



#### Projected Regional Growth, 2000-2030










#### Demographic Components, 2000-2004 (Rates per 1000)














## Hispanic Concentration








#### Melting Pot States: Race Change 1990-2003






## 2000-10 Growth: Under Age 35

#### Urban Suburban Growth: 2000-04








## Red, Blue and Purple State Electoral Votes, 2004






#### Population in Red, Blue and Purple Counties, 2004




#### Percent Population Change, 2000-04












#### Hispanics: 2004 Total vs Voter Shares








