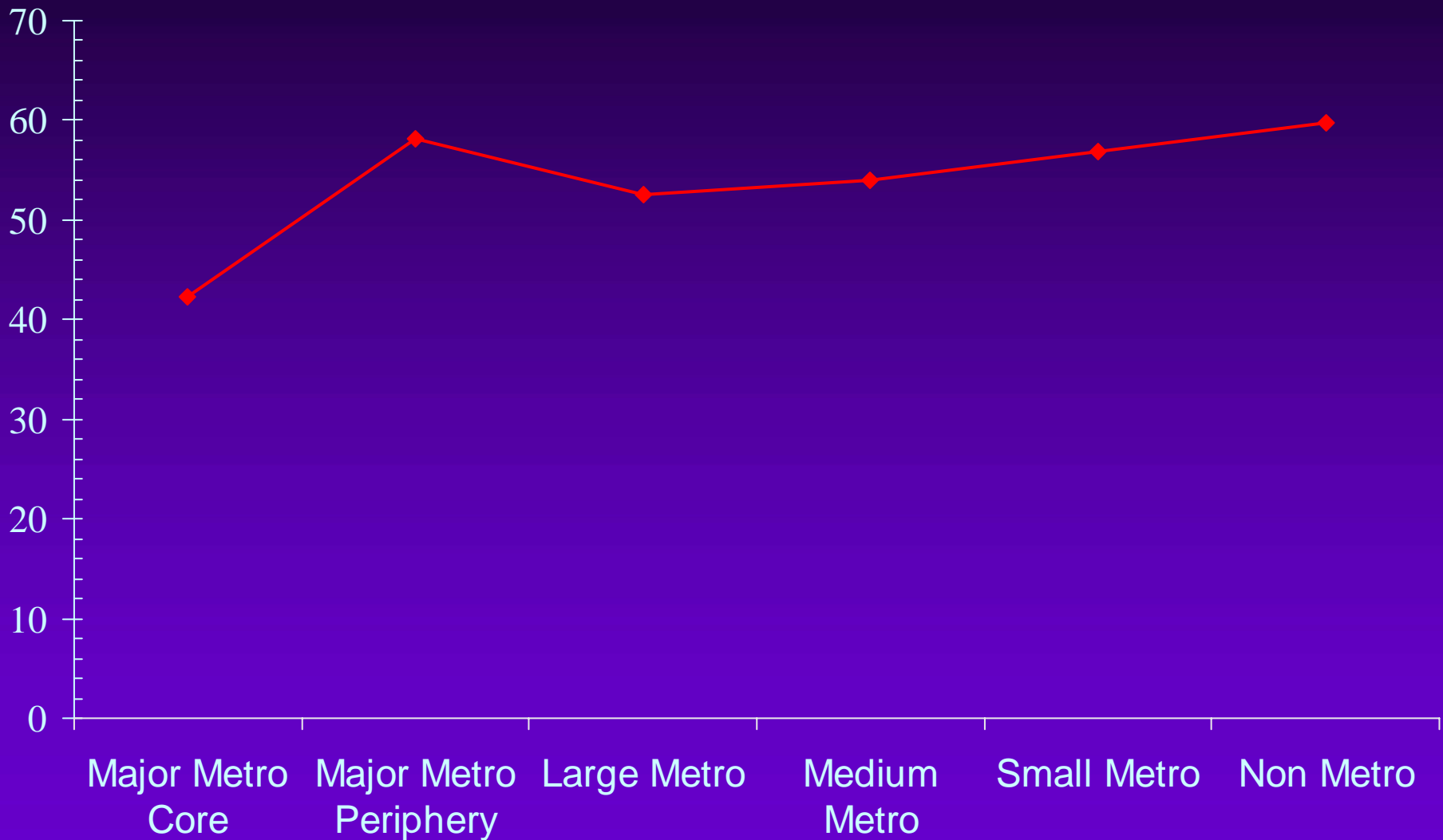
Growth by Age, 2000-10

Bush 2004 Vote by Urban-Suburban

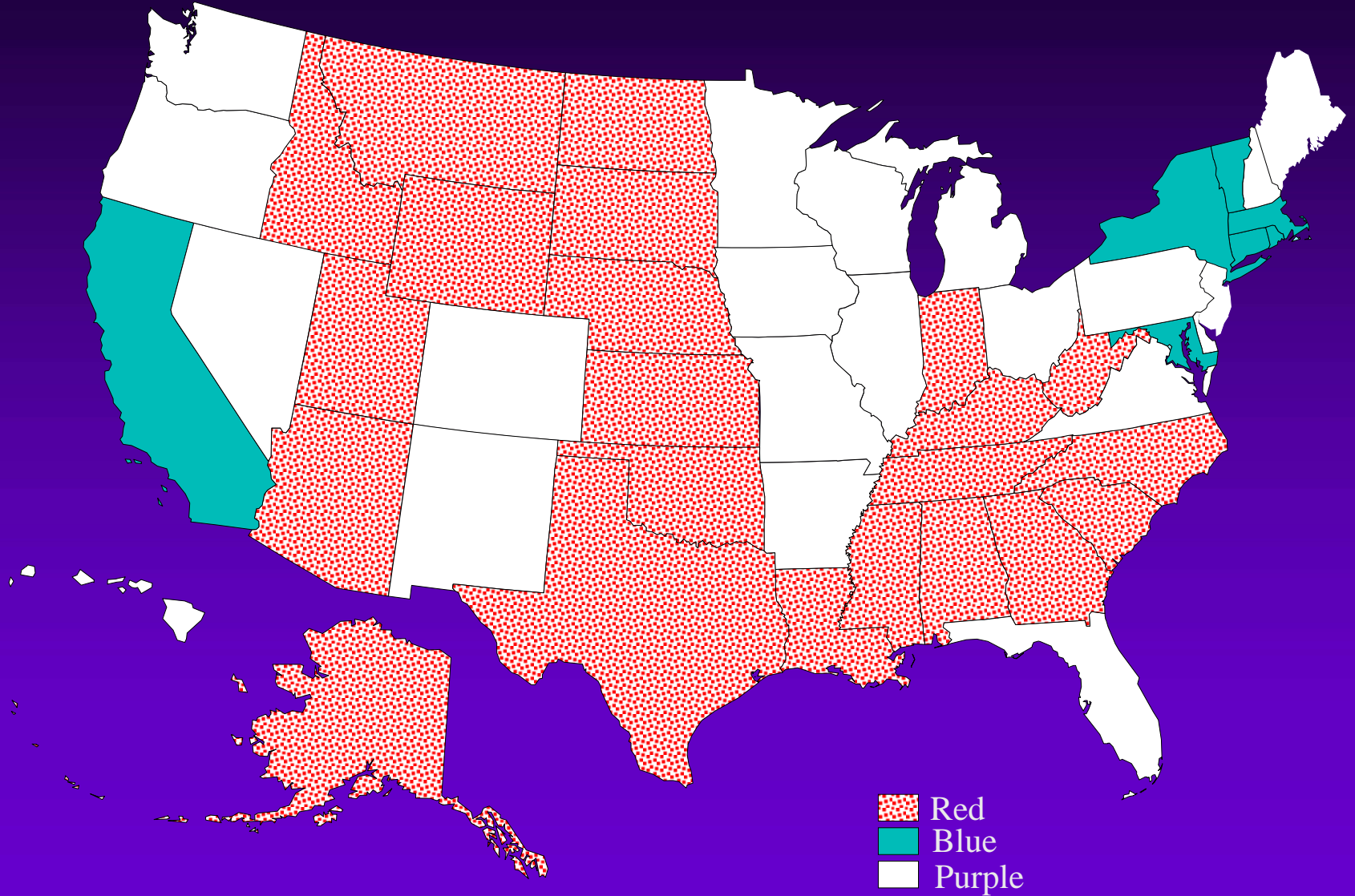

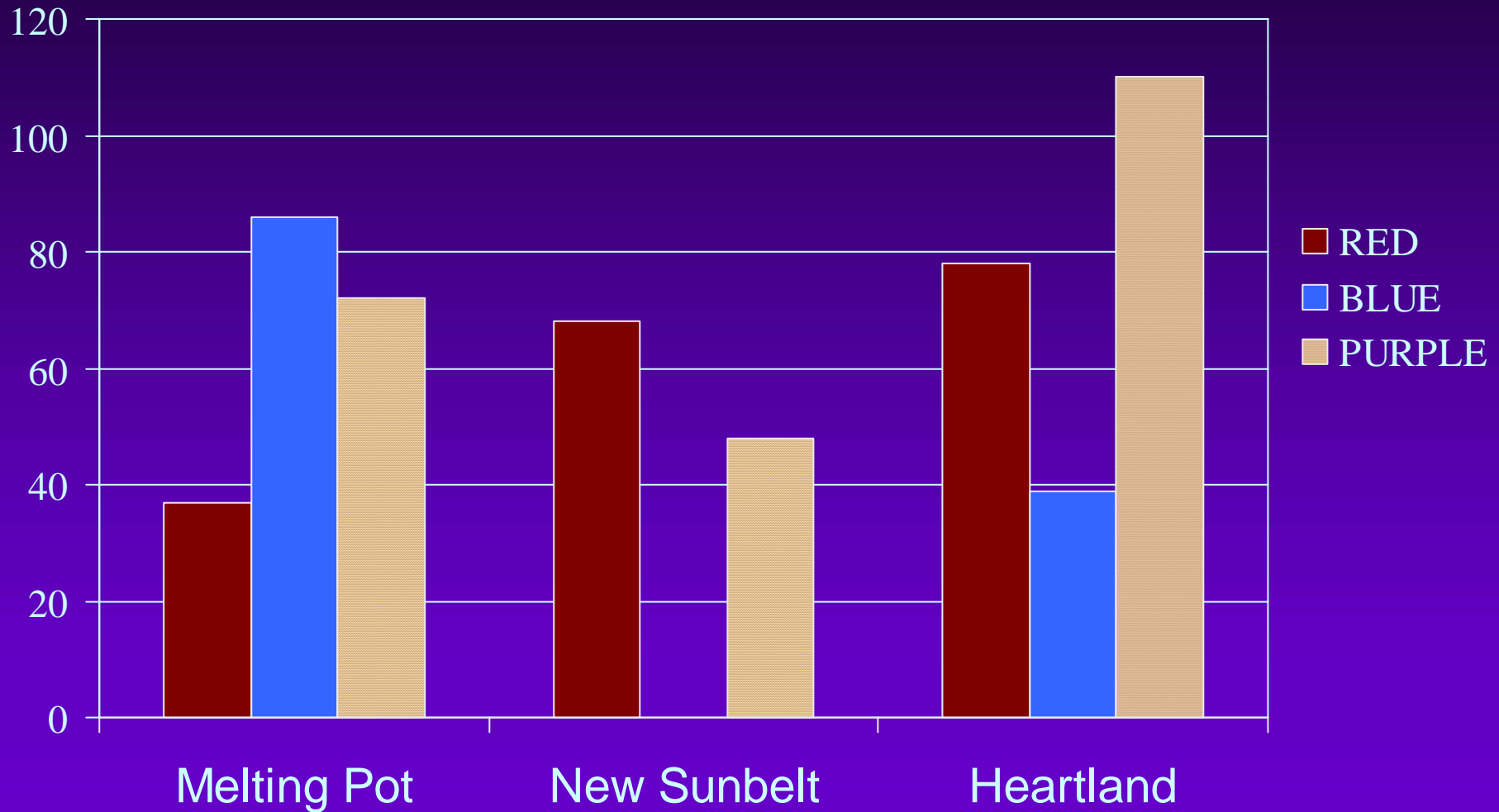

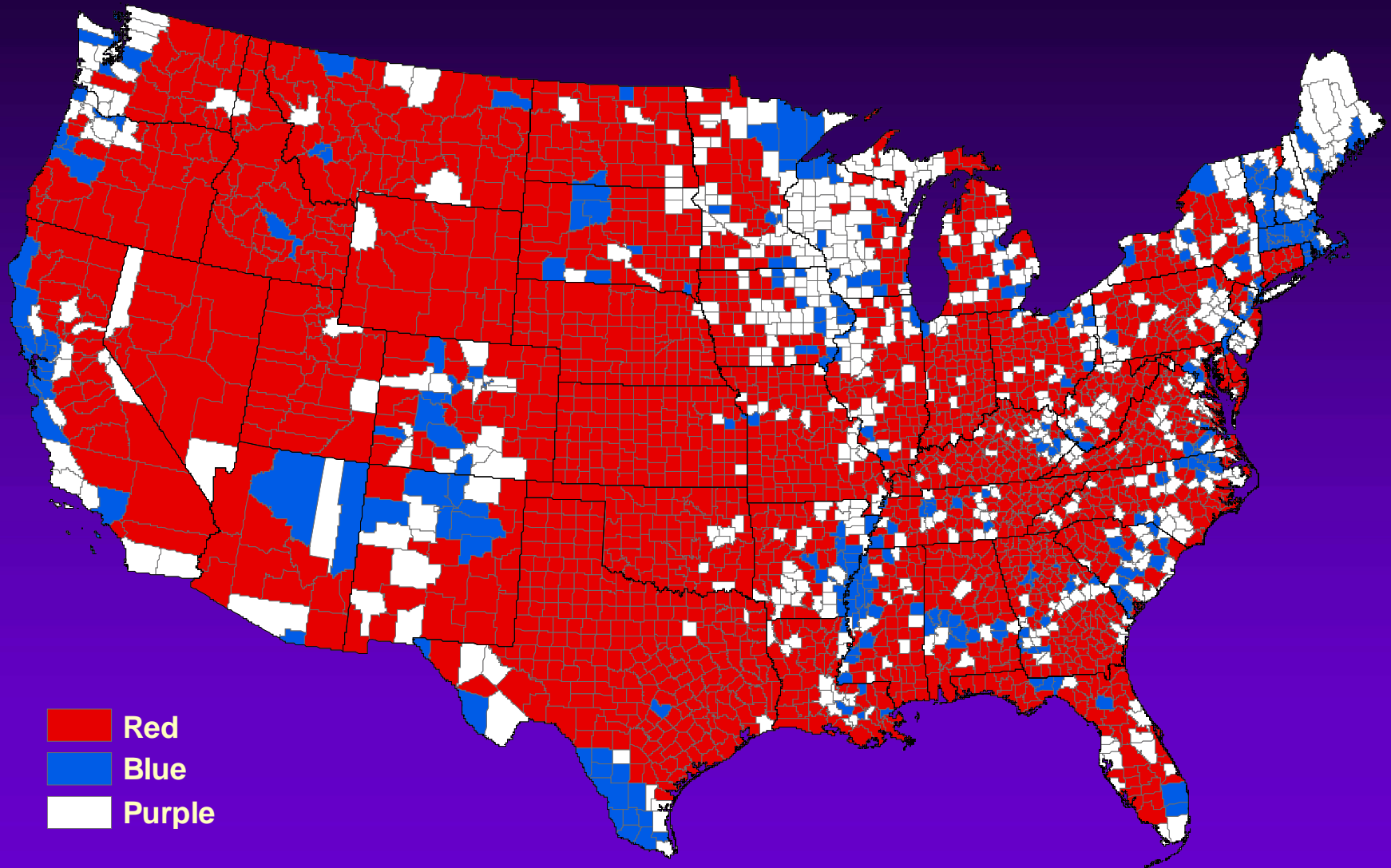

Red, Blue and Purple State Electoral Votes, 2004



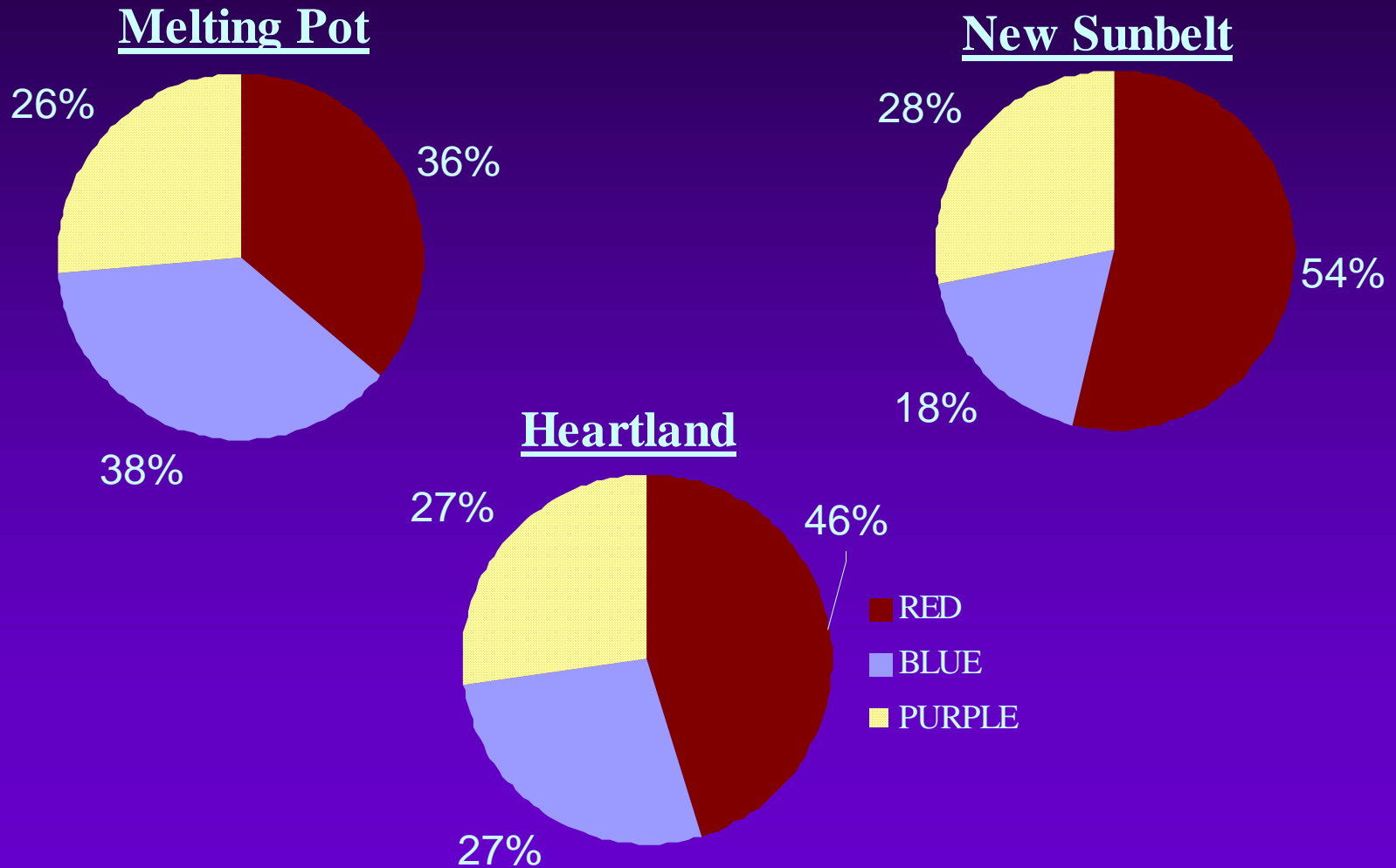

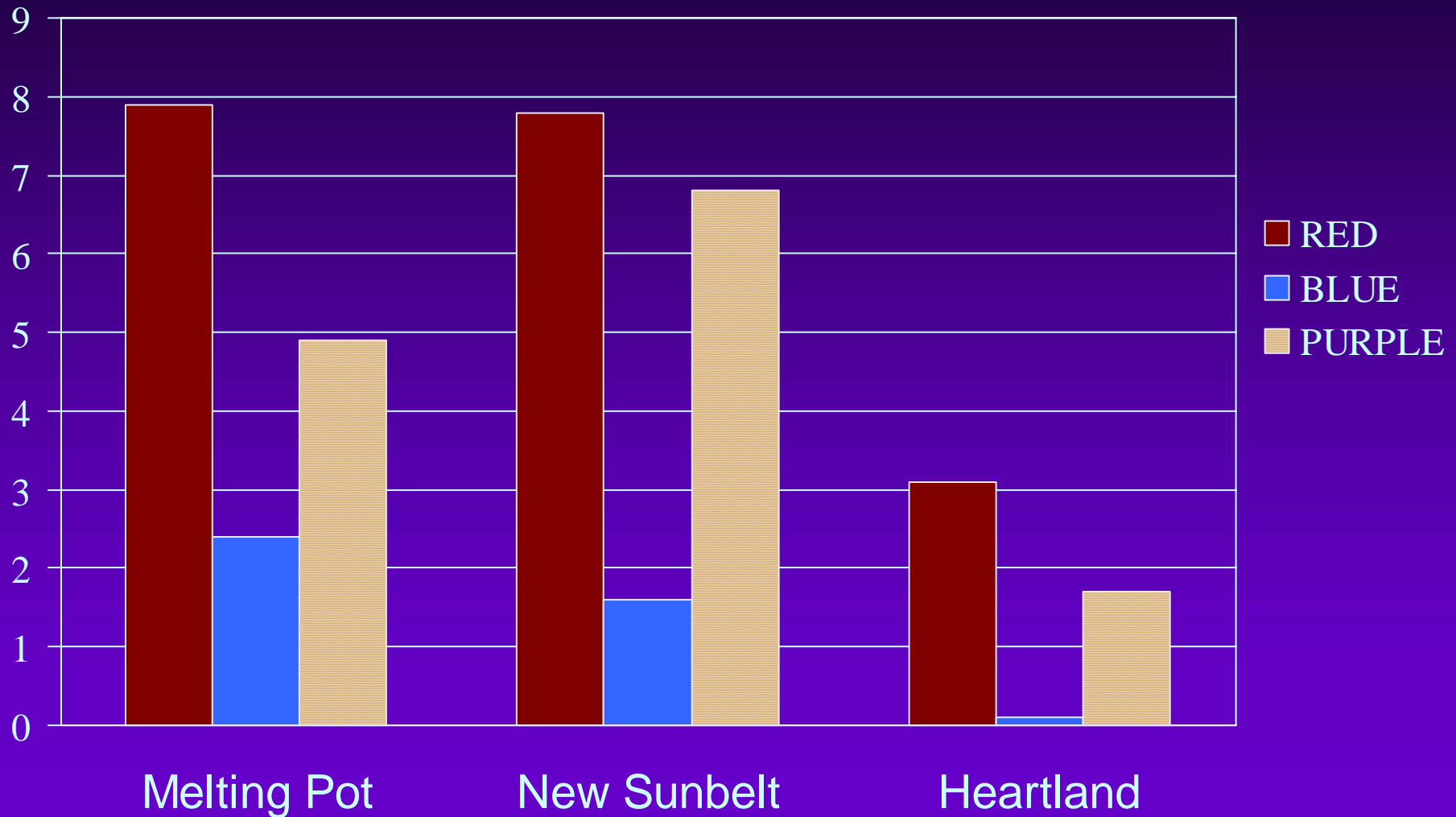

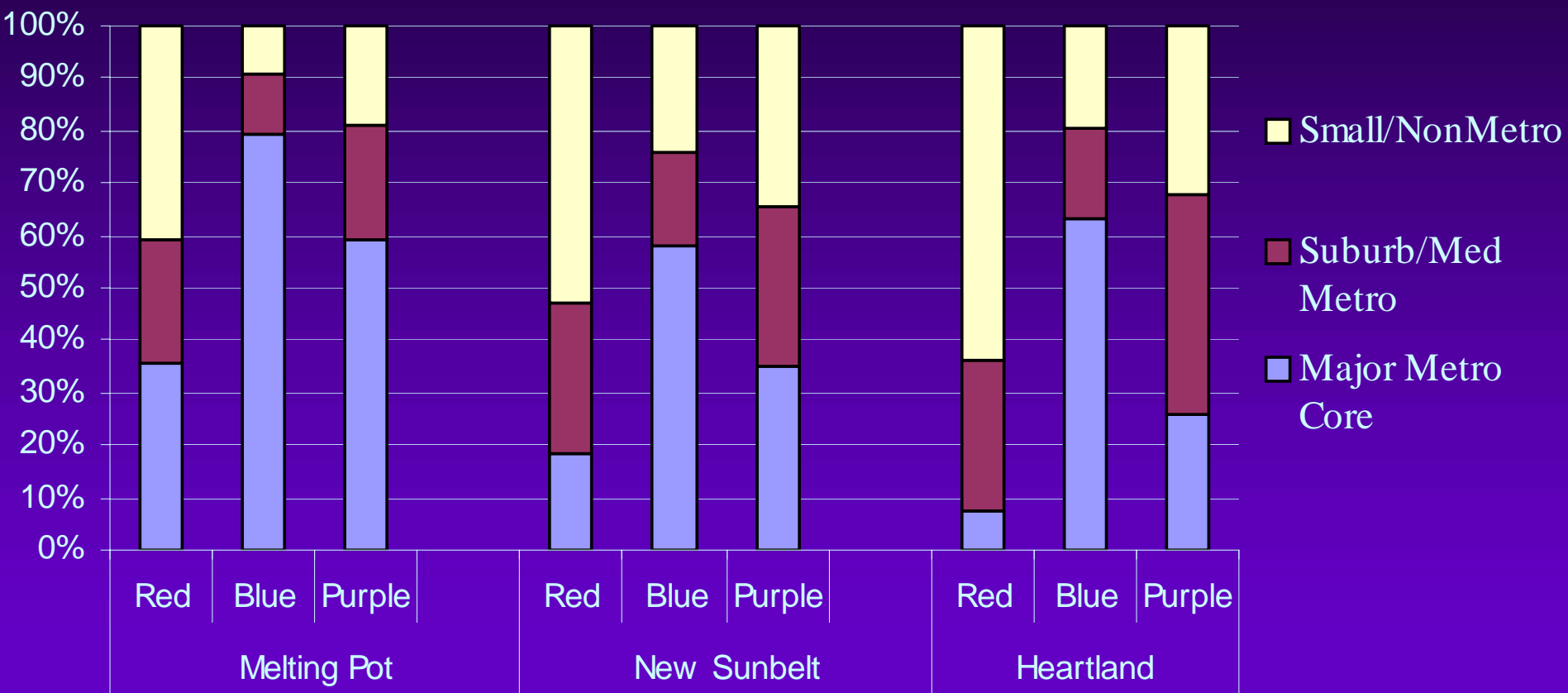
Population in Red, Blue and Purple Counties, 2004



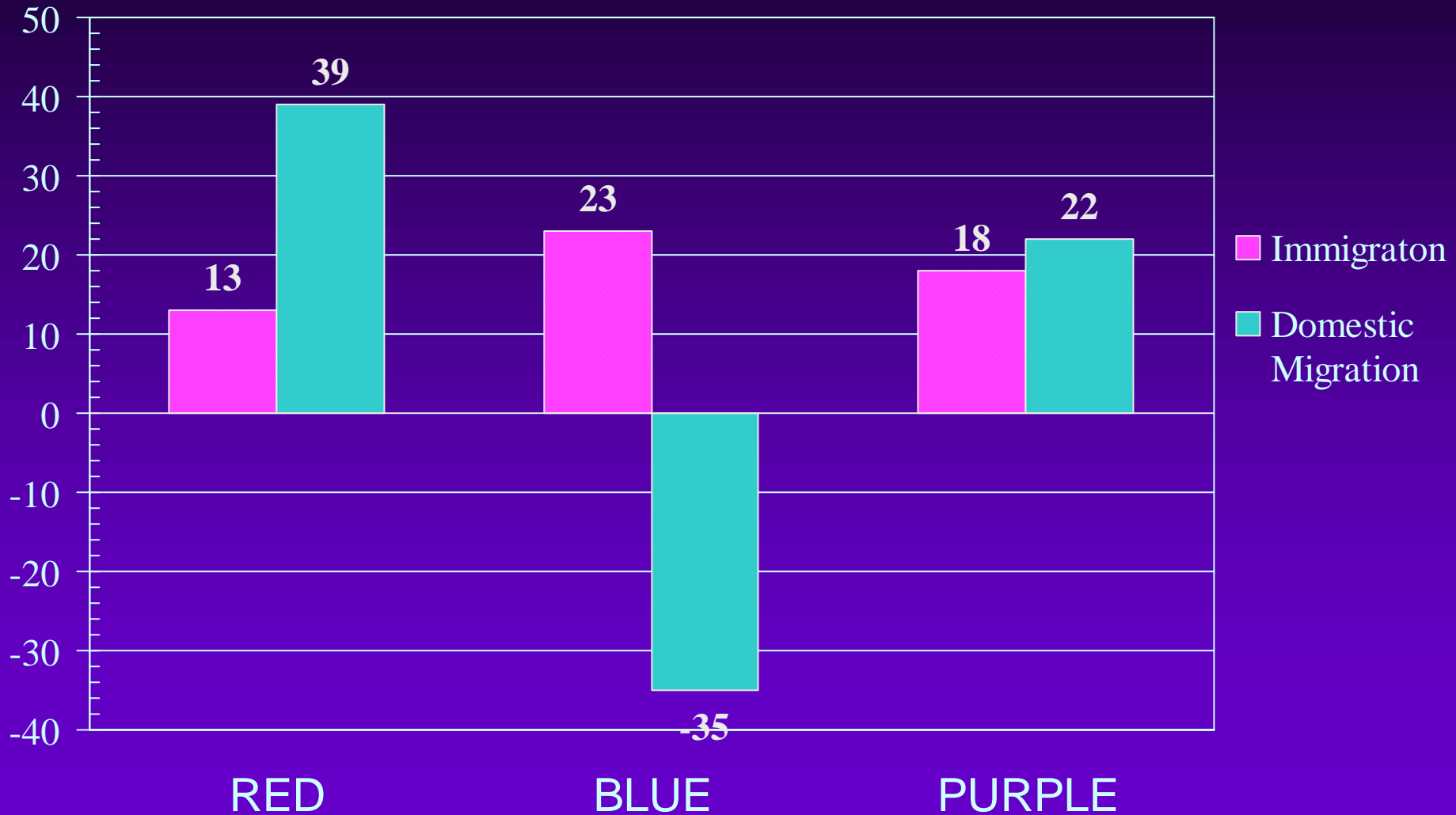
Percent Population Change, 2000-04



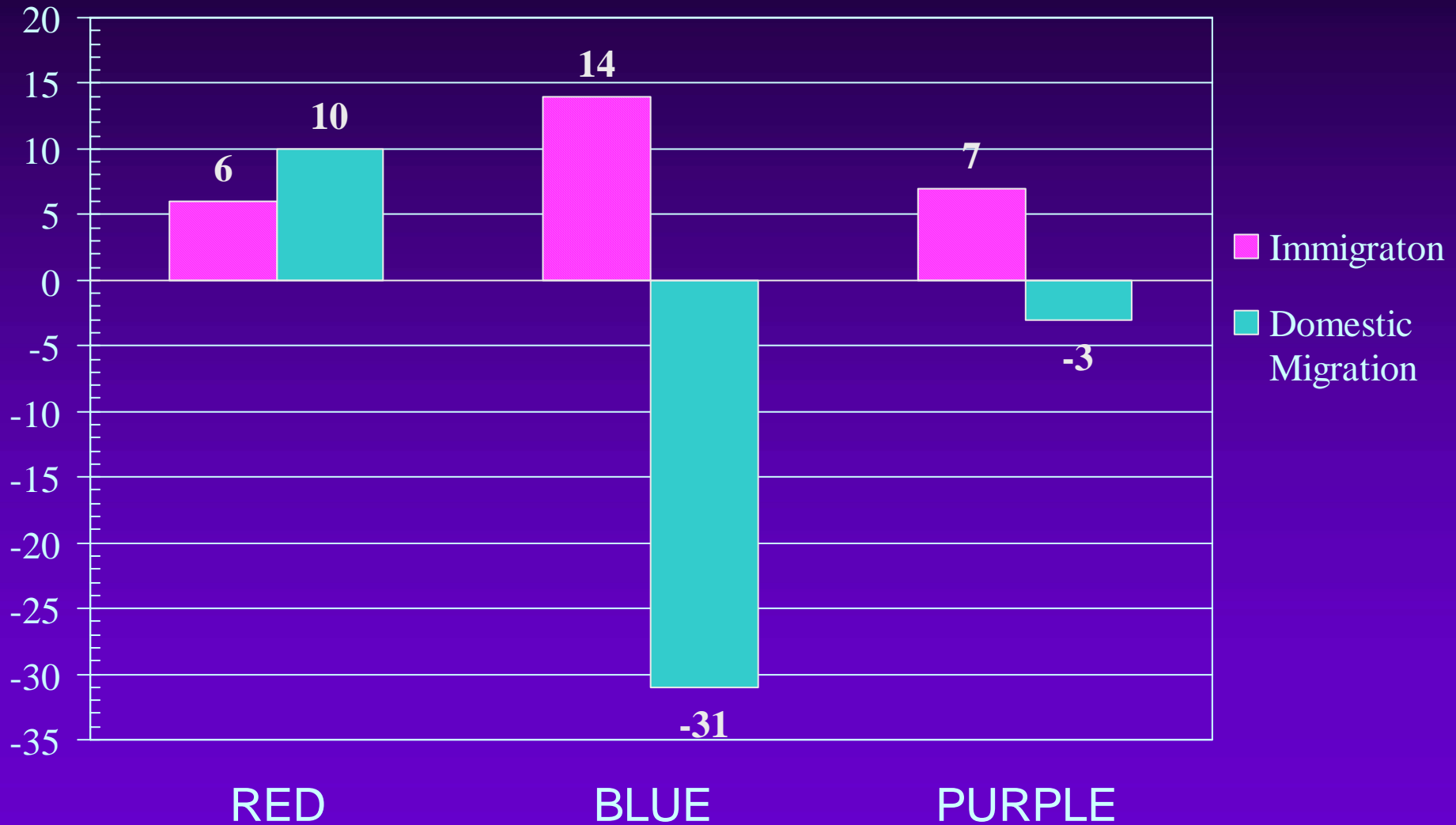

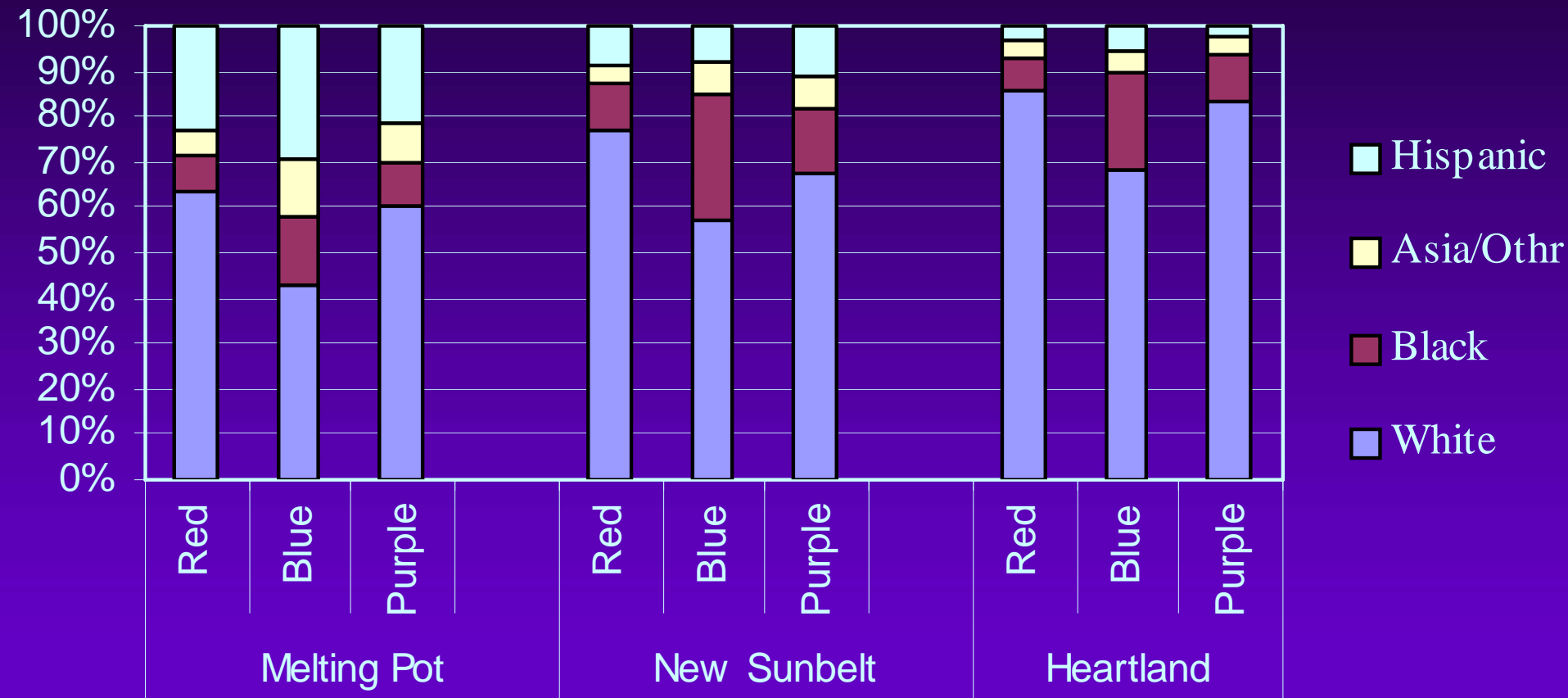

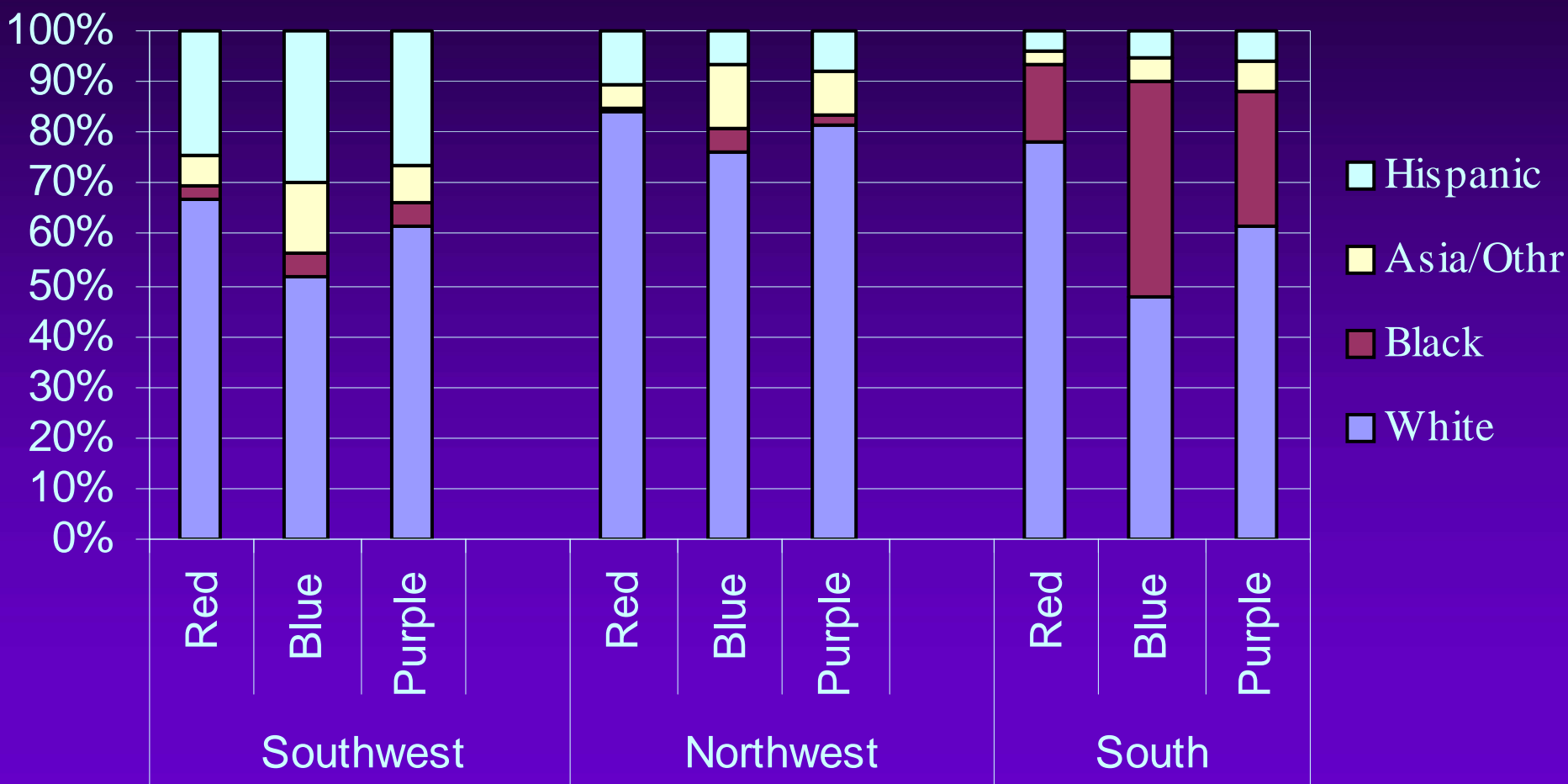

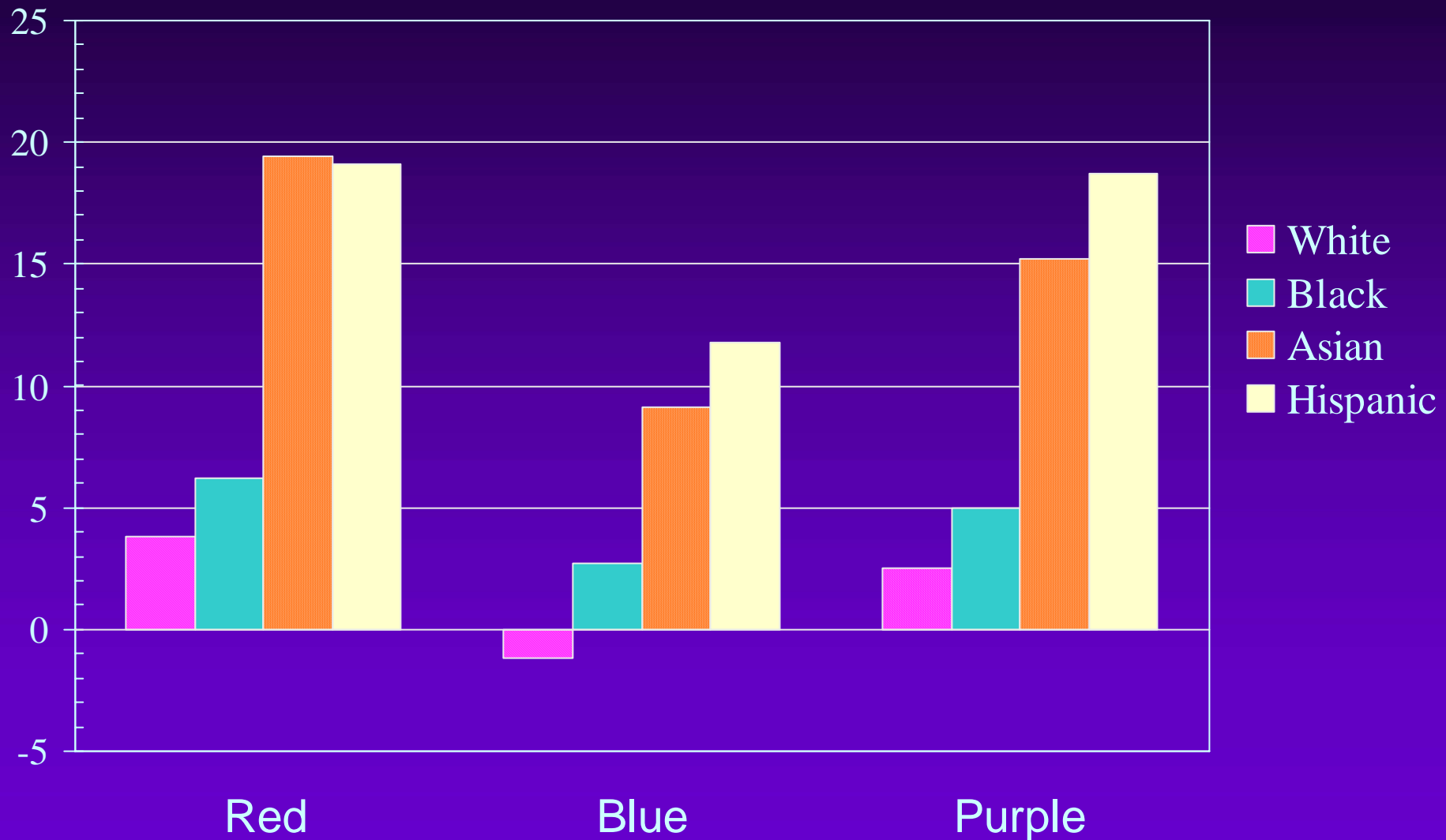

New Sunbelt Subregions: Race Profiles

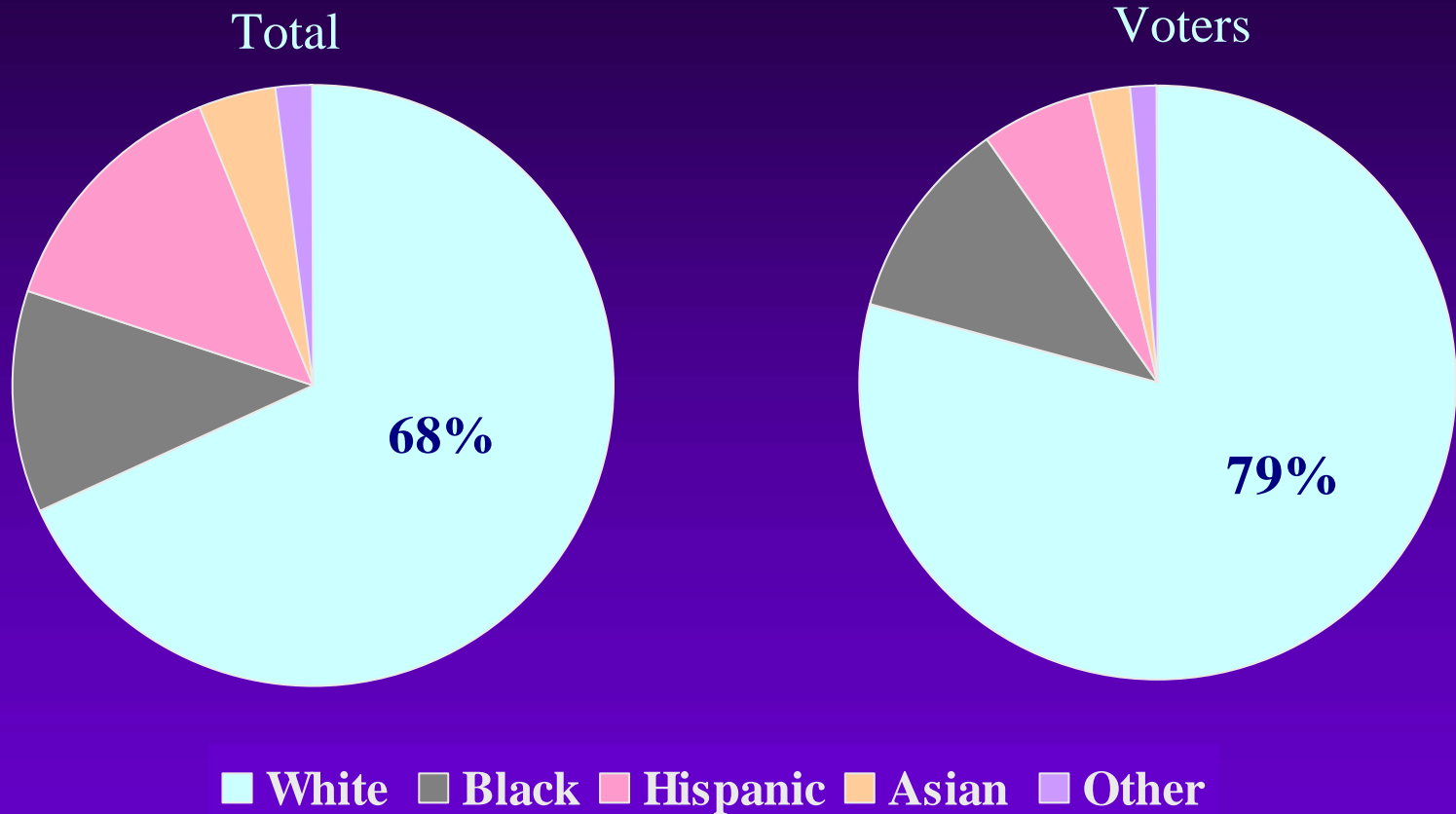


New Sunbelt Race Growth 2000-04

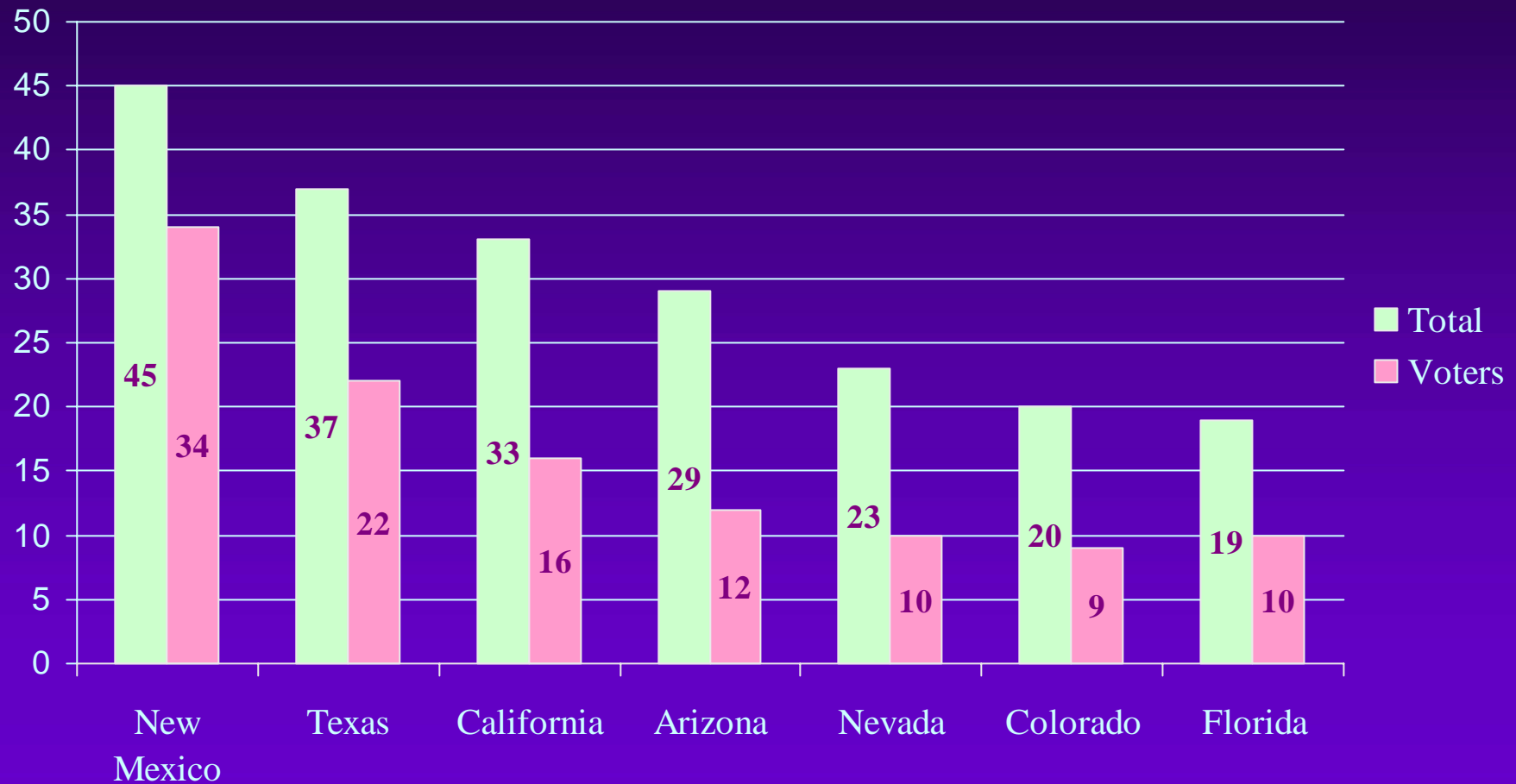

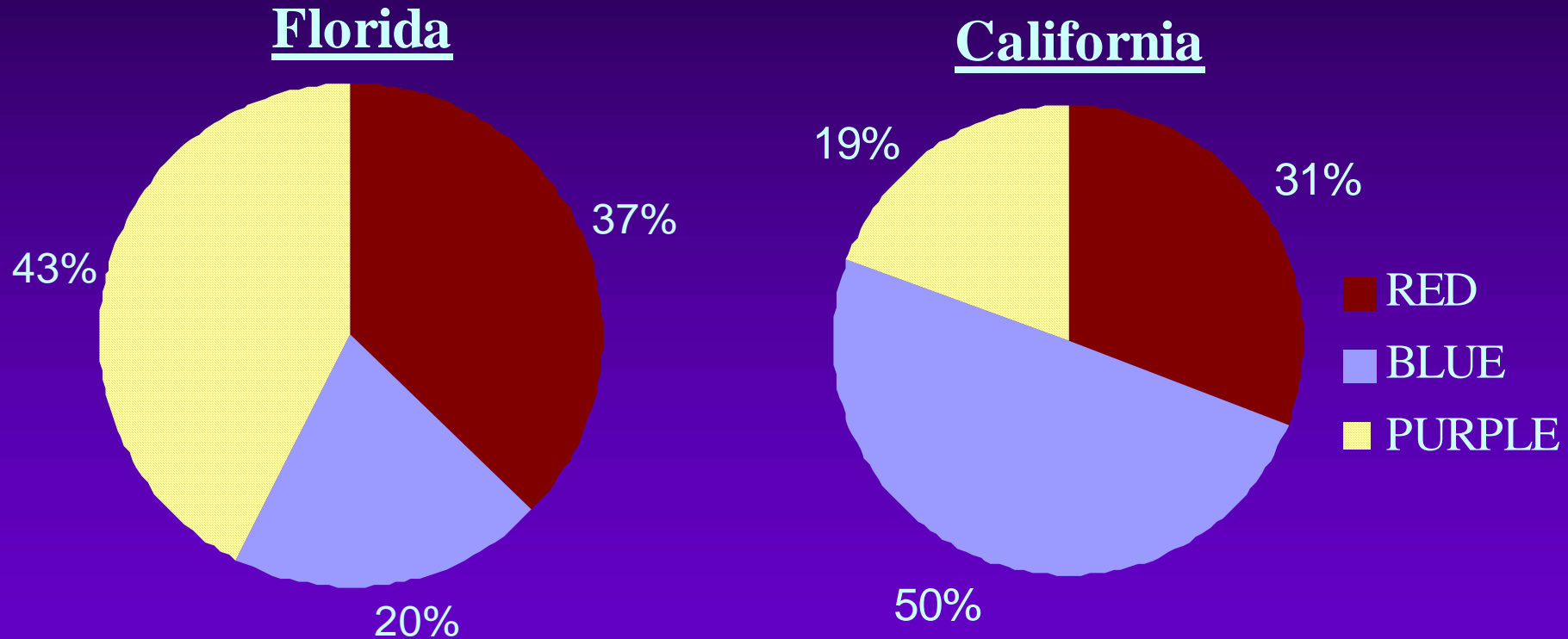
US: Race Profile Comparisons, 2004



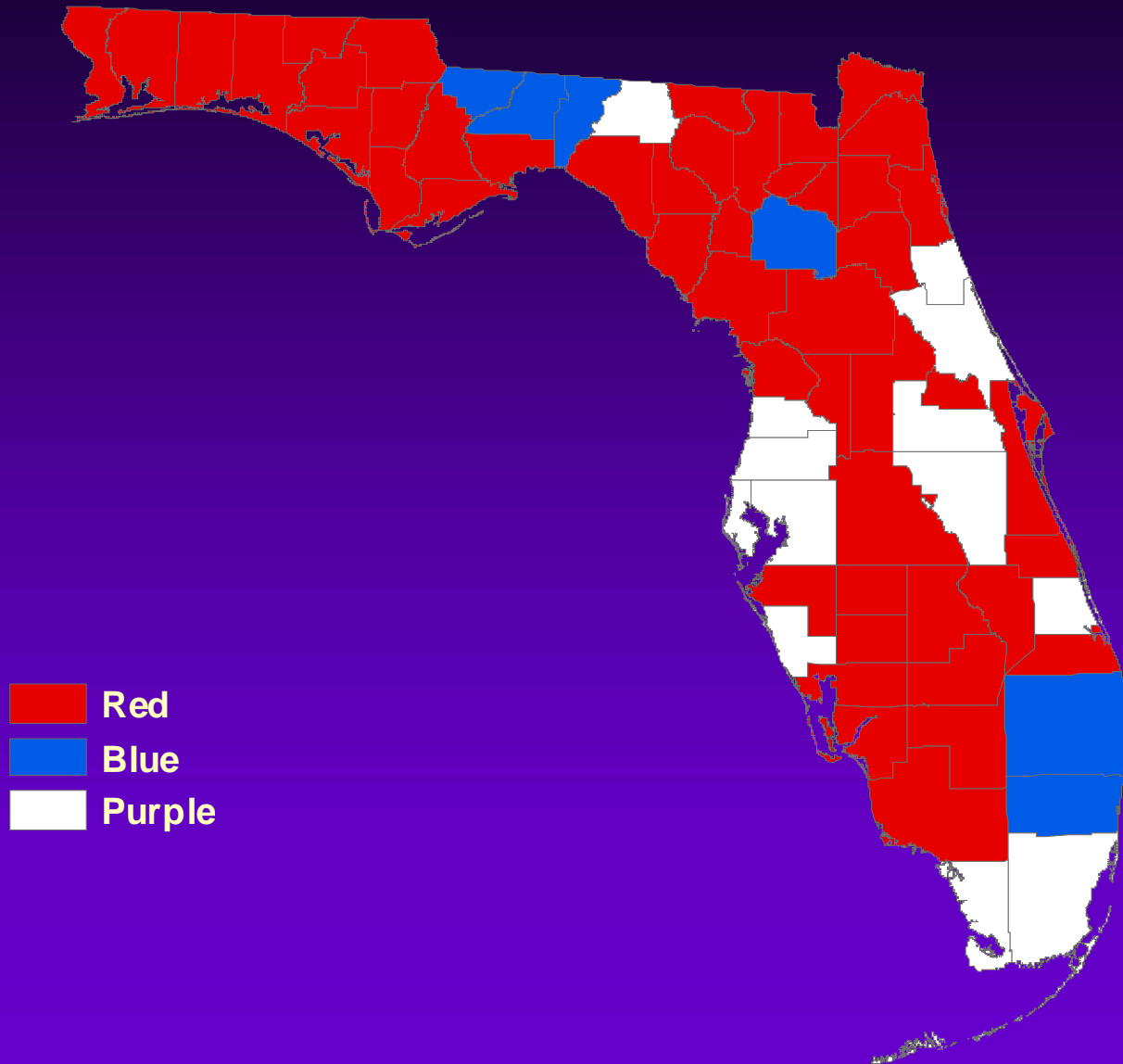
Hispanics: 2004 Total vs Voter Shares



Population in Red, Blue and Purple Counties, 2004

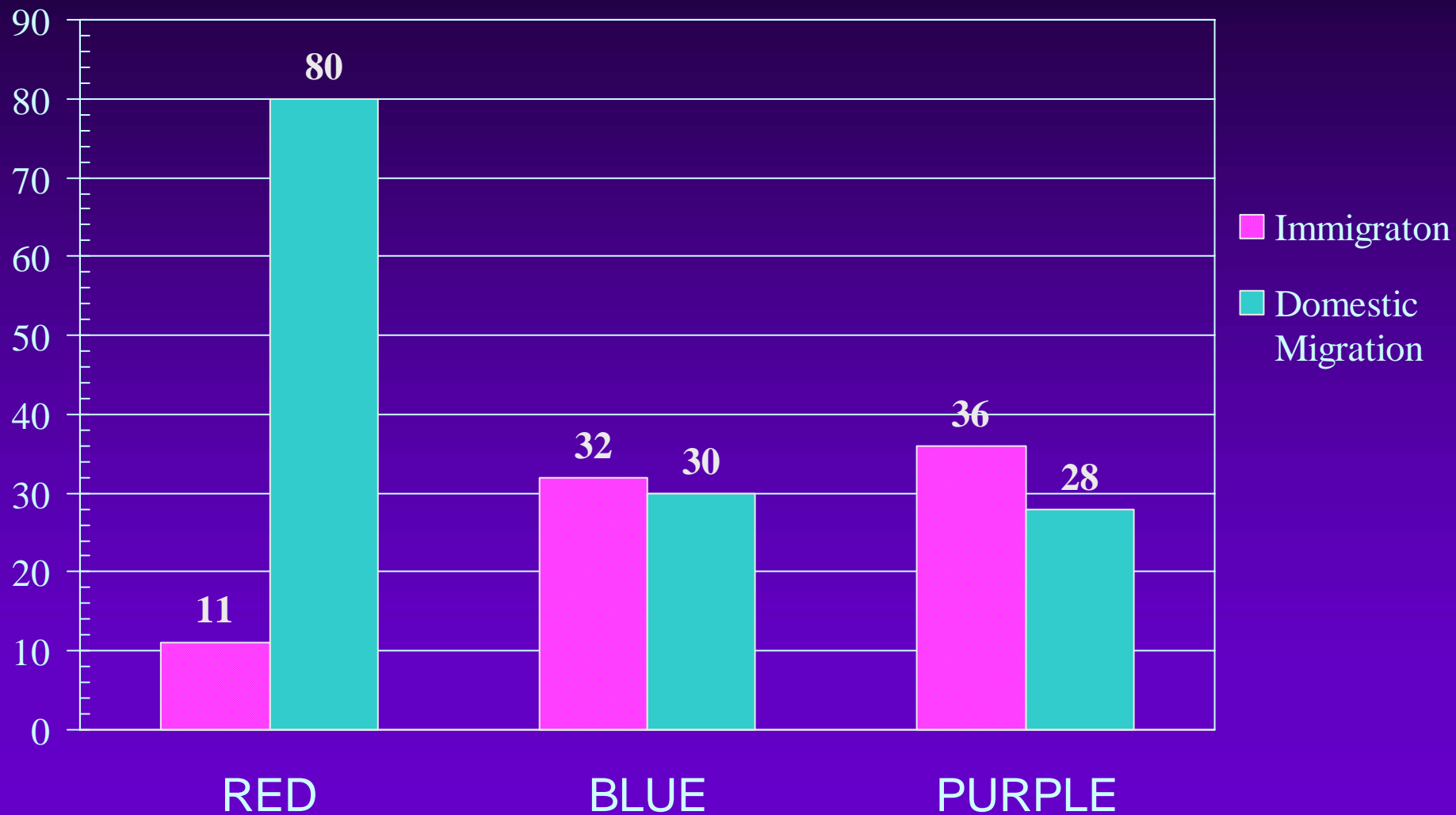


Florida: 2004 Red, Blue, and Purple Cos

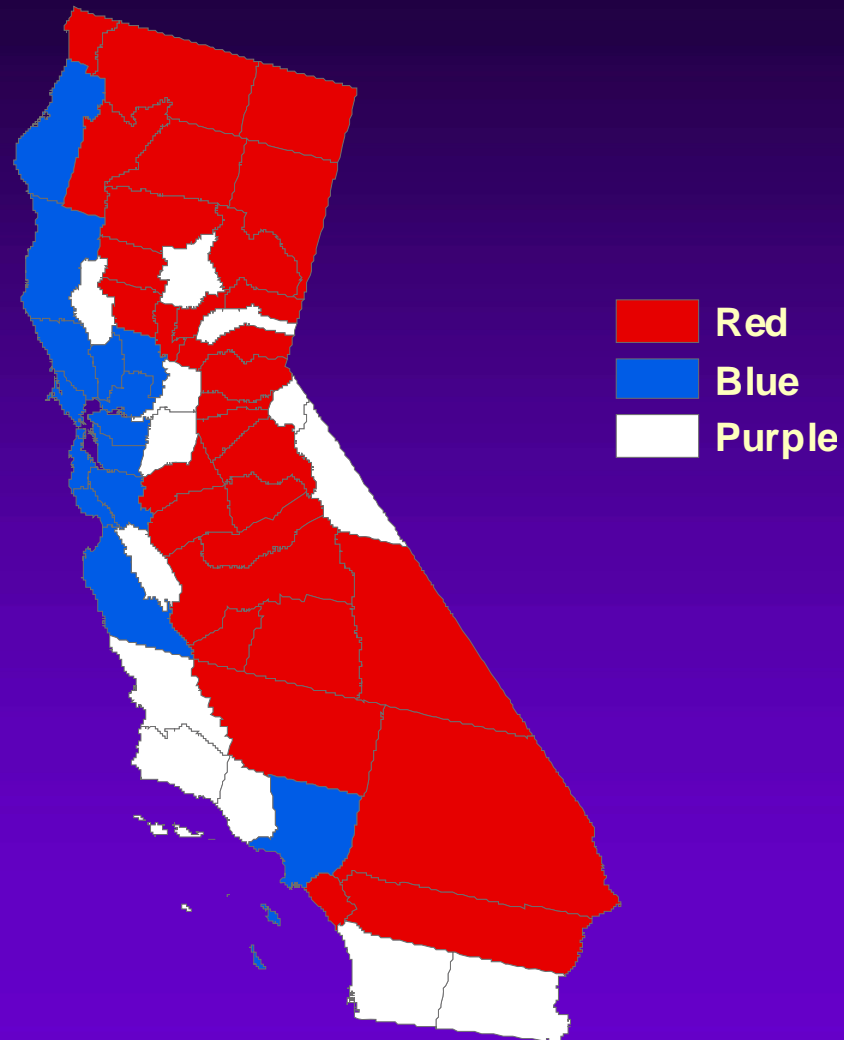

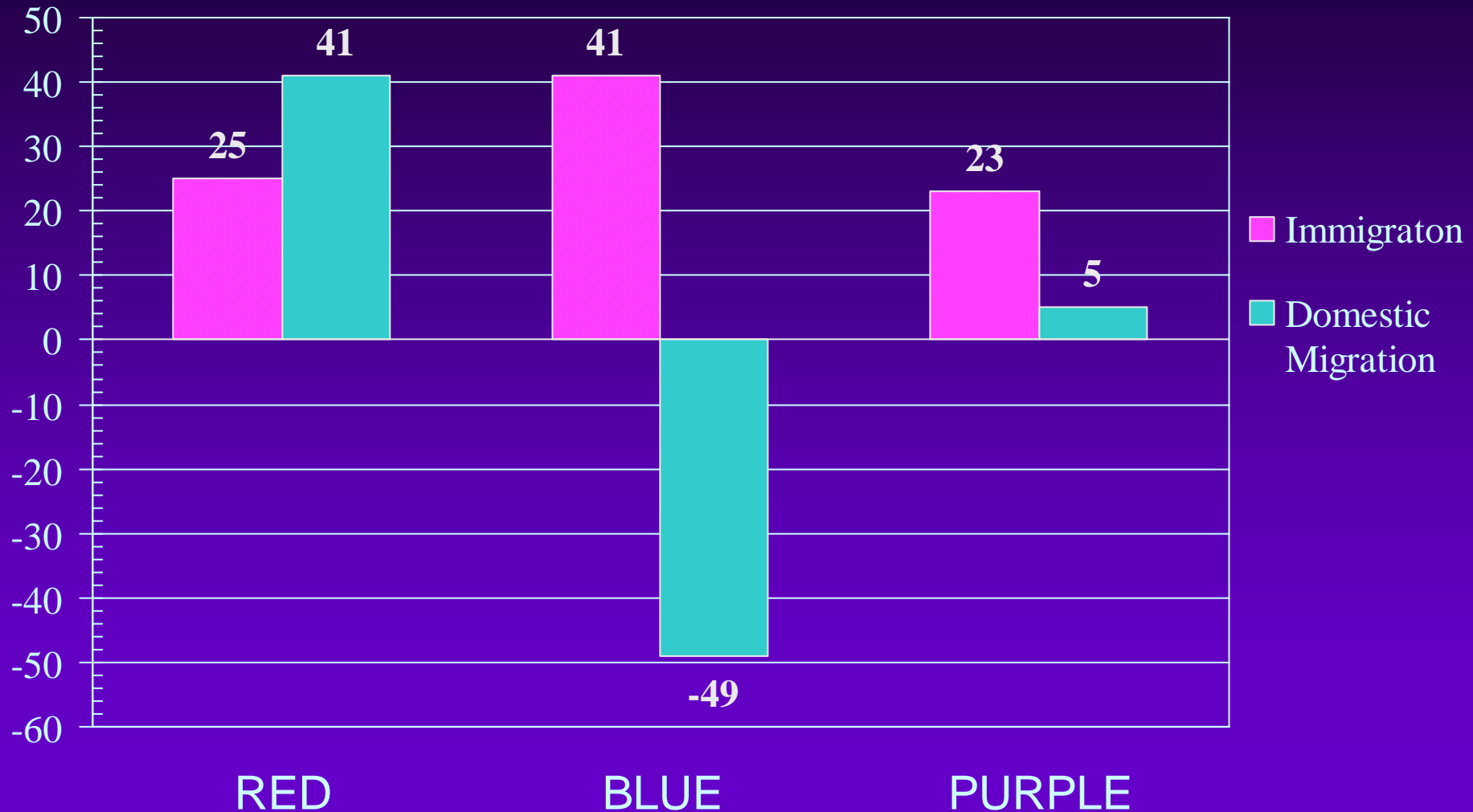


California: 2004 Red, Blue, and Purple Cos.

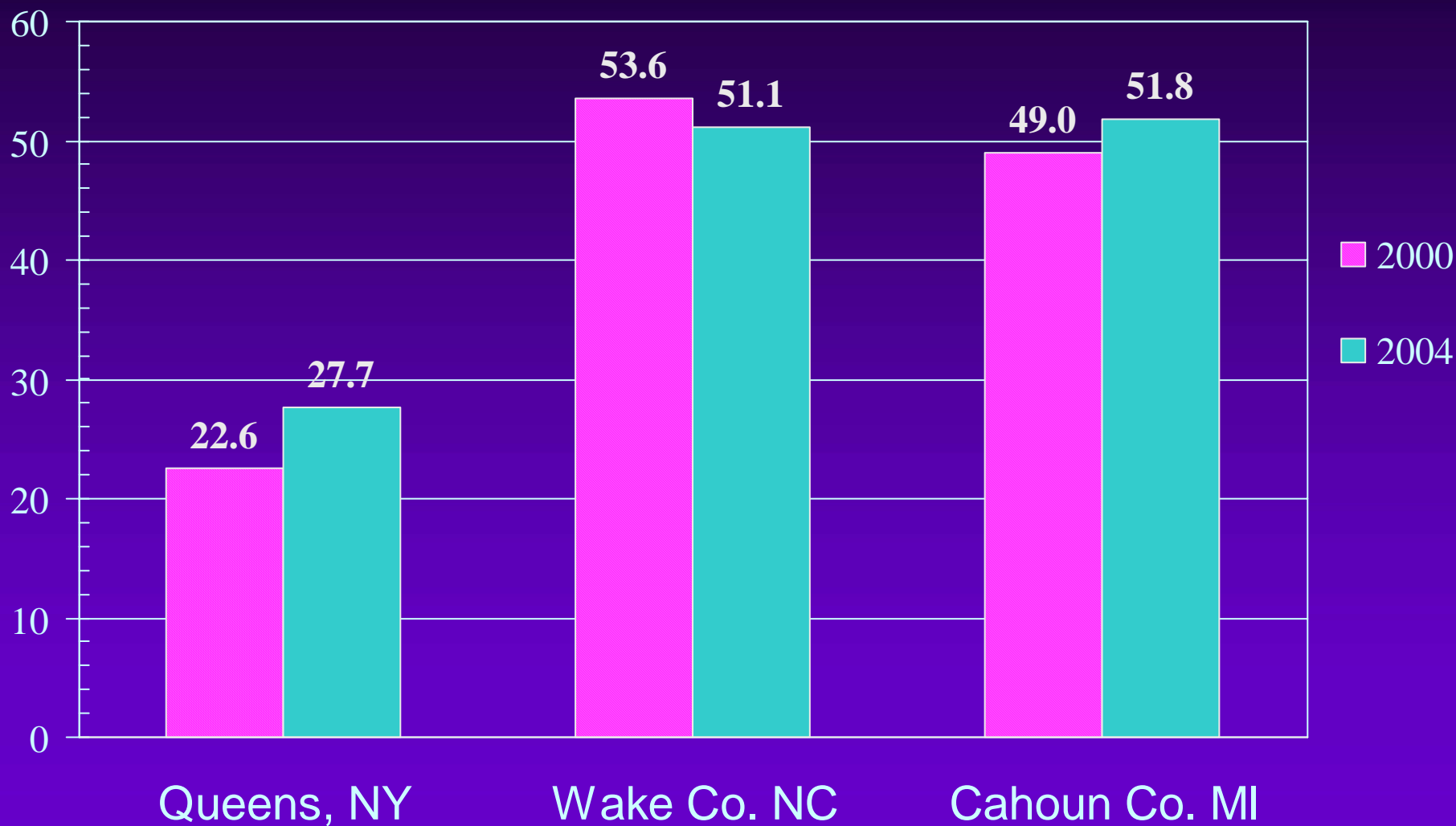

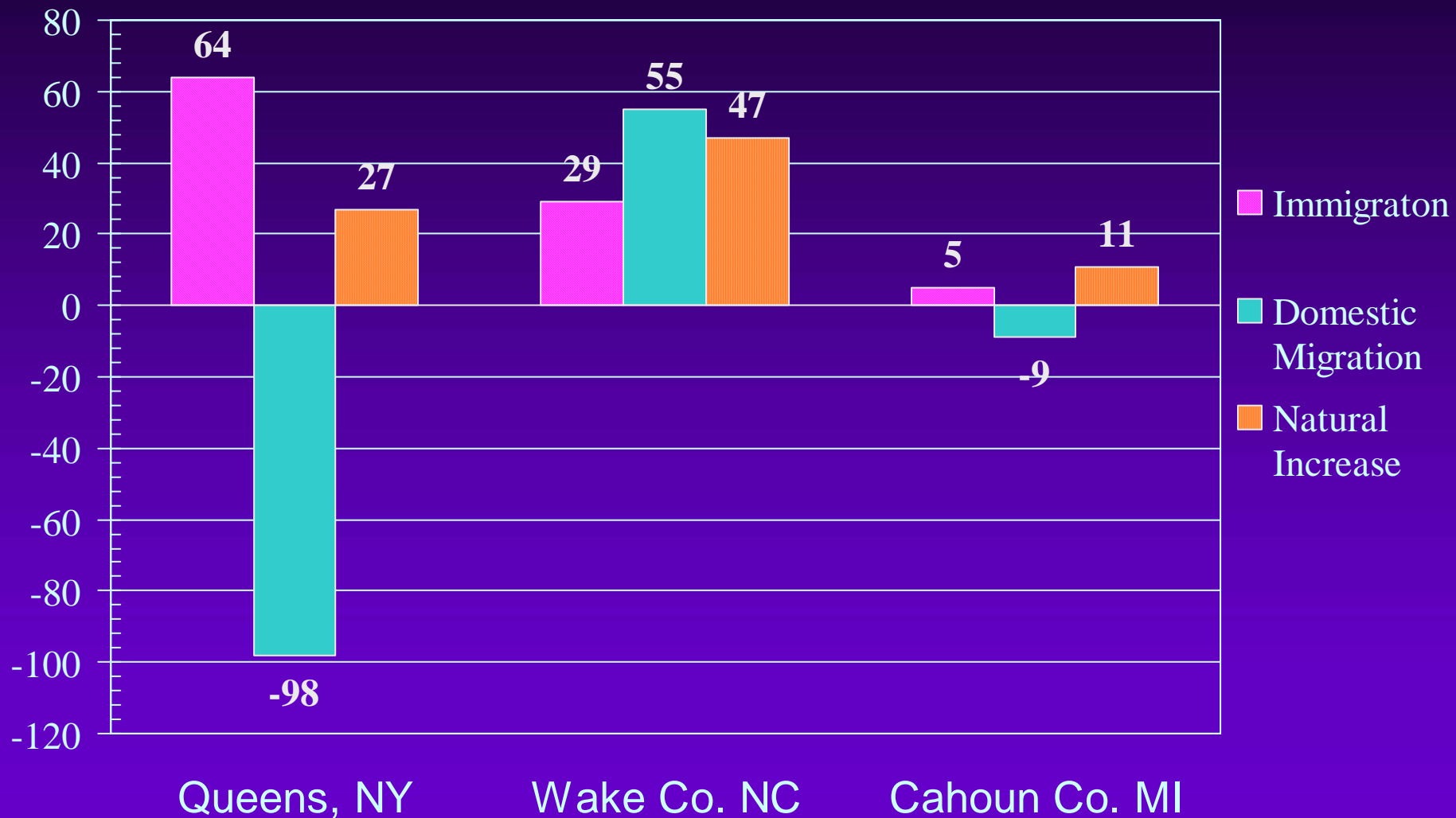

Percent Voting for Bush: 2000 vs 2004

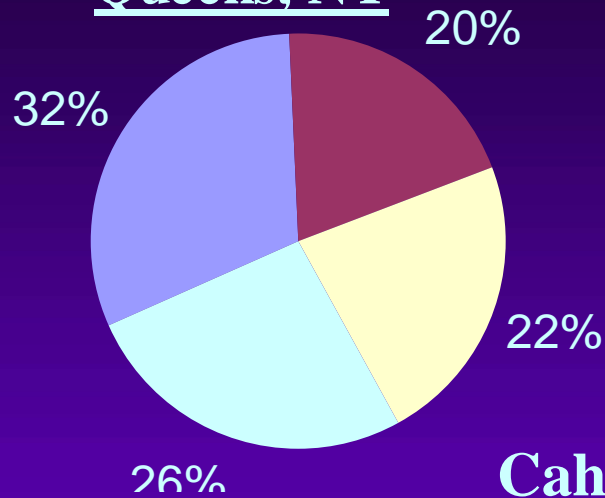

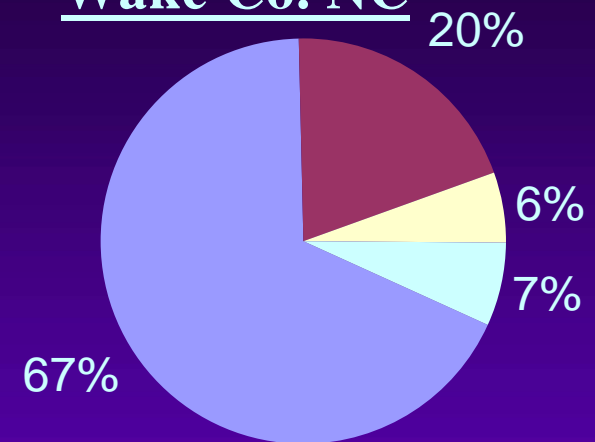
