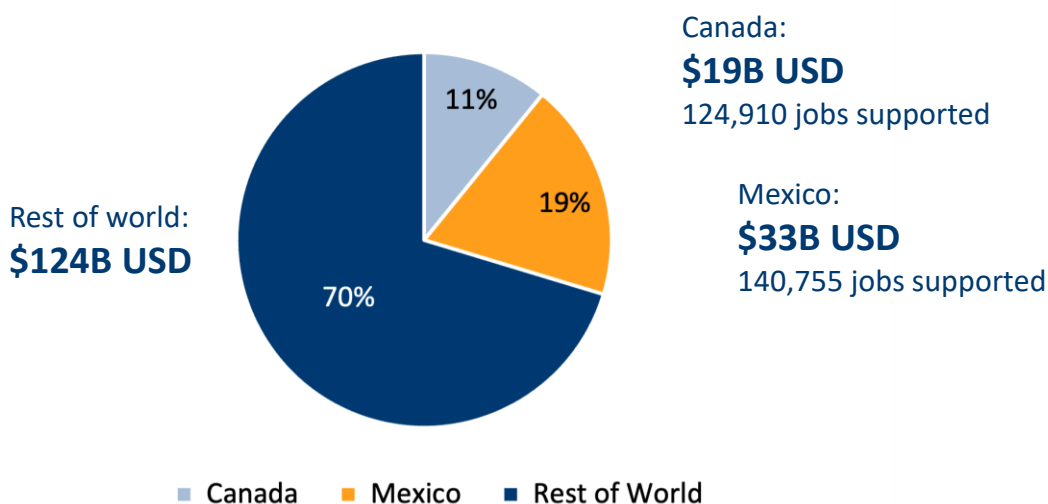


The United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) governs trade among the US, Canada and Mexico worth around 1.8 trillion dollars, where each country is each other's largest exports partners, supporting around 17 million jobs. 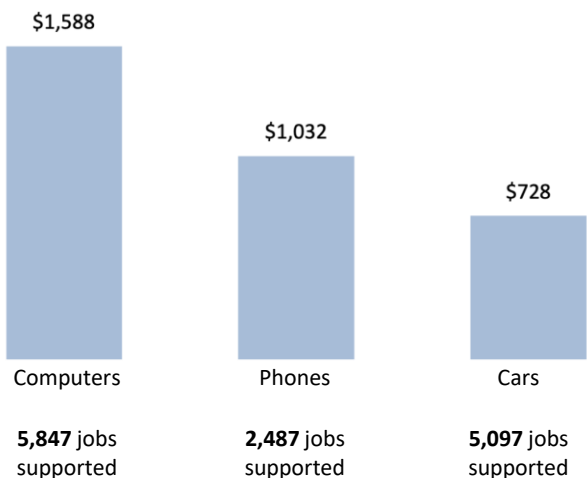

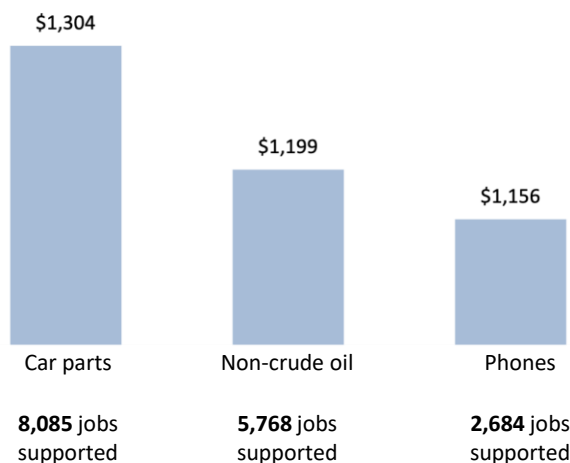


CALIFORNIA TOP GOODS EXPORTS UNDER USMCA

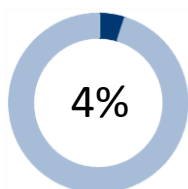
Canada (\$M)

For California, phones accounted for 4% of goods exports to USMCA partners in 2023. Nationally, just 1% of exports to Canada and Mexico were phones.
