

Appendix C: City statistics

After January 2025, the typical surge city saw enforcement more than triple, and they lost an average of about 7,800 jobs in the months that followed. The table below shows city-level statistics, including baseline 2024 employment, at-large arrests, and surge arrests made in the first half of 2025. The final column projects job losses at the city level by applying our topline employment loss effect to 2024 employment. We observe job losses in aggregate, comparing 86 surge and 255 non-surge cities, so applying the effect at the city level assumes effects spread evenly across surge cities. We do not directly observe job loss at the city level.
