






"At Work" Changes (Season 2020/21 – Season 2018/19) for 20 to 54 Years Old: By Education and Sex





"At Work" Changes (Season 2020/21 – Winter2019/20) for 20 to 54 Years Old: By Education and Sex



Working Remotely (due to COVID) among Men and Women by Education: May 2020 to Sept. 2021




Childcare Hours of College-Graduate, Employed Couples, by the Age of Their Youngest Child






Pandemic Impact on "At Work" Rates of Women 20 to 54 Years Old by Various Factors
