

# Who Did Young People Vote for in Presidential Elections? 1972-2016








#### Levels of Trust Among Millennials, By Race and Ethnicity


#### % "somewhat" or "completely" trust



### Racial Makeup of the Voters by Age





# Composition of Young Supporters by Race, Gender, and Education




#### Feelings Held by Young Supporters of Trump and Clinton




#### Makeup of the Youth Electorate, by Educational Attainment






## Shift in Youth Party ID and Ideology











# Presidential Vote Choice Among Young Moderates, by Gender
