

Partisan Flips on Direction of the Country


Country Heading in the Right Direction, 2016 vs. 2019, by Party Affiliation




No Partisan Overlap in Top Three Critical Issues






Democrats Believe Republican Party Has Been Taken Over by Racists

- The Republican Party has been taken over by racists.






Republicans believe Democratic Party Has Been Taken Over by Socialists

- The Democratic Party has been taken over by socialists.






Divergent Partisan Conceptions of Capitalism

- A system where the interests of businesses and company shareholders are placed above the interests of workers and the middle class.






Divergent Partisan Conceptions of Socialism

Percent who say socialism is...


■ A system in which government provides citizens with health insurance, retirement support and access to free higher education.

Partisan Divides on Restrictive Immigration Scale






BUT More Partisan Agreement on Path to Citizenship and Family Separation


- FAVOR: Allowing immigrants living in country illegally a way to become citizens, provided they meet certain requirements.


Favorability of Top Five Democratic Candidates

Among Democrats and Democratic-leaning Independents







Thinking ahead to the 2020 election for president, which of the following describes how you are thinking about your vote?



- My vote will depend on who the Democratic candidate is.






Top Three Critical Issues Among Uncommitted Americans

Top Candidate Preferences over Trump, Among Uncommitted Americans







Trump Favorability, 2015-2019





- Disapprove, and almost nothing Trump could do to gain approval



Preference for Trump over Other Republican Candidate, Among Republican Subgroups


Among Republicans and Republican-leaning independents




President Trump has encouraged white supremacist groups.






Is Trump Encouraging White Supremacists? A Look at White Americans by Religion




Support for Impeaching and Removing President Trump from Office, 2017-2019
