

Methodology

- In India, survey conducted from February 21 to March 10, 2017 among 2,464 respondents
- Based on face-to-face interviews among adults 18 and older (conducted in the Union Territory of Delhi and in 16 of the 18 most populous states, Kerala and Assam excluded)
- The margin of sampling error for the completed set of weighted data is ±3.7%







Indians Feel Very Positive About Life Today Compared With 50 Years Ago


Would you say life in India today is better, worse or about the same as it was 50 years ago for people like you?



A Strong Majority Is Satisfied With India's Direction




No Disagreement About India's Economic Situation

How would you describe the current economic situation in India?







Full question wordings for political systems: Representative democracy, "A democratic system where representatives elected by citizens decide what becomes law"; Direct democracy, "A democratic system where citizens, not elected officials, vote directly on major national issues to decide what becomes law"; Rule by experts, "Experts, not elected officials, make decisions according to what they think is best for the country"; Rule by a strong leader, "A system in which a strong leader can make decisions without interference from parliament or the courts"; Rule by the military, "The military rules the country."












Men, Women, People of All Ages and Educational Levels Have Favorable Opinion of Modi Views of Narendra Modi










% saying they think of Donald Trump as ...

Indian Views of U.S. More Positive Than Their Views of China




Indians See China's Growing Strength as a Bad Thing
